Furniture & Fixtures, 2. Plant & Machinery and 3. Hardware** Equipment for the Financial Year 2025-26. Only those bidders having relevant experience, proven technical capability, and sound financial standing in the supply of similar goods are eligible to participate in the bidding process. Interested bidders must possess valid and active registration certificates, including National Tax Number (NTN), Sales Tax Registration Number (STRN) issued by Federal Board of Revenue, and Sindh Sales Tax Registration with Sindh Revenue Board (where applicable) strictly in accordance with the provisions of the Sindh Public Procurement Rules, 2010 (amended up to date). The procurement process shall be carried out under Rule 46(1) – Single Stage – One Envelope Procedure of the Sindh Public Procurement Rules, 2010.

**Eligibility/ Evaluation Criteria**

- I. Copy of CNIC of Owners / Proprietors / CEO / Board Members.
- II. Copy of FBR Registration Certificate bearing National Tax Number (NTN) and Sales Tax Registration Number (STRN).
- III. Copy of Registration with Sindh Revenue Board (SRB) bearing Sindh Sales Tax Number (SSTN).
- IV. Copy of FBR Active Taxpayer List (ATL) Status (latest) for both Income Tax and Sales Tax.
- V. Copy of submitted tax returns for the last three (03) financial years, including:
  - a. Income Tax Returns
  - b. Sales Tax Returns
  - c. Sindh Sales Tax Returns
- VI. Copy of Bank Statement showing annual turnover of at least 50% per year of the estimated cost (as stated in APP) for the last three (03) years and at least 10 million amount as a closing balance in firm contractor/company bank account corresponding to the offered bid (s).
- VII. Copy of Annual Audited Financial Statements / Audit Reports for the last three (03) financial years, duly issued by International / Global Associations of Auditors or Chartered Accountancy Firms. Reports from other sources shall not be accepted.
- VIII. The bidder must have at least five (10) years of experience in contracts of a similar nature and must have been awarded and successfully executed at least three (03) work contracts of similar nature during the last three (03) years. The bidder shall provide a complete company profile clearly depicting the chronology of work orders, supply orders issued by various organizations, along with copies of relevant work orders, supply orders, completion certificates, and other documentary evidence demonstrating the successful execution and completion of the aforementioned works.
- IX. Catalogue / Brochure / Technical Literature (original) and Dealership Authorization Letter from the Principal / Manufacturer's Representative, where applicable.
- X. Office / Workshop facility in Sindh (Complete Address with phone, Fax, Email).
- XI. Relevant Skilled Human Capital "Complete Bio Data CV"
- XI. Affidavits:
  - a. Undertaking on Judicial E-Stamp Paper stating that the firm has not been blacklisted by any public sector organization or government department.
  - b. Undertaking on Judicial E-Stamp Paper stating that the firm is not involved in any litigation and has not abandoned any work in any public sector organization or government department.
- XII. Tender Earnest Money / Bid Security amounting to 5% of the total bid value (refundable) in the form of Banker's Cheque / CDR / Pay Order in favor of "DDO PDM&I Cell, CTA&AD, Government of Sindh."
- XIII. Each page of the tender / bidding document must be duly signed and stamped by the firm / bidder. Conditional bids shall not be considered.
- XIV. Pay Order / Demand Draft / Receipt of Rs. 3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only) in favor of "DDO PDM&I Cell, CTA&AD, Government of Sindh" as non-refundable bid document fee. Note: Rates quoted must be inclusive of all prevalent taxes, providing, transportation and fixing installation.
- XV. Bids submitted by firms failing to meet the prescribed eligibility criteria or lacking the required documentation shall be rejected as non-responsive.

The Procuring Agency reserves the right to verify, authenticate, and cross-check any or all documents submitted by the bidder and may conduct site visits, if deemed necessary, to ascertain the authenticity of the information provided and the technical and financial capability of the firm. Bidders shall submit the Technical Standards Specifications for each quoted item on the company's official letterhead, duly signed and stamped by the authorized representative. Any bidder found to have submitted false, misleading, fabricated, or unsubstantiated information shall be declared non-responsive and liable to disqualification, and legal action may be initiated if any forged or fraudulent document is detected at any stage of the procurement process in accordance with applicable laws and the provisions of the Sindh Public Procurement Rules, 2010. Furthermore, bid documents submitted without adequate documentary evidence or without fulfilling the prescribed Eligibility / Evaluation Criteria checklist shall be treated as incomplete, declared non-responsive, and rejected during the preliminary evaluation stage.

