1 About the Company/ Client/ Procuring Agency

Government of Sindh has established Sindh Economic Zones Management Company (SEZMC) to institutionally facilitate, promote, encourage and enhance the industrial base in the province.

2 Instructions for APPLICANTS

This document contains all the information pertinent to our solicitation, and governs the preparation and submission of application. The forms to be filled by the applicant for the assignment are annexed with this document. Applications must be submitted by the deadline, completed in the formats provided by the Company, with supporting documents, according to the guidelines given in the document titled **Instructions to Applicant**. The proposals will be evaluated by a committee constituted by the company. The shortlisting will be based on the evaluation of documentary proof provided by applicants.

3 Solicitation Document

3.1 Contents

The APPLICANT is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications contained in the document and its annexures. Failure to comply with instructions will be at the APPLICANT's risk and may affect the evaluation of the proposal. Proposals that do not comprehensively address the TORs and requirements may be rejected. Inability to comply with the corresponding instructions, terms and specifications may lead to rejection of the proposal.

In the event of non-compliance with the TORs of the document and obligations contained in the agreement, the Company may terminate the license by providing 01 month's written notice to the successful APPLICANT without any further obligation or compensation on the part of the Company.

4 Preparation of Proposal/ Applications

4.1 Language of the Proposal

The proposals prepared by the APPLICANTS and all correspondence and documents relating to the proposal exchanged between the APPLICANTS and the Company shall be in writing and in the English Language.

4.2 Period of Validity of Proposal

Proposals shall remain valid for 120 days from the date of submission of proposal as provided in the CRITERIA document. In exceptional circumstances, Company may solicit the APPLICANT's consent to an extension of the period of validity without any material changes in the bidding document.

4.3 Supporting Documents

While preparing the Proposal, the bidding firm shall ensure that it provides the Company with documentary evidence. The evaluation committee will evaluate the bids on the basis of their responsiveness, applying the qualification/ eligibility criteria. A proposal shall be rejected at this stage if it does not respond to important aspects of this document or if it fails to comply with any requirement of Selection Criteria.

4.4 Cost of Preparing Proposal

The costs of preparing the proposal are not reimbursable.

4.5 Proposal Documents

The proposal should be in binder form with a serial number on each page.

4.6 Format and Authorization

The proposal shall contain no interlineations, erasures, or overwriting, except, as necessary to correct errors made by the APPLICANT, in which case such corrections shall be initiated by the APPLICANT's authorized person. The proposals shall be clear and elaborate. Different parts of the proposals shall be separated using color separators, flags or tags

An authorized representative of the Consultants shall stamp and sign the original submission letters in the required format for the Proposal and shall initial and stamp all pages of Proposal. The written authorization on letter head must be attached to the Proposal.

5 Submission, Receipt and Opening of Proposal/ Application

- 5.1 APPLICANT is required to submit Proposal along with all supporting documents.
- 5.2 The Proposal shall be placed in a sealed envelope and shall bear the submission address and title of the assignment **“APPLICATION FOR SHORTLISTING FIRM”** and clearly marked **“DO NOT OPEN BEFORE SUBMISSION DEADLINE”**. The proposal should contain one original and one true copy. The Company shall not be responsible for misplacement, loss or premature opening if the envelope is not sealed and/or marked as stipulated. This circumstance may be the case for Proposal rejection.
- 5.3 The Proposal must be sent to the given address and received by the Company not later than the time and the date indicated in the CRITERIA document.
- 5.4 Any proposal received by the Company after the deadline for submission shall be returned unopened.
- 5.5 Delayed / conditional Proposals shall not be entertained.
- 5.6 This CRITERIA comprises detailed information about the services requested as well as information to help applicants in the formulation of their proposals. While every effort has been made to ensure that the information contained in this document is accurate, it may not contain all of the information needed by the applicants. Queries of the applicants seeking clarifications must be received in writing or through e-mail to the Company before opening.
- 5.7 The Company reserves the right to edit, revise, delete, update, or cancel any or all conditions or information set out in this document as the Company may deem necessary in compliance with SPPRA Rules through the publication of an appropriate corrigendum.
- 5.8 The Company reserves the right to accept or reject all of the proposals submitted at any time in accordance with applicable SPPRA rules.
- 5.9 The Company shall open the applications thirty minutes after the submission deadline.

