security, to medical cover and no pension. Asim Bashir Khan, researcher and author of the study, said the consequences of chronic loadshedding ripple far beyond discomfort. "What we documented is a cascade of harm," he said.

"Workers arrive at factories already exhausted from sleepless, sweltering nights. Without fans or cooling, children cannot study and families cannot sleep. Water meters stop working, which means no water for drinking or sanitation. The spread of mosquito-borne diseases like dengue and malaria increases. Workplace accidents rise. Domestic violence rises. These are not separate problems, they all flow from the same source," he added.


The study documents that 80pc of Sindh's workers fall entirely outside the social security net administered by the Sindh Employees Social Security Institution (SESSI), largely because registration thresholds exclude piece-rate and informal workers. More than 90pc of labour contracts are not registered with the Sindh Revenue Board, further compounding the gap between law and practice.

The study also proposes a solution. It says that between fiscal years 2016-17 and 2024-25, the Sindh Workers' Welfare Fund collected Rs28.33 billion and the Sindh Workers' Profit Participation Fund collected Rs50.57m. It recommends earmarking a portion of these funds to establish a Sindh Solarisation Endowment Fund for Labourers, which could finance off-grid solar installations for over 94,000 labourer households at an estimated cost of Rs300,000 per unit.

It terms the proposal as designed to be realistic within Pakistan's constrained fiscal environment. "We are not asking for new money. The Workers' Welfare Fund exists precisely to improve the lives of labourers. We are asking that it be used for that purpose. Off-grid solarisation would reduce the cost of living for poor households, build resilience against climate change, and could attract international climate finance because it is a green investment. The government of Sindh has the tools. What is needed now is the political will," Mr Haider pointed out.

Asad Iqbal Butt, chairperson of the IHRC, said 45pc of Pakistan's population is living below the poverty line. "The minimum wage must be raised to Rs75,000 if we are serious about giving workers a decent life. Yet 80pc of workers do not even receive the current minimum wage. The state has failed to implement its own laws and its own policies," he added.

Habibuddin Junaidi, senior trade unionist and leader of the Peoples Labour Bureau, also spoke.

Over 1,000 students get laptops under PM scheme

Minister seeks report for renovating Dr N.A. Baloch Model School

HYDERABAD: Sindh Minister for Education Sardar Ali Shah has directed a relevant team within his ministry on Wednesday to conduct a comprehensive assessment of Dr N.A. Baloch Model School of Sindh University (SU) at the earliest and prepare a detailed proposal for its complete renovation.

The objective, he said, was to secure budgetary approval and restore the historic institution to its former stature.

The minister issued the direction during a visit to the school, which is also his alma mater. The minister sat at a desk in one of the classrooms for a few moments and reviewed the historic school building, classrooms, laboratories and corridors.

Expressing immense joy over returning to his alma mater after many years, he regretted the deteriorating state of the historic building. He stated he should have visited it earlier to assess its condition and initiate restoration work.

He announced immediate renovation measures and pledged to equip the institution with modern facilities. He was received by SU Vice-Chancellor Prof Farah Mohammad Marri.

The minister noted with pride that numerous graduates of the school were currently serving in key positions across various ministries and departments throughout the country and abroad.

"Improving quality of education is one of my foremost priorities as strengthening the province's education system is the most effective way to serve Sindh and its people," he said. He added that teachers' recruitments had been carried out strictly on merit and that tangible steps were being taken to upgrade basic facilities in schools.

He reiterated his commitment to ensure that every young person in Sindh completed at least intermediate level education. He added that a comprehensive strategy was being implemented to achieve this goal. He pointed out that practical measures had been introduced to reduce dropout rates in schools and colleges.

He stated that renovation work at Dr N.A. Baloch Model School would commence soon and new furniture would also be provided to improve the learning environment.

The VC remarked that the SU had periodically undertaken maintenance work on the school building. "However, the structure is more than a century old, it now requires extensive renovation and the provision of new furniture on a larger scale," the VC said. He said the role of the provincial education ministry was crucial in that regard.

- 2. Language of Bid**
- 3. Documents Comprising the Bid** The bid prepared by the Bidder shall comprise the following components:
 - (a) Price Schedule completed in accordance with ITB Clauses 4, 5 and 6.
 - (b) Bid security furnished in accordance with ITB Clause 9.
- 4. Bid Prices**

15.1 The Bidder may modify or withdraw its bid after the bid's submission, provided that written notice of the modification, including substitution or withdrawal of the bids, is received by the Procuring agency prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of bids.

15.2 No bid may be modified after the deadline for submission of bids.

15.3 No bid may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and the expiry of the period of bid validity. Withdrawal of a bid during this interval may result in the Bidder's forfeiture of its bid security.

OPENING AND EVALUATION OF BIDS

16. Opening of Bids by the Procuring agency

16.1 The Procuring agency shall open all bids in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend, at the time, on the date, and at the place specified in the Bid Data Sheet. The bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register/attendance sheet evidencing their attendance.

16.2 The bidders' names, bid modifications or withdrawals, bid prices, discounts, and the presence or absence of requisite bid security and such other details as the Procuring agency may consider appropriate will be announced at the opening.

17. Clarification of Bids

During an evaluation of the bids, the Procuring agency may ask the Bidder for a clarification of its bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing, and no change in the prices or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted.

18. Preliminary Examination

18.1 The Procuring agency shall examine the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed and whether the bids are generally in order.

18.2 Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail, and the total price shall be corrected. If the Supplier does not accept the correction of the errors, its bid will be rejected, and its bid security may be forfeited.