9. Bid Security
- 9.1 The bid security is required to protect the procuring agency against the risk of Bidder's conduct, which would warrant the security's forfeiture. The bid security shall be denominated in the currency of the bid:
- a. at the Bidder's option, be in the form of either demand draft/call deposit or an unconditional bank guarantee from a reputable bank;
  - b. be submitted in its original form; copies will not be accepted;
  - c. remain valid for a period of at least 28 days beyond the original validity period of bids, or at least 28 days beyond any extended period of bid validity
- 9.2 Bid security shall be released to the unsuccessful bidders once the contract has been signed with the successful bidder or the validity period has expired.
- 9.3 The successful bidder's bid security shall be discharged upon the Bidder signing the contract, and furnishing the performance security.
- 9.4 The bid security may be forfeited:
- a. if a Bidder withdraws its bid during the period of bid validity or
  - b. in the case of a successful Bidder, if the Bidder fails:
    - i. to sign the contract in accordance or
    - ii. to furnish performance security
10. Period of Validity of Bids
- 10.1 Bids shall remain valid for the period specified in the Bid Data Sheet after the date of bid opening prescribed by the procuring agency. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the procuring agency as non-responsive.
- 10.2 In exceptional circumstances, the Procuring agency may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing. The bid security shall also be suitably extended. A bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its bid security. A Bidder granting the request will not be required nor permitted to modify its bid.
11. Format and Signing of Bid
- 11.1 The bidder shall prepare an original and the number of copies of the bid indicated in the Bid Data Sheet, clearly marking each "ORIGINAL BID" and "COPY OF BID," as appropriate. In the event of any discrepancy between them, the original shall govern.
- 11.2 The original and the copy or copies of the bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by the Bidder or a person or persons duly authorized to bind the Bidder to the contract. All pages of the bid, except for unamend printed literature, shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the bid.
- 11.3 Any interlineations, erasures, or overwriting shall be valid only if they are initialed by the person or persons signing the bid.

12. Sealing and Marking of Bids
- 12.1 The bidder shall seal the original bid. The envelope shall be addressed to the Procuring agency at the address given in the Bid Data Sheet with statement.
- 12.2 If the outer envelope is not sealed and marked as required, the procuring agency shall assume no responsibility for the bid's misplacement or premature opening.
13. Deadline for Submission of Bids
- 13.1 Bids must be received by the Procuring agency at the address specified in Bid Data Sheet, not later than the time and date specified in the Bid Data Sheet.
- 13.2 The Procuring agency may, at its discretion, extend this deadline for the submission of bids by amending the bidding documents. In such case all rights and obligations of the Procuring agency and bidders previously subject to the deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.
14. Late Bids
- 14.1 Any bid received by the Procuring agency after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the Procuring agency shall be rejected and returned unopened to the Bidder.
15. Modification and Withdrawal of Bids
- 15.1 The Bidder may modify or withdraw its bid after the bid's submission, provided that written notice of the modification, including substitution or withdrawal of the bids, is received by the Procuring agency prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of bids.
- 15.2 No bid may be modified after the deadline for submission of bids.
- 15.3 No bid may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and the expiry of the period of bid validity. Withdrawal of a bid during this interval may result in forfeiture of bid security.

### OPENING & EVALUATION OF BIDS

16. Opening of Bids by the Procuring Agency
- 16.1 The Procuring agency shall open all bids in the presence of bidders' representatives who choose to attend, at the time, on the date, and at the place specified in the Bid Data Sheet. The bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register/attendance sheet evidencing their attendance.
- 16.2 The bidders' names, bid modifications or withdrawals, bid prices, discounts, and the presence or absence of requisite bid security and such other details as the Procuring agency, at its discretion, may consider appropriate, will be announced at the opening.
17. Clarification of Bids
- 17.1 During evaluation of the bids, the Procuring agency may, at its discretion, ask the Bidder for a clarification of its bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing, and no change in the prices or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted.
18. Preliminary Examination
- 18.1 The Procuring agency shall examine the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether the bids are generally in order.
- 18.2 Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail, and the total price shall be corrected. If the Supplier does not accept the correction of the errors, its bid will be rejected, and its bid security may be forfeited. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail.
- 18.3 Prior to the detailed evaluation, the Procuring agency will determine the substantial responsiveness of each bid to the bidding documents. A substantially responsive bid is one which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the bidding documents without material deviations. Procuring agency's determination of a bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the bid itself.