6 Conflict of Interest

Without limitation on the generality of the foregoing, the APPLICANT shall be considered to have a conflict of interest and shall not be recruited under any of the circumstances set forth below:

6.1 Conflicting assignments

- The APPLICANT (including its Personnel) or any of its affiliates shall not be hired for any assignment that, by its nature, may conflict with another assignment to be executed for the same or another Client.

6.2 Conflicting Relationships

- The APPLICANT (including its Personnel) or any of its affiliates that has a business or family relationship with a member of the Company Board, Management, or staff who is directly or indirectly involved in the preparation of Terms of Reference, the selection process of third party evaluation services and/or supervision of the Agreement may not be awarded an Agreement unless conflict stemming from this relationship has been resolved in a manner acceptable to the Board throughout the selection process and the execution of the Agreement.
- The APPLICANT has an obligation to disclose any situation of actual or potential conflict that impacts their capacity to serve the best interest, or that may reasonably be perceived as having this effect by notifying the Company in writing. Failure to disclose said situations may lead to disqualification of the APPLICANT or the termination of its Agreement.
- Current employees of the Company shall not work as and for the APPLICANT.

7 Fraud and Corruption

- 7.1 The Company requires the APPLICANT/s participating in the provision of Service/s to adhere to the highest ethical standards, both during the selection process and throughout the execution of an agreement. In pursuance of this policy, the Company defines, for this paragraph, the terms set forth below as follows:

“Corrupt practice” means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence the actions of any employee of the Company in the selection process or agreement execution;

“Fraudulent practice” means a misrepresentation or omission of facts to influence a selection process or the execution of an agreement;

- 7.2 “Collusive practices” means a scheme or arrangement between two or more with or without the knowledge of the Client, designed to establish prices at artificial, non-competitive levels;

“Coercive practices” means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in a procurement process, or affect the execution of an agreement. The Company will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the APPLICANT recommended for award has directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for the agreement in question. The Company may also impose penalties on the APPLICANT, declaring it ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period, for Company funding, if at any time it determines that the APPLICANT has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for, or in executing, a Company funded project.

- 7.3 The Company will have the right to inspect the bidding firm’s accounts and records and other documents relating to the submission of proposals and agreement performance and have them audited by an Auditor appointed by the Company.

8 Clarification Request/ Amendment

- 8.1 The APPLICANT can request clarification in the CRITERIA document up to the date indicated in the CRITERIA document. Any request for clarification must be sent in writing, or by standard electronic means to the Company’s e-mail address indicated in the CRITERIA document. The Company will respond in writing or by standard electronic means and may place responses on the Company’s website under FAQs for the understanding of all potential APPLICANTS.
- 8.2 At any time before the submission of Proposals, the procuring agency may amend the CRITERIA by issuing an addendum in writing or by standard electronic means. The addendum shall be sent to all and will be binding on them. Applicants shall acknowledge receipt of all amendments. To give applicants reasonable time in which to take an amendment into account in their Proposals the Client may, if the amendment is substantial, extend the deadline for the submission of Proposals.

**PART C - TERMS OF REFERENCE & SCOPE OF
SERVICES**

9 Background

Sindh Economic Zones Management Company (SEZMC), a government-owned company, invites applications from reputed Consulting Firms (Architects & Engineers), registered with the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) / Pakistan Council of Architects & Town Planners (PCATP), Income Tax and Sales Tax Departments and who are on Active Taxpayers List of the Federal Board of Revenue, to designate a panel of Architects and Engineers to **Vet & Approve** Building Plans, Architectural and Structural, MEP drawings of the industrial buildings at Khairpur Special Economic Zone.

