

Bidding documents for above works will be issued from date of issuance of this NIT and can be obtained from office of the undersigned on any working day up to **17.04.2026** upon submission of a written application and payment of tender fee (non-refundable) (in cash or in the shape of Pay Order in favour of undersigned) in PK rupees. The Bidding Documents are also available on SPPRA's PPMS website (www.ppms.pprasingh.gov.pk).
3. Envelope containing bidding documents shall be marked as "**TECHNICAL & FINANCIAL PROPOSAL**" in bold and legible letters to avoid confusion and will be received back/submitted on **17.04.2026 up to 1:00 p.m.** The same shall be opened on the **same day at 3:00 p.m** in the presence of Procurement Committee, interested bidders/firms or their authorized representatives.
4. In case of un-responded bids/tenders, the bidding documents will be re-issued up to next date i.e **28-04-2026**. Proposals (Financial & Technical) will be received back/submitted on **29-04-2026 upto 1:00 p.m** and will be opened on the **same day at 3:00 p.m** in the presence of Procurement Committee, interested bidders/firms or their authorized representatives.
