

02. The Committee shall announce its decision within seven (07) days of receipt of the complaint and communicate the same to the complainant and the relevant authority within three (03) working days thereafter.



1.1 : Clarification of Bidding Documents

- i. The Accountant will respond to any query for clarification prior to the deadline for the submission of bids.
- ii. Clarifications shall be sought at least five (5) days prior to the bid-opening date, in accordance with Rule 23 of the Sindh Public Procurement Rules 2010 (Amended 2022).

1.2 : Amendment of Bidding Documents

- i. At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas may, for any reason, modify the Bidding Document by issuing an addendum.
- ii. Any addendum thus issued shall be part of the Bidding Document and shall be made available online on the official websites of SPPRA and District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas.

1.3: Eligible Bidders

Bidding is open to all firms meeting the following criteria:

- i. The Bidder must be a registered civil works contractor holding a valid Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) license, renewed for the current year, with specialization related to building and construction works and have valid certificate and license must have EE04, EE06 and EE11 electrical codes.
- ii. The Bidder must have successfully completed at least three (03) contracts of similar nature and scope during the last three (03) years, and must also have at least two (02) similar projects currently in hand under valid agreements.
 - Work Orders / Agreements
 - Completion Certificates
 - The Procurement Committee may conduct site verification of completed projects.
- iii. The Bidder must not be blacklisted under Rule 35 of SPP Rules 2010 (Amended 2022).
- iv. The Bidder must have qualified technical staff, including:
 - One (01) PEC-registered Civil Engineer as Project Engineer,
 - One (01) DAE Civil Site Supervisor with minimum 3 years experience.
- v. The Bidder must have a minimum average annual turnover of PKR 10 million during the last three (03) fiscal years, supported by:
 - Last three years verified audited financial statements
 - Bank statements for the last three years

- vi. The Bidder must be an Active Taxpayer (ATL) with the Federal Board of Revenue (FBR).
- vii. The Bidder must possess valid NTN, GST, and SRB Vendor Registration and last three years income tax returns.

1.7: Prior to the detailed evaluation of bids, the Procurement Committee will determine whether the Bidder fulfills all requirements of eligibility criteria as per section 1.3. If the Bidder does not fulfill any of these conditions, it will not be evaluated further.

1.8 Criteria for Bid Evaluation

- i. The bid price shall be inclusive of all construction works, materials, labor, equipment, overheads, and all applicable taxes. No separate or additional cost shall be entertained.

- ii. The bidder shall quote a single, firm price for the complete scope of works. Multiple rates or alternative prices for the same item will be treated as non-responsive.
- iii. The bidder shall quote for the entire scope of civil works as specified in the Schedule of Requirements and drawings. Partial bidding or incomplete BOQ/works will not be accepted.
- iv. Bidders shall not quote for partial quantities. The bid must cover the full and complete quantity of all works required under the Schedule of Requirements.
- v. Any conditional, incomplete, or ambiguous bid shall be declared non-responsive and rejected.

1.9 : Cost of Bidding

The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and the District and Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

1.10 : Earnest Money/Bid Security

- 1.10.1** Each Bidder shall furnish the required Earnest Money/Bid Security in favour of the District and Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas. The Earnest Money/Bid Security shall be valid for a period as specified in the Bidding Data Form.
- 1.10.2** In case of failure to submit Earnest Money/Bid Security (physical form) prior/at the time of opening, the bids bid rejected by the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas treating it as non-responsive.
- 1.10.3** The Earnest Money/Bid Security of an unsuccessful Bidder will be returned to him after the award of the contract.
- 1.10.4** The Earnest Money/Bid Security of the successful Bidder(s) will be returned on satisfactory performance of Job or supply of relevant item(s).
- 1.10.5** The Earnest Money/Bid Security may be forfeited if the Contractor fails to commence, execute, or complete the works within the specified time, or withdraws the bid during the validity period.

1.11 : Work

- 1.11.1** All construction works / goods, materials, and fittings shall be new, of approved quality, and in accordance with PEC standards and the specifications provided in the bidding document.
- 1.11.2** If any material, workmanship, or executed portion of the works / goods is found unsatisfactory or not as per specifications, the Contractor shall remove and replace the defective work / goods at his own cost within the specified time.

1.12 : Contractor Responsibilities

1.12.1 The Contractor shall ensure the execution of all civil works, provision of materials, labor, equipment, and related activities strictly in accordance with the approved drawings,

1.13 : Dispute Resolution

1.13.1 Amicable Settlement:

The Parties agree to attempt to resolve any dispute arising under this Agreement promptly, amicably and in good faith. Each Party shall designate a representative who shall be entitled to enter into discussions to resolve by amicable agreement any dispute in connection with this Agreement.