- 18.4 If a bid is not substantially responsive, it will be rejected by the Procuring agency and may not subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder by correction of the nonconformity.
19. Evaluation and Comparison of Bids
- 19.1 The Procuring agency will evaluate and compare the bids which have been determined to be substantially responsive.
- 19.2 The Procuring agency's evaluation of a bid will be on delivery to consignee's end inclusive of all taxes, stamps, duties, levies, fees and installation and integration charges imposed till the delivery location and shall exclude any allowance for price adjustment during the period of execution of the contract.
20. Contracting the Procuring Agency
- 20.1 No Bidder shall contact the Procuring agency on any matter relating to its bid, from the time of the bid opening to the time the announcement of Bid Evaluation Report. If the Bidder wishes to bring additional information to the notice of the Procuring agency, it should do so in writing.
- 20.2 Any effort by a Bidder to influence the Procuring agency in its decisions on bid evaluation, bid comparison, or contract award may result in the rejection of the Bidder's bid.
- AWARD OF CONTRACT**
21. Post-Qualification
- 21.1 In the absence of prequalification, the Procuring agency may determine to its satisfaction whether that selected Bidder having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive bid is qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily.
- 21.2 The determination will take into account the Bidder's financial, technical, and production capabilities. It will be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications submitted by the Bidder, pursuant to ITB Clause 7 as well as such other information as the Procuring agency deems necessary and appropriate.
- 21.3 An affirmative determination will be a prerequisite for award of the contract to the Bidder. A negative determination will result in rejection of the Bidder's bid, in which event the Procuring agency will proceed to the next lowest evaluated bid to make a similar determination of that Bidder's capabilities to perform satisfactorily.
22. Award of Contract
- 22.1 The Procuring agency will award the contract to the successful Bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and has been determined to be the lowest evaluated bid, provided further that the Bidder is determined to be qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily.
23. Procuring Agency's Right to Accept any Bid and to Reject any or all Bids
- 23.1 Subject to relevant provisions of SPP Rules 2010 (Amended 2019), the Procuring agency reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to contract award.
- 23.2 Pursuant to Rule 45 of SPP Rules 2010 (Amended 2019), Procuring agency shall host the evaluation report on Authority's website, and intimate to all the bidders three days prior to notify the award of contract
24. Notification of Award
- 24.1 Prior to the expiration of the period of bid validity, the Procuring agency shall notify the successful Bidder in writing, that its bid has been accepted.
- 24.2 Upon the successful Bidder's furnishing of the performance security pursuant to ITB Clause 26, the Procuring agency will promptly notify each unsuccessful Bidder and will discharge its bid security.
25. Signing of Contract
- 25.1 At the same time as the Procuring agency notifies the successful bidder that its bid has been accepted, the Procuring agency will send the Bidder the Contract Form provided in the bidding documents, incorporating all agreements between the parties.



