**Terms & Conditions**

1. The bids shall comprise a single package containing two separate envelopes. Each envelope shall contain separately the “Technical Proposal” and “Financial Proposal” boldly marked on each envelope.
2. The envelopes containing “Technical Proposal” shall be opened first and after selection of transportation rates “given below” on the basis of technical grounds by the committee, the envelopes containing “Financial Proposal” will be opened in the presence of bidders on the same date.

3. Bidders are required to submit photo copies of their valid NIC (duly attested) with tender documents and also provide 5 years’ Experience Certificate about transportation of goods, at least (03 work orders).
4. The Bidders will submit a call deposit amounting to Rs.500,000/- (refundable) of the available budget in favor of Assistant/Deputy Collector (HQ), Collectorate of Customs (Enforcement), Peshawar with the tender.
5. Payment will be made after completion of transportation work through cross cheque.
6. The time limit for transportation of goods will be given in the work order.
7. All payments will be subject to applicable Government taxes including GST.
8. Error and omissions, if any shall be subject to rectification by the Customs Department.
9. The Bidder are required to submit attested photo copy of STRN and valid national tax numbers who are on active tax payers list (ATL) with tender documents.
10. The competent authority reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject all the bids (as per PPRA Rules-33(I)).
11. Conditional/telegraphic tender and telephonic discussion shall not be entertained.
12. The accepted bid rates would be valid for the current financial year, 2025-2026 as well as financial year 2026-27.
13. The interested and eligible bidders must submit their applications online via PPRA’s portal: <https://epads.ppra.org.pk> by 16.02.2026 or within 20 days of the advertisement’s publication on PPRA’s website, whichever is later.
