No. F.1-1/2025-IDSRS-NIH, Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response System, National Institute of Health (NIH), Islamabad intends to pre-qualify vendors / firms for the **UPGRADATION AND RENOVATIONS OF LABORATORIES AT AJK, GILGIT-BALTISTAN, AND NIH ISLAMABAD, ON AN AS-AND-WHEN-REQUIRED BASIS** i.e., IDSRS Project Office during the Fiscal Year 2025-26 (extendable) on as and when required basis in terms of rule 15 & 16(a) of PPRA, 2004 amended from time to time. Bids through EPADS are invited from vendors / firms / Bidders registered with Income Tax Departments and are on Active Taxpayer List (ATL) of FBR which fulfill the following terms and conditions:

1. The Pre-qualification process shall be carried out through EPADS.
2. Interested eligible bidders must be registered on the EPADS (<http://eprocure.gov.pk/>) and submit their documents on EPADS.
3. In case of any discrepancy between documents uploaded on EPADS and the physically submitted hard copy, the EPADS submission shall prevail.
4. Proof of Registration with FBR, NTN, SRTN must be attached along-with proof of ATL.
5. PEC registration is mandatory as the scope involves structural, electrical, mechanical, and allied engineering works for repair, maintenance, and upgradation and renovations of laboratory buildings; under the Pakistan Engineering Council Act, 1976, only PEC-registered firms having C-2 category and above are authorized to execute such works, ensuring technical competence, regulatory compliance, public safety, and audit conformity under PPRA Rules, 2004.
6. The interested bidders shall submit the Application for Pre-Qualification as per **(Annexure-A)**. The bidder shall submit Pre-Qualification Application along with all Annexures attached herewith.
7. The interested bidder shall submit an undertaking that he/she or his/her firm is not involved in any corrupt or fraudulent practice during the pre-qualification procurement and award of work/contract as per **(Annexure-B)**.
8. Non-Blacklisting and Insolvency declaration / undertaking on affidavit as per **(Annexure-C)** must be attached with Pre-Qualification / Bidding documents.

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9. The Pre-Qualified Bidder / vendor shall be bound to carry out the requisite work or provide the required services on immediate basis, as and when work order is issued to the pre-qualified bidders, including outside normal office hours, where operationally required.
10. The Bid / Application / Request for pre-qualification shall remain valid for the period of Ninety (days) from the date of submission. IDSRS Project Office shall complete the evaluation and communicate within this period.
11. The prequalification or enlistment of Bidders does not constitute or create any form of contractual commitment or retainership. Pre-qualification does not constitute a commitment to award any contract.
12. Financial bids shall be invited only at the Call-Off / Mini-Competition stage under Rule-16(a), restricted to pre-qualified firms, through EPADS.
13. For each Call-Off contract, bid security (if applicable) and a Performance Bank Guarantee @10% of the contract value shall be submitted, as specified in the respective Call-Off document.
14. All / any payment(s) will be made through cross cheque, after due deductions.

Criteria for Pre-Qualification:

1. The Bidder shall submit Pre-Qualification Application (Annexure-A) along with all Annexures attached herewith, as per (Annexure-D).
2. Procuring Agency may conduct physical visit of all vendor's offices before pre-qualification and verify key information like capacity to perform the required job, space availability, machinery installed, tool and plants available, technical workforce on ground physically. The Procuring Agency may conduct physical verification during the pre-qualification process or at any time prior to award of a Call-Off.
3. The bidder must have a verifiable minimum average annual financial turnover of PKR 200,000,000/- or above during the last two completed financial years.

General Stipulations:

1. An authorized representative of the Bidder(s) on duly notarized authority letter should initial on all pages of the Prequalification, failure to which leads to disqualification of firm.
2. No bid security shall be required at the pre-qualification stage; bid security, if any, shall be specified and required only at the Call-Off / Mini-Competition stage.
3. The Bidders shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of their respective Proposals and IDSRS Project Office shall in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the prequalification process.

4. The bids received in the stipulated time and date will be opened by the pre-qualification committee on the same day in the presence of bidders of their authorized representatives, who choose to be present on the occasion and only the name of the bidders will be announced.
5. The Pre-Qualified firm will quote rates only at call-off / secondary competition stage, which shall be inclusive of all service charges, applicable taxes, levies, duties and fees as prevailing laws.
6. Pre-qualified firms shall be deemed to have fully familiarized themselves with site conditions, operational constraints, and access limitations. No claim on account of lack of site knowledge shall be entertained at call-off stage.
7. Subcontracting of core works shall not be permitted without prior written approval of the Procuring Agency, and the pre-qualified firm shall remain fully responsible for performance.
8. Neither party shall be liable for failure to perform obligations due to force majeure events as defined under applicable laws, subject to timely notification and documentation.
9. The pre-qualified bidder shall be bound to mobilize and commence work immediately upon issuance of a call-off/work order and adhere strictly to the timelines specified therein.
10. Pre-qualification or enlistment does not confer any exclusive right or guarantee of work, nor does it obligate the Procuring Agency to issue any minimum number of call-offs.

Annexure-B

Declaration of Bidder Regarding Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices (on Legal Stamp Paper)

The purchaser observes the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. In pursuance of this policy, the Purchaser:

- i. defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:

- iv. “Obstructive practice” includes deliberately destroying, falsifying, altering or concealing of evidence material to the investigation or making false statements to investigators in order to materially impede IDSRS Project Office investigation into allegations of a corrupt, fraudulent, coercive or collusive practice; and/or threatening, harassing or intimidating any party to prevent it from disclosing its knowledge of matters relevant to the investigation or from pursuing the investigation, or IDSRS Project Office has a right to immediately reject a proposal for award if it determines that the Bidder recommended for award has, directly or through an agent, engaged in afore stated practices. A panel of Entities will be selected after an open and transparent bidding process in accordance with Public Procurement Regulatory Authority Rules – 2004.