26. Performance Security 26.1 Within seven (7) days, or any other period specified in Bid Data Sheet, of the receipt of notification of award from the Procuring agency, the successful Bidder shall furnish the performance security in accordance with the Conditions of Contract, in the Performance Security Form provided in the bidding documents, or in another form acceptable to the Procuring agency.
- 26.2 Failure of the successful Bidder to comply with the requirement of ITB Clause 25 shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the bid security, in which event the Procuring agency may make the award to the next lowest evaluated Bidder or call for new bids.
27. Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices 27.1 The Government of Sindh requires that procuring agency's (including beneficiaries of donor agencies' loans), as well as bidders/ suppliers/ contractors under Government-financed contracts, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. In pursuance of this policy, the SPPRA, in accordance with the SPP Act, 2009 and Rules made thereunder:
- a. "**Corrupt and Fraudulent Practices**" means either one or any combination of the practices given below;
    - (i) "**Coercive Practice**" means any impairing or harming, or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or the property of the party to influence the actions of a party to achieve a wrongful gain or to cause a wrongful loss to another party;
    - (ii) "**Collusive Practice**" means any arrangement between two or more parties to the procurement process or contract execution, designed to achieve with or without the knowledge of the procuring agency to establish prices at artificial, noncompetitive levels for any wrongful gain;
    - (iii) "**Corrupt Practice**" means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence the acts of another party for wrongful gain;
    - (iv) "**Fraudulent Practice**" means any act or omission, including a misrepresentation, that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, a party to obtain a financial or other benefit or to avoid an obligation;
  - b. "**Obstructive Practice**" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in a procurement process, or affect the execution of a contract or deliberately destroying, falsifying, altering or concealing of evidence material to the investigation or making false statements before investigators in order to materially impede an investigation into allegations of a corrupt, fraudulent, coercive or collusive practice; or threatening, harassing or intimidating any party to prevent it from disclosing its knowledge of matters relevant to the investigation or from pursuing the investigation, or acts intended to materially impede the exercise of inspection and audit rights provided for under the Rules.

1. Definitions
  - 1.1 In this Contract, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated:
    - (a) "The Contract" means the agreement entered into between the Procuring agency and the Supplier, as recorded in the Contract Form signed by the parties, including all attachments and appendices thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.
    - (b) "The Contract Price" means the price payable to the Supplier under the Contract for the full and proper performance of its contractual obligations.
    - (c) "The Goods" means all of the equipment, machinery, and/or other materials which the Supplier is required to supply to the Procuring agency under the Contract.
    - (d) "The Services" means those services ancillary to the supply of the Goods, such as transportation and insurance, and any other incidental services, such as installation, commissioning, provision of technical assistance, training, and other such obligations of the Supplier covered under the Contract.
    - (e) "GCC" mean the General Conditions of Contract contained in this section.
    - (f) "SCC" means the Special Conditions of Contract.
    - (g) "The Procuring agency" means the organization purchasing the Goods, as named in SCC.
    - (h) "The Procuring agency's country" is the country named in SCC.
    - (i) "The Supplier" means the individual or firm supplying the Goods and Services under this Contract.
    - (j) "The Project Site," where applicable, means the place or places named in SCC.
    - (k) "Day" means calendar day.
  - 2.1 These General Conditions shall apply to the extent that they are not superseded by provisions of other parts of the Contract.
2. Application
  - 3.1 All Goods and Services supplied under the Contract shall have their origin in the countries and territories eligible under the rules and further elaborated in the SCC.
  - 3.2 For purposes of this Clause, "origin" means the place where the Goods were mined, grown, or produced, or from which the Services are supplied. Goods are produced when, through manufacturing, processing, or substantial and major assembly of components, a commercially recognized new product results that is substantially different in basic characteristics or in purpose or utility from its components.
  - 3.3 The origin of Goods and Services is distinct from the nationality of the Supplier.
3. Country of Origin
  - 4.1 The Goods supplied under this Contract shall conform to the standards mentioned in the Technical Specifications, and, when no applicable standard is mentioned, to the authoritative standards appropriate to the Goods' country of origin. Such standards shall be the latest issued by the concerned institution.
4. Conformance
  - 5.1 The Supplier shall not, without the Procuring agency's prior written consent, disclose the Contract, or any provision thereof, or any specification, plan, drawing, pattern, sample, or information furnished by or on behalf of the Procuring agency in connection therewith, to any person other than a person employed by the Supplier in the performance of the Contract. Disclosure to any such employed person shall be made in confidence and shall extend only so far as may be necessary for purposes of such performance.
  - 5.2 The Supplier shall not, without the Procuring agency's prior written consent, make use of any document or information enumerated in GCC Clause 5.1 except for purposes of performing the Contract.
5. Use of Contract Documents and Information; Inspection and Audit by the Government