1.13.2 Arbitration

- (a) Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement that has not been resolved amicably in accordance with Clause 1.13.1 shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the **Arbitration Act, 1940 (as amended, supplemented or modified)**. The dispute shall be referred to a **sole arbitrator mutually agreed upon by both parties**. If the parties fail to agree on an arbitrator within thirty (30) days of a written request by either party, an arbitrator shall be appointed in accordance with the provisions of the said Act by a competent court of law.
- (b) The arbitration proceedings and the award shall be rendered in the **English/Urdu language**.
- (c) The arbitration shall be conducted at **Mirpurkhas, Sindh, Pakistan**.
- (d) The **decision of the arbitrator** shall be final and binding upon both parties, and judgment upon the award rendered may be entered in any court of competent jurisdiction.

1.13.3 Performance to Continue During Dispute:

Notwithstanding any reference of a dispute to the amicable settlement or arbitration herein, the Parties shall (to the extent practicable) continue to perform their respective obligation under this Agreement unless they otherwise agree.

1.14: Rejection of Bids

Bid may be rejected if:

- 1.14.1** Eligibility criteria is not met.
- 1.14.2** Bid is submitted without the required Earnest Money/Bid Security.
- 1.14.3** Bid is received after the specified date and time as per the Bidding Data Form.
- 1.14.4** The bid shall be rejected if it is not duly signed and stamped on all required pages by the authorized signatory of the bidder.
- 1.14.5** If the Bidder has no GST or NTN.
- 1.14.6** Ambiguous Bid shall be rejected.
- 1.14.7** Any other major discrepancy found in the proposal.

2: SUBMISSION OF BID (Instructions to Bidders)

- 2.1 The Bidder is expected to follow all instructions and specifications in the bidding document.
- 2.2 Failure to furnish all information required in the bidding document or to submit a bid not substantially responsive to the bidding document will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in the rejection of the bid.
- 2.3 The bid shall remain valid for the period stipulated in the Bidding Data Form.
- 2.4 The bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person or persons duly authorized to sign. This shall be indicated by submitting a written Power of Attorney authorizing the signatory of the Bidder to act for and on behalf of the Bidder.
- 2.5 Official seal shall be affixed on every page of the bid or shall be initialed by the person submitting the bid.
- 2.6 A bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation will be treated as non-responsive and will be rejected.
- 2.7 All bids shall be submitted electronically through the SPPRA e-Procurement (ePAD) portal before the deadline specified in the Bidding Data Form. No manual or physical bid submission will be entertained.
- 2.8 Bidders must ensure successful upload and encryption of their bids on the ePAD system within the prescribed time.
- 2.9 The Bidder may modify or withdraw his bid through ePAD portal before the deadline for submission. After the closing time, no modification or withdrawal shall be permitted.
- 2.10 Any bid submitted or uploaded after the deadline on the ePAD portal will be automatically rejected by the system.
- 2.11 The Bidder may modify or withdraw his bid after the bid's submission, provided that written notice of the modification, including substitution or withdrawal of the bid, is received by the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of bids.
- 2.12 No bid shall be modified after the deadline for submission of bids.

2.13 No bid shall be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and the expiry of the period of bid validity. Withdrawal of a bid during this interval shall result in the forfeiture of the bid security.

2.14 The prices shall be fixed and must be inclusive of all relevant taxes. If a tax is not mentioned, then the offered price will be considered as inclusive of all prevailing /applicable taxes.

2.15 If these instructions to Bidders are not fully complied with, the bid may be rejected.

3: BID OPENING, CLARIFICATION AND EVALUATION

3.1 The bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders or their representatives who choose to attend at the time, date and location stipulated in the Bidding Data Form.

3.2 Bidders or their representatives who choose to attend shall sign the attendance sheet.

3.3 The Bidder's name, bid price, the presence or absence of the Bid Security, and such other details as the Procurement Committee of the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas at its discretion may consider appropriate, will be announced at the time of bid opening.

3.4 A substantially responsive bid is one which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the Bidding Document.

3.5 A bid determined as substantially non-responsive will be rejected and will not subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder by correction of the non- conformity.

3.6 The Procurement Committee of the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas will evaluate and compare the bids which have been determined to be substantially responsive.

3.7 The Procurement Committee of the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas shall announce the result of the bid evaluation at least ten (10) days prior to the award of contract on the official websites of the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas and SPPRA.

3.8 The Procurement Committee of the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas will examine the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether the bids are generally in order.

Bid Evaluation:

3.9 Bids will be opened on the tender opening date as specified in the Bidding Data Form.

3.10 Bids will be opened at the time and date as mentioned in the Bidding Data Form.

3.11 To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of bids, the Procurement Committee of District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas may, at its discretion, ask the Bidder for a clarification of its bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing and no change in the price or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered or permitted.

