

Senate body to look into PMDC matters

ISLAMABAD Senate Standing Committee on National Health Services on Thursday set up a subcommittee to review matters related to Pakistan Medical and Dental Council (PMDC).

The meeting, chaired by Senator Amir Waliuddin Chishti, was attended by Senator Amir Waliuddin Chishti, Mustafa Kamal, CIO of the Federal Health Minister of Pakistan (Dr. Dr.), Executive Director of NIH, and the PMDC president.

Senator Amir Chishti said that he did not want any conflict of interest in the process. The subcommittee will be headed by Senator Anusha Rahman, while Senator Agha Shahzad Durrani, Rahat Jamali, and Mustafa Kamal will be its members.

Mustafa Kamal informed the committee that, following the committee's directions, arrangements were being made to conduct the Medical and Dental Colleges Admission Test (MDCAT) at the earliest.

He noted that educational boards have separate examination schedules, adding that the final MDCAT examinations will conclude on July 20, while the MDCAT will be held on Aug 16. The minister further stated that the government aimed to eliminate the "MDCAT preparation mafia" and ensure a transparent examination system.

The committee members criticised the sharp increase in medicine prices across the country. During the briefing, officials informed the committee that medicine prices were deregulated during the caretaker government in 2024, allowing pharmaceutical companies to independently determine prices.

It was further revealed that prices of various medicines had increased by up to 100 percent over the past two years.

Officials explained that under the current law, Drap can regulate prices only for essential life-saving medicines. The minister clarified that the health ministry has no direct role in increasing or decreasing medicine prices.

The committee directed the head of Drap to formulate a clear pricing mechanism for medicines and also decided to summon officials from the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics in the next meeting.

Committee members remarked that the pharmaceutical business appeared to be among the most profitable sectors in Pakistan and stressed that giving pharmaceutical companies unrestricted authority to determine medicine prices was unacceptable. They emphasised the need to review the existing law.

During the briefing, Drap Chief Dr. Obaidullah Malik informed the committee that there were currently 659 pharmaceutical companies operating in Pakistan, while 394 institutions import medicines and vaccines from abroad.

AJK High Court stays POS enforcement against hotels

MUZAFFARABAD The Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK) High Court on Thursday granted status quo relief to nine major hotels and restaurants in Muzaffarabad that had challenged the Central Board of Revenue's (CBR) campaign to enforce installation and integration of Point of Sale (POS), digital invoicing and electronic monitoring systems in the hospitality sector.

Justice Syed Shahid Bahar, the senior puisne judge, passed the order while hearing a writ petition filed under

Article 44 of the AJK Interim Constitution, 1974 by nine hotels and restaurants operating in Muzaffarabad, and filed May 21 for further proceedings.

Represented by Barrister Kamran Ilyas Raja, the petitioners contended that they were not opposed to lawful taxation of hotel and hospitality services, but challenged the CBR's attempt to extend the POS and electronic monitoring regime to hotels under Section 40C of the Sales Tax Act, 1998, and Chapter XIV-A of the Sales Tax Rules, 2006.

The petition argued that Section 40C

was framed primarily in the context of production, sales, clearances, stocks and taxable goods, and could not automatically be applied to service providers without explicit statutory authority.

It further maintained that the service sector in AJK was separately governed under the AJK Sales Tax (Tax on Services) Act, 2001, and that subordinate legislation, including Rules 1502A, 1502B and 1502C, could not enlarge the scope of the parent statute.

The petitioners also questioned the legal basis for extending the imposed regime to hotels, arguing that the authorities had failed to identify any

notification, SRO, circular or gazette instrument authorising such application.

They sought declarations that the POS enforcement regime, insofar as it applied to hotels and hospitality businesses, was without lawful authority, and prayed that the authorities be restrained from sealing premises, imposing penalties or taking coercive action except strictly in accordance with law.

After the preliminary hearing, the judge granted status quo in favour of the petitioners, effectively providing enforcement protection against "coercive enforcement measures" until the next hearing.

Parental violence against children on the rise: Sparc

ISLAMABAD While there are less than 500 clinical psychologists and approximately 270 to 400 psychiatrists for a population exceeding 240 million, violence by parents against children in Pakistan is becoming a widespread issue with reports indicating it is often treated as a private family matter rather than a social crisis.

Though the government has passed progressive laws in recent and preceding years, there is an increasing need to address the deeply intertwined societal and mental health needs in the country. This was stated by Society for the Protection of the Rights of the Child (Sparc) in a statement. Data, collected through secondary research, shows that the country is witnessing tragic cases of murders by family members, including parents.

"During June 2025, a father with a history of torturing his children beat his 18-month-old daughter to death at Chaklala, Rawalpindi. Medical reports revealed severe torture. Through the same month, a man blamed his wife of poisoning three children to death in Rawalpindi.

Another case was registered against parents on torturing a minor girl in Dhiamal, Rawalpindi where police intervened upon receiving a call by neighbours," it stated.

"August saw the arrest of a mother killing her two children with a knife in Karachi's Defence area. In Khewra town, Pind Dadan Khan, two children were strangled to death in October with police detaining both parents. In December, a father poisoned his three children in Abbottabad.