- 5.3 Any document, other than the Contract itself, enumerated in GCC Clause 5.1 shall remain the property of the Procuring agency and shall be returned (all copies) to the Procuring agency on completion of the Supplier's performance under the Contract if so required by the Procuring agency.
- 5.4 The Supplier shall permit the Procuring agency to inspect the Supplier's accounts and records relating to the performance of the Supplier and to have them audited by auditors appointed by the procuring agency, if so required.
6. Patent Rights
- 6.1 The Supplier shall indemnify the Procuring agency against all third-party claims of infringement of patent, trademark, or industrial design rights arising from use of the Goods or any part thereof in the Procuring agency's country.
7. Performance Security
- 7.1 Within seven (07) days of receipt of the notification of Contract award, the successful Bidder shall furnish to the Procuring agency the performance security in the amount specified in SCC.
- 7.2 The proceeds of the performance security shall be payable to the Procuring agency as compensation for any loss resulting from the Supplier's failure to complete its obligations under the Contract.
- 7.3 The performance security shall be denominated in the currency of the Contract acceptable to the Procuring agency and shall only be in the following form:
- a. Bank pay order /demand draft issued by a reputable bank located in the Procuring agency's country, in the form provided in the bidding documents or another form acceptable to the Procuring agency.
- 7.4 The performance security will be discharged by the Procuring agency and returned to the Supplier not later than thirty (30) days following the date of completion of the Supplier's performance obligations under the Contract, including any warranty obligations, unless specified otherwise in SCC.
8. Inspection and Tests
- 8.1 The Procuring agency or its representative shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the Goods to confirm their conformity to the Contract specifications at no extra cost to the Procuring agency. SCC and the Technical Specifications shall specify what inspections and tests the Procuring agency requires and where they are to be conducted. The Procuring agency shall notify the Supplier in writing, in a timely manner, of the identity of any representatives retained for these purposes.
- 8.2 The inspections and tests may be conducted on the premises of the Supplier or its subcontractor(s), at point of delivery, and/or at the Goods' final destination. If conducted on the premises of the Supplier or its subcontractor(s), all reasonable facilities and assistance, including access to drawings and production data, shall be furnished to the inspectors at no charge to the Procuring agency.
- 8.3 Should any inspected or tested Goods fail to conform to the Specifications, the Procuring agency may reject the Goods, and the Supplier shall either replace the rejected Goods or make alterations necessary to meet specification requirements free of cost to the Procuring agency.
- 8.4 The Procuring agency's right to inspect, test and, where necessary, reject the Goods after the Goods' arrival in the Procuring agency's country shall in no way be limited or waived by reason of the Goods having previously been inspected, tested, and passed by the Procuring agency or its representative prior to the Goods' shipment from the country of origin.
- 8.5 Nothing in GCC Clause 8 shall in any way release the Supplier from any warranty or other obligations under this Contract.

15. Warranty

- 15.1 The Supplier warrants that the Goods supplied under the Contract are new, unused, of the most recent or current models, and that they incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials unless provided otherwise in the Contract. The Supplier further warrants that all Goods supplied under this Contract shall have no defect, arising from design, materials, or workmanship (except when the design and/or material is required by the Procuring agency's specifications) or from any act or omission of the Supplier, that may develop under normal use of the supplied Goods in the conditions prevailing in the country of final destination.
- 15.2 This warranty shall remain valid for twelve (12) months after the Goods, or any portion thereof as the case may be, have been delivered to and accepted at the final destination indicated in the Contract, or for eighteen (18) months after the date of shipment from the port or place of loading in the source country, whichever period concludes earlier, unless specified otherwise in SCC.
- 15.3 The Procuring agency shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty.
- 15.4 Upon receipt of such notice, the Supplier shall, within the period specified in SCC and with all reasonable speed, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof, without costs to the Procuring agency.
- 15.5 If the Supplier, having been notified, fails to remedy the defect(s) within the period specified in SCC, within a reasonable period, the Procuring agency may proceed to take such remedial action as may be necessary, at the Supplier's risk and expense and without prejudice to any other rights which the Procuring agency may have against the Supplier under the Contract.

16. Payment

- 16.1 The method and conditions of payment to be made to the Supplier under this Contract shall be specified in SCC.
- 16.2 The Supplier's request(s) for payment shall be made to the Procuring agency in writing, accompanied by an invoice describing, as appropriate, the Goods delivered and Services performed, and by documents submitted pursuant to GCC Clause 10, and upon fulfillment of other obligations stipulated in the Contract.
- 16.3 Payments shall be made promptly by the Procuring agency, but in no case later than sixty (60) days after submission of an invoice or claim by the Supplier.
- 16.4 The currency of payment is Pakistani Rupees.