3.12 The bids will be evaluated in accordance with technical specifications, drawings,

BOQ and construction requirement prescribed in bidding document any bid that does not confirm to the requirement specification quality standards or terms and conditions shall be declared non-responsive and rejected.

3.13 If there is a discrepancy between the unit rate and total amount calculated by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected. If there is a discrepancy between the amount in words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail. If the Bidder does not accept the corrected bid price, his bid will be rejected and his Bid Security shall be forfeited.

4. TIME FOR COMPLETION OF WORKS (Instructions to Bidders)

4.1 Execution of Works

4.1.1 The Contractor shall execute and complete all construction works, including provision of materials, labor, tools, equipment, and related activities, at the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas, or any other notified location, within the time specified in the Bidding Data Form and at the Contractor's own cost.

4.1.2 If the Contractor fails to complete any portion of the works within the stipulated period, the Procuring Agency may, without prejudice to its other remedies under the Contract, impose liquidated damages at the rate of five percent (5%) of the contract price for the delayed portion of the works, and may take further permissible action including blacklisting under the applicable rules.

4.1.3 Any defect, substandard workmanship, or failure in the executed works discovered during construction or within the defect-liability period shall be rectified or replaced by the Contractor at his own risk and cost.

4.1.4 There shall be a minimum one-year defect liability period for all civil works, finishing works, fixtures, and installed item.

5: PROCESS TO BE CONFIDENTIAL (Instructions to Bidders)

5.1 No Bidder shall contact any officer of the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas on any matter relating to his bid from the time of the bid opening to the time the bid evaluation result is announced. The evaluation result shall be announced at least ten (10) days prior to Award of Contract.

5.2 Any effort by a Bidder to influence any officer of the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas in the bid evaluation, bid comparison or contract award decisions may result in the rejection of his bid.

5.3 Whereas, any Bidder feeling aggrieved may lodge a written complaint to Complaint Redressal Committee (CRC) constituted under Rule 31 of the Sindh Public Procurement Rules, 2010 (Amended 2022) after the announcement of the bid evaluation result. However, a mere fact of lodging a complaint shall not warrant suspension of the procurement process.

5.4 No bidder may ask for sharing the information/documents of other bidder/s participating the process.

6: AWARD OF CONTRACT

6.1 Award Criteria and Right of the District and Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas

- (a) The Procurement Committee, District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas shall award the Contract to the Bidder(s) whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive to the Bidding Document and most advantageous Bid as per procurement Rules.
- (b) The Procurement Committee, District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas reserves the right to:-
 - i. increase or decrease the scope or quantity of the work/ Goods without any change in the unit, rate, price or other terms and conditions.
 - ii. accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidders, except that the grounds for rejection shall upon request be communicated, to any Bidder who submitted a bid,
 - iii. Issue a notice of the rejection of bids to all concerned Bidders.
- (c) The Procurement Committee, District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas observes the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and will reject a bid at any stage if it determines that the Bidder recommended for award has engaged in any corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract.

6.1 Notification of Award

6.2 Performance Guarantee

The successful Bidder shall be bound to furnish a performance guarantee as provided in the Bidding Data Form.

6.3 Payment and Currency

Payment shall be made in Pak. Rupees after successful delivery of the works/ Goods.

6.4 All applicable taxes shall be deducted at source as per Government Rules.

6.5 Signing of the Contract Form

As the Procurement Committee, District and Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas notifies the successful Bidder that its bid has been accepted, the Procurement Committee, District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas will send the Bidder the Contract Form provided in the Bidding Document incorporating all agreements between the parties.

1. Definitions

1.1 In this Contract, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated:

- a) **“The Bidding Document”** includes the following:
 - i. Invitation to Bid
 - ii. General Conditions for Bidding
 - iii. Instructions to Bidders
 - iv. Bidding Data Form
 - v. Schedule of Requirements / Scope of Works
 - vi. Bid Form
 - vii. Price Schedule Form
 - viii. Contract Form
 - ix. General Conditions of Contract
- b) **“The Contract”** means the agreement entered into between the Purchaser and the Contractor, as recorded in the signed Contract Form, including all attachments, schedules, and documents incorporated by reference.
- c) **“The Contract Price”** means the amount payable to the Contractor under the Contract for the proper execution and completion of the works.
- d) **“The Works”** means all construction, civil works, labor, materials, equipment, and related obligations required under the Contract to complete the project at the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas.
- e) **“GCC”** means the General Conditions of Contract contained in this section.
- f) **“The Purchaser”** means the District & Sessions Court, Mirpurkhas.
- g) **“The Contractor”** means the firm/company awarded the Contract for execution of the works.
- h) **“Day”** means a calendar day.
- i) **“The Site”** means the Taluka Courts Kot Ghulam Muhammad, or any other location designated for execution of the works.