More recently, children found dead with slit throats in Lahore shook the whole country. These reported cases are only the tip of an iceberg whereas situation can be more precarious in areas with under-reporting of such

cases," it stated.

"Driven by factors such as poverty, mental health struggles, domestic disputes, including divorce, re-marriage jealousies, broken families and deep-seated cultural issues such as son preference, these children paid the price," lamented Ailya Arif, Sparc's Executive Director.

Clinical psychologist Tuba Zafar highlighted the shortage of mental health professionals in the country with reportedly less than 500 clinical psychologists and approximately 270 to 400 psychiatrists for a population exceeding 240 million people.

"SPARC believes the deeply concerning reality demands urgent attention to parents' emotional well-being and more pro-active efforts on part of both government and the society. In the past, the dangers threatening children were often perceived as existing outside the home; today, we are increasingly witnessing how unresolved trauma, severe emotional distress, violence and ongoing family conflicts within the home can place children at a serious risk. When parents are overwhelmed, unsupported, or struggling with untreated mental health challenges, the impact on children can be profound and devastating. Prioritising mental health support for parents is therefore not only critical for adult well-being, but essential for protecting children and fostering safer, healthier family environments," she said.

Sparc called for enhanced mental health and child protection reforms. A proactive social protection services would mean families in crisis can be reached in time. Community in general and society in particular has a role to play when violence against children is already rising, it added.

Nawaz summons ticket aspirants for AJK polls

MUZAFFARABAD Pakistan Muslim League-Nawaz (PML-N) President and former prime minister Nawaz Sharif has summoned party ticket aspirants for the upcoming Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK) elections to Lahore on Friday (today), party sources said.

More than 205 PML-N leaders and activists from 33 constituencies in AJK and 12 in Pakistan, reserved for the refugees from occupied Jammu and Kashmir, have applied for party tickets. They have been directed to appear before the parliamentary board at 11:30am at the party's Model Town office, a party leader told Dawn on Thursday.

Prior to this, the 24-member parliamentary board will hold its first formal meeting at 11am with Mr Sharif in the chair. The board, constituted by him on April 16, has been tasked with scrutinising and finalising candidates for the polls due in July.

Headed by Mr Sharif, the board includes Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif, Deputy Prime Minister Ishaq Dar, Punjab Chief Minister Maryam Nawaz Sharif, and federal ministers Ahsan Iqbal, Khawaja Asif, Amir Muqam and Rana Sanaullah.

Other members include former ministers Senator Pervaiz Rashid, Senator Anusha Rahman, Khawaja Saad Rafique, Chaudhry Barjees Tahir, Hamza Shehbaz, Murray Aurangzeb and retired Capt Muhammad Saldar. Former MNA Chaudhry Abid Raza was also added to the panel recently.

The AJK representation comprises the party's regional president Shah Ghulam Qadir, former AJK prime minister Raja Farooq Haider, Mushraaq Ahmad Minhas, Chaudhry Muhammad Saeed, Chaudhry Tariq Farooq, Dr Najeeb Naqi, Barrister Itikhar Gillani and Chaudhry Abdul Rehman Arain.

Earlier this year, Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif had also constituted a nine-member political committee comprising federal ministers and AJK based leaders to shape party policy and oversee political affairs related to the region.

In February, the committee's AJK members held consultations with prospective candidates at divisional headquarters across the territory, while separate consultations with aspirants from among Pakistan-based Kashmiri refugees were held in Rawalpindi.

Party sources said the committee had completed most of the groundwork regarding prospective candidates in the 33 AJK constituencies.

The bid prepared by the Bidder, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the bid exchanged by the Bidder and the Procuring agency, shall be written in the English language
- 2. Language of Bid**
- 3. Documents Comprising the Bid** The bid prepared by the Bidder shall comprise the following components:
 - (a) Price Schedule completed in accordance with ITB Clauses 4, 5 and 6.
 - (b) Bid security furnished in accordance with ITB Clause 9.
- 4. Bid Prices**
 - 4.1 The Bidder shall indicate on the appropriate Price Schedule the unit prices (where applicable) and total bid price of the equipment it proposes to supply under the contract.
 - 4.2 The prices shall be quoted on delivery to the consignee's end inclusive of all taxes, stamps, duties, levies, fees and installation and integration charges imposed till the delivery location specified in the Schedule of Requirements. OPENING AND EVALUATION OF BIDS

- 16. Opening of Bids by the Procuring agency**

The bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register/attendance sheet evidencing their attendance.

- 17. Clarification of Bids**
- During an evaluation of the bids, the Procuring agency may ask the Bidder for a clarification of its bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing, and no change in the prices or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted.
- 18. Preliminary Examination**
- 18.1 The Procuring agency shall examine the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed and whether the bids are generally in order.
- 18.2 Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail, and the total price shall be corrected. If the Supplier does not accept the correction of the errors, its bid will be rejected, and its bid security may be forfeited. 25. Signing of Contract

26. Performance Security
