HIRING OF CONSULTANT(S) FOR THIRD-PARTY FORENSIC ANALYSIS OF SUI COMPANIES' (SNGPL & SSGC) REVENUE REQUIREMENT AS DETERMINED BY OGRA

BACKGROUND

Unaccounted-for-gas (UFG), cost of gas, and revenue requirement determinations are critical factors affecting gas tariffs, financial sustainability of the gas sector, and consumer prices in Pakistan. Petroleum Division, Ministry of Energy has previously undertaken sectoral diagnostics of the gas supply chain. It has now been desired that an independent third-party forensic analysis be conducted of the OGRA-determined revenue requirements of Sui Northern Gas Pipelines Limited (SNGPL) and Sui Southern Gas Company Limited (SSGC), including the petitions filed by both companies before OGRA.

The assignment requires evidence-based verification of inputs and assumptions, identification of cost-reduction opportunities, and development of an actionable reform roadmap for decision-making.

SCOPE OF THE ASSIGNMENT

The consultant(s) shall carry out a forensic, regulatory, operational, and financial review of OGRA-determined revenue requirements for SNGPL and SSGC, primarily covering FY 2023-24 & FY 2024-25 revenue requirement cycles, with a look-back of 3-5 years where necessary.

Key areas include:

- Cost of Gas (CoG) and supply portfolio review
- Regulated return and asset base (WACC)
- Technical and commercial losses (UFG)
- Revenues and other price-relevant items
- Opex efficiency and organization
- Capex and asset integrity
- Regulatory consistency and legal framework

KEY DELIVERABLES

- Inception Report

- Interim Update(s)
- Draft Final Report
- Final Report & Executive Summary with board-level presentation

Indicative Duration: Six (06) months from inception, subject to timely data access.

CONSULTANT REQUIREMENTS

The assignment may be undertaken by a single firm or by a consortium/joint venture. Firms must demonstrate expertise in forensic analysis, utility regulation, energy economics, data analytics, and legal/regulatory review.

SHORTLISTING MANDATORY CRITERIA

1. Relevant Experience:

- a) At least one completed assignment involving forensic audit or forensic review of a regulated entity, SOE, or utility.
- b) At least one additional completed assignment in tariff/revenue requirement analysis, WACC or asset-base review, gas sector diagnostics, or loss-accounting/UFG studies.

2. Registration:

- a) Pakistani firms must be registered with applicable federal/provincial tax authorities and relevant professional bodies.
- b) International firms (if any) must be registered with relevant authorities in their home jurisdictions.

3. Team Composition:

Availability of key experts including Engagement Partner (Forensics), Utility Regulation Specialist, Energy Economist, Senior Auditor, Data/SCADA Analyst, Legal/Regulatory Counsel, and Risk Specialist.

SELECTION METHOD

Only short-listed firms meeting the above criteria will be invited to submit detailed proposals under the applicable Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method.

SUBMISSION OF EOI

EOIs shall be submitted only through PPRA e-Procurement System (EPADS), duly filled, signed, and stamped, on or before the deadline mentioned above.

The procuring agency reserves the right to accept or reject any or all EOIs and annul the process as per applicable rules.