9.1 Scope of the Services

- **Regulatory Compliance:** Firms should thoroughly understand and be well-versed in all relevant local, state, and national building codes, construction regulations, and by-laws (SBCA). They ensure that the construction adheres to these legal requirements.
- **Design Review:** Before construction commences, firms to vet, reviews and approve building plans (submission and completion), architectural and Structural, MEP drawings of buildings, soil investigation report to ensure the compliance with building by-laws, zoning regulations as stated in Zone SOP's, safety codes, and other applicable standards as per SBCA by-laws.
- **Certifications and Approvals:** The Firm will certify every stage of construction as per the applicable by-laws up to completion, such as commencement, execution, completion certificate, and other milestones that may be required by Authority.
- **Documentation:** Firms will maintain records of vetting, reviewing, certifications, and compliance reports. The same may be produced upon the request of the authority.
- **Handover and Closeout:** Upon completion of the structure (Civil/MEP), the firms will assess whether all by-laws have been adhered to and verifies that the structure is ready for commencement of operations, and the Authority confirms that all requisite codal formalities have been duly completed. Any outstanding documentation, including as-built drawings, and any subsequent modifications or changes, shall be duly incorporated and regulated through the Zone SOPs or SBCA by-laws in all relevant aspects prior to the issuance of the Completion Certificate.
- To issue the Completion/ Stability Certificate as per SBCA by-laws. The same shall be provided to SEZMC.

9.2 Terms & Conditions

- Vetting charges for Architectural should not exceed the limit of 8 Rs. / sft of covered area and for Structural consultant including MEP should not exceed the limit of 8 Rs. / sft of covered area (the charges 40% of SBCA scheduled charges or whichever is higher and

the same may be revised time to time)

- Engagement notification will be provided to the qualified Architectural and Engineering firms but only after submission of fee accordingly. Enlistment of firm is valid up to **3 years** however, renewal is required every year. It will be renewed on yearly basis, based on performance of firm, re- submission of valid registration with PEC/ PCATP, proofs of SBCA approved Structure engineer and Architect & Town Planner, yearly engagement fee, and willingness of client and firm.
- Enlisted applicants are liable to pay yearly enlisting charges to SEZMC as per below charges:
 - i. Architectural & Structural consultant: 1,000 PKR / annum
- Scheduled rates of SBCA to be followed.
- The allottee is liable to pay all applicable charges in accordance with SBCA schedule before the issuance of NOCs.

PART D – ELIGIBILITY & EVALUATION

10 Evaluation of Proposals/ Applications

- 10.1 From the time the Applications are opened to the time the evaluation report is announced, the APPLICANTs should not contact the Procuring Agency on any matter related to its proposal. Any effort by the APPLICANT to influence the Procuring Agency in the examination, evaluation, ranking of Proposals, and recommendation for the award of Agreement/ license may result in the rejection of the APPLICANT's Proposal. However, the Procuring Agency may contact the APPLICANT for seeking clarification of any aspect of the application or demand any missing information.
- 10.2 During the evaluation no amendments in the proposals shall be permitted. A Proposal shall be rejected at this stage if it does not respond to important aspects of the CRITERIA and particularly the eligibility criteria (mandatory requirements) or if it fails to achieve the minimum qualifying technical score in selection criteria. The eligible APPLICANTs who obtain at least **70 marks** in the selection criteria will be selected.

Note:

It is the responsibility of the APPLICANTs to ensure the provision of sufficient/ required documents to the Company along with the proposal.

11 Evaluation Criteria

11.1 Eligibility/ Mandatory Requirements

For Eligibility, APPLICANTs must meet mandatory requirements.

- Valid registration of firm with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) and/ or Pakistan Engineering Council for Architect and Town Planner (PCATP).
- Firm should be registered with relevant body since last 5 years (years of experience)
- CVs of PCATP registered Architects (at least 01) having minimum 10 Years' experience and PEC registered Structure Engineers (at least 01) having minimum 10 Years' experience. Both individuals should have valid license from SBCA.
- The Firm should be an Active Tax payer; Sales Tax and NTN Registration Certificates are required.
- Affidavit be submitted for Consulting firm not Blacklisted nor in litigation on any Project or by any organization.

11.2 Selection Criteria

For selection, APPLICANTs must attain 70 marks out of 100.