2. Application

These General Conditions shall apply to the Contract unless superseded by the Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) or other provisions.

3. Standards

All civil works shall conform to the Pakistan Engineering

Council (PEC) standard specifications and Provincial Buildings Division norms. The contractor shall employ licensed engineers or site supervisors registered with PEC.

4. Inspection

4.1 The Purchaser or its authorized representative shall have the right to inspect the works, materials, and workmanship at any stage to verify conformity with specifications and approved drawings.

4.2 If any part of the works, materials, or workmanship is found to be substandard, defective, or not in accordance with specifications, the Purchaser may reject such work. The Contractor shall remove and replace the defective work or materials at his own cost.

4.3 The Purchaser's right to inspect and reject defective work shall not be limited by prior inspections or approvals conducted during earlier stages of construction.

5. Execution of Works and Documentation

The Contractor shall execute the works in accordance with the Schedule of Requirements, approved drawings, BOQ, specifications, and instructions issued by the Purchaser. All construction-related documents, completion reports and measurement records shall be submitted as required under the Contract.

6. Transportation

The Contractor shall arrange, at his own cost, the transportation of all construction materials, tools, equipment, and related items to the site of works at Taluka Courts Kot Ghulam Muhammad, or any other designated location.

7. Payment

The Contractor's request for payment shall be submitted to the Purchaser in writing, accompanied by:

- Invoices for materials (where applicable), and
- Any other documents required under the Contract.

Payment shall be made only after verification and satisfactory performance of the works as per the Contract

8. Contract Amendments

No modification or variation in the terms of the Contract shall be made except through a written amendment signed by both the Purchaser and the Contractor.

9. Delays in the Contractor Performance

9.1 The Contractor shall execute and complete the works within the time schedule prescribed in the Schedule of Requirements.

9.2 If the Contractor fails to complete the works within the stipulated period, he shall be liable for liquidated damages as specified in GCC Clause 10.

10. Liquidated Damages

If the Contractor fails to complete any part or the whole of the works within the time period specified in the Contract, the Purchaser shall, without prejudice to other remedies, impose liquidated damages at the rate of **five percent (5%) of the contract price** for the delayed portion of the works. The Purchaser may also take further action, including blacklisting, in accordance with the applicable rules.

11. Termination for Default

11.1 The Purchaser may terminate the Contract, in whole or in part, by written notice to the Contractor if:

- a) The Contractor fails to complete the works within the period(s) specified;
- b) The Contractor fails to perform any of his contractual obligations;
- or
- c) The Contractor is found, in the judgment of the Purchaser, to have engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive, or obstructive practices.

Definition of Corrupt and Fraudulent Practices:

Includes offering, receiving, or soliciting anything of value to influence the procurement process or contract execution; misrepresentation of facts; collusion among bidders; and any attempt to compromise free and fair competition.

12. Force Majeure

12.1 Force Majeure” refers to events beyond the control of the Contractor and not involving the Contractor’s negligence. These include, but are not limited to, acts of the Purchaser in its sovereign capacity, war, floods, fire, epidemics, natural disasters, or other unforeseen events.

12.2 If a Force Majeure situation arises, the Contractor shall promptly notify the Purchaser in writing, detailing the cause. Unless instructed otherwise, the Contractor shall continue to perform obligations to the extent possible and shall seek reasonable alternative means for performance.

13. Notices

13.1 Any notice required under the Contract shall be delivered to the concerned party at its designated address.

13.2 A notice becomes effective on the date it is delivered or on the date specified therein, whichever is later.

14. Taxes and Duties

The Contractor shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, levies, and charges applicable under law in connection with the execution and completion of the works until final handover to the Purchaser.

15. Governing Language

The Contract shall be written in English language. All correspondence and other documents pertaining to the Contract which are exchanged by the parties shall be written in the same language.

16. Applicable Law

The Contract shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

14. SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

14.1 Scope

These Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) shall supplement and, in case of any conflict, shall supersede the provisions of the General Conditions of Contract (GCC).

14.2 Time for Completion of Works

The Contractor shall execute and complete all construction works strictly within the timelines specified in the Schedule of Requirements and Work Order. Any delay beyond the allowed period shall attract penalties under Clause 10 of the GCC.

14.3 Defect Liability / Warranty

All civil works, fixtures, fittings, and installed items shall carry a minimum one-year defect liability period, during which the Contractor shall rectify, repair, or replace any defects at no additional cost to the Purchaser.

14.4 Payment Terms

Payment shall be made in Pakistani Rupees after:

- successful execution of the works,
- verification of measurements,
- Inspection and acceptance by the Purchaser.
- No advance payment shall be made.

R.O Performance Guarantee

The Performance Guarantee shall remain valid until completion of the works and expiry of the defect liability period, whichever is later.

R.O Jurisdiction