17. Prices

- 17.1 Prices charged by the Supplier for Goods delivered and Services performed under the Contract shall not vary from the prices quoted by the Supplier in its bid, with the exception of any price adjustments authorized in SCC or in the Procuring agency's request for bid validity extension, as the case may be.

18. Change Orders

- 18.1 The Procuring agency may at any time, by a written order given to the Supplier pursuant to GCC Clause 31, make changes within the general scope of the Contract in any one or more of the following:
- Drawings, designs, or specifications, where Goods to be furnished under the Contract are to be specifically manufactured for the Procuring agency;
  - the method of shipment or packing;
  - the place of delivery; and/or
  - The Services to be provided by the Supplier.
- 18.2 If any such change causes an increase or decrease in the cost of, or the time required for, the Supplier's performance of any provisions under the Contract, an equitable adjustment shall be made in the Contract Price or delivery schedule, or both, and the Contract shall accordingly be amended. Any claims by the Supplier for adjustment under this clause must be asserted within thirty (30) days from the date of the Supplier's receipt of the Procuring agency's change order.

25. Force Majeure
- 25.1 Notwithstanding the provisions of GCC Clauses 22, 23, and 24, the Supplier shall not be liable for forfeiture of its performance security, liquidated damages, or termination for default if and to the extent that it's delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the Contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure.
- 25.2 For purposes of this clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the Supplier and not involving the Supplier's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include, but are not restricted to, acts of the Procuring agency in its sovereign capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, and freight embargoes.
- 25.3 If a Force Majeure situation arises, the Supplier shall promptly notify the Procuring agency in writing of such condition and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the Procuring agency in writing, the Supplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the Contract as far as is reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event.
26. Termination Insolvency for
- 26.1 The Procuring agency may at any time terminate the Contract by giving written notice to the Supplier if the Supplier becomes bankrupt or otherwise insolvent. In this event, termination will be without compensation to the Supplier, provided that such termination will not prejudice or affect any right of action or remedy which has accrued or will accrue thereafter to the Procuring agency.
27. Termination Convenience for
- 27.1 The Procuring agency, by written notice sent to the Supplier, may terminate the Contract, in whole or in part, at any time for its convenience. The notice of termination shall specify that termination is for the Procuring agency's convenience, the extent to which performance of the Supplier under the Contract is terminated, and the date upon which such termination becomes effective.
- 27.2 The Goods that are complete and ready for shipment within thirty (30) days after the Supplier's receipt of notice of termination shall be accepted by the Procuring agency at the Contract terms and prices. For the remaining Goods, the Procuring agency may elect:
- to have any portion completed and delivered at the Contract terms and prices; and/or
  - to cancel the remainder and pay to the Supplier an agreed amount for partially completed Goods and Services and for materials and parts previously procured by the Supplier.
28. Resolution Disputes of
- 28.1 The Procuring agency and the Supplier shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the Contract.
- 28.2 If, after thirty (30) days from the commencement of such informal negotiations, the Procuring agency and the Supplier have been unable to resolve amicably a Contract dispute, either party may require that the dispute be referred for resolution to the formal mechanisms specified in SCC. These mechanisms may include, but are not restricted to, conciliation mediated by a third party, adjudication in an agreed manner and/or arbitration.
29. Governing Language
- 29.1 The Contract shall be written in the language specified in SCC. Subject to GCC Clause 30, the version of the Contract written in the specified language shall govern its interpretation. All correspondence and other documents pertaining to the Contract which are exchanged by the parties shall be written in the same language.



30. Applicable Law            30.1 The Contract shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Procuring agency's country, unless otherwise specified in SCC.
31. Notices                    31.1 Any notice given by one party to the other pursuant to this Contract shall be sent to the other party in writing or by cable, telex, or facsimile and confirmed in writing to the other party's address specified in SCC.
- 31.2 A notice shall be effective when delivered or on the notice's effective date, whichever is later.
32. Taxes and Duties        32.1 Supplier shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, license fees, etc., incurred until delivery of the contracted Goods to the Procuring agency.
