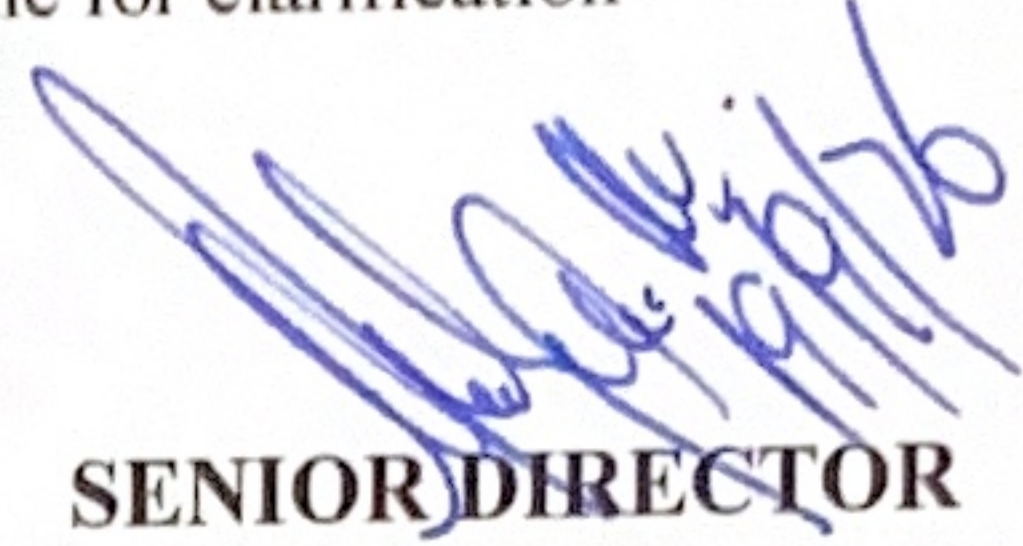

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1. INVITATION TO BID

The Safari Park & Recreation Department, Karachi Metropolitan Corporation (KMC), invites sealed bids through the Single Stage – One Envelope Procedure from interested and eligible bidders for execution of civil works required for upgradation/reconstruction of the existing K-Electric substation at Safari Park for installation of a 425 KVA PMT. The existing substation was constructed in accordance with an earlier design, whereas the proposed installation is to be executed in accordance with the revised K-Electric approved design and prevailing approved standards.

2. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE OF WORK

The existing K-Electric substation at Safari Park was constructed according to the earlier substation arrangement/design. Due to revision of K-Electric's approved substation design and applicable standards, the existing civil arrangement requires modification/upgradation/reconstruction to accommodate the proposed 425 KVA PMT and associated equipment. The purpose of this procurement is to execute the required civil works so that the substation is brought into conformity with the revised approved K-Electric design, drawings and technical requirements.

- The Contractor shall verify existing site conditions before commencement.
- All civil works shall conform to the latest approved K-Electric design/drawings supplied or approved for the project.
- Where a conflict exists between an old existing arrangement and the revised approved design, the revised approved design shall govern, subject to the Engineer's written direction.
- The Contractor shall coordinate with KMC and K-Electric during execution wherever civil works interface with electrical equipment, cables, earthing or energization requirements.

3. INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- Bidders shall carefully examine the complete Bidding Document, approved drawings/specifications, BOQ and site conditions before submitting bids.
- Submission of a bid shall constitute confirmation that the bidder has understood the nature and extent of the civil works and the constraints of working within an operational public recreational facility.
- The bidder shall inspect the existing substation and satisfy itself regarding dimensions, access, existing structures, levels, soil/ground conditions visible at site and other relevant conditions.
- All documents submitted through EPADS shall be complete, legible and signed/stamped where required.
- Conditional bids, material deviations or failure to meet mandatory eligibility requirements may render the bid non-responsive.

Note: Since the present procurement is principally for civil works associated with a K-Electric substation, bidders shall also demonstrate adequate civil construction capability, supervision and resources for safe execution of the works.

6. EVALUATION AND RESPONSIVENESS CRITERIA

- Compliance with all mandatory eligibility requirements shall be assessed on Pass/Fail or Yes/No basis.
- Relevant similar experience shall be supported by work orders, agreements, completion certificates or other verifiable documentary evidence.
- K-Electric prequalification/registration evidence shall be verified where required by the NIT.
- Financial bids shall be evaluated only in accordance with the applicable procurement procedure after determination of technical responsiveness.
- Arithmetic errors, material deviations, conditional offers or incomplete mandatory documents may be dealt with in accordance with the applicable procurement rules.

7. SITE INSPECTION AND EXISTING CONDITIONS

- The bidder is strongly advised to visit the site before submission.
- The existing substation is an old-design structure and may require dismantling, alteration, reconstruction and making-good works to suit the revised K-Electric design.
- The Contractor shall verify existing levels, dimensions, structural condition, access and location of existing services before commencing work.
- No structural element shall be demolished or altered without approval/confirmation of the Engineer where the proposed action affects existing facilities or safety.
- Existing KMC and K-Electric installations shall be protected from damage.

8. SCOPE OF CIVIL WORKS

- Mobilization, site establishment and protection of the work area.
- Setting out and verification of levels and dimensions.
- Controlled dismantling/removal of portions of the existing substation structure that conflict with the revised approved design.
- Removal of existing foundations, plinths, walls, slabs, doors, roof elements or other civil components only where shown/required by the approved design or directed by the Engineer.
- Excavation, disposal and backfilling required for new foundations and allied works.
- PCC and RCC foundations/plinths for PMT, equipment and associated structures as per approved drawings.
- Reinforcement steel, formwork, concrete placement, curing and finishing.
- Brick/block masonry and structural wall modifications.
- Cable trenches, openings, sleeves, ducts, covers and cable entry arrangements as per approved drawings.
- Earthing pit civil works and inspection chambers as required.
- Flooring, screed, slope formation and equipment plinth finishing.

- Doors, gates, louvers, ventilation openings and associated frames where included in the approved BOQ/drawings.
- Roof repair, waterproofing and rainwater protection where required.
- Plastering, rendering, painting and protective finishing.
- Drainage and water disposal arrangements.
- Removal of construction debris and disposal at approved location.
- Making good of all disturbed surfaces and existing structures.
- All incidental civil works necessary for complete execution in accordance with the approved BOQ and drawings.

9. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS – CIVIL WORKS

9.1 General

- All work shall be executed strictly in accordance with approved drawings, BOQ, specifications and written instructions of the Engineer.
- Dimensions, reinforcement details, concrete grades, foundation depths and structural details shall be as shown on the approved project drawings. No dimensions shall be assumed by the Contractor.
- Any discrepancy between drawings, BOQ and site conditions shall be referred to the Engineer before execution.
- Workmanship shall be sound, uniform and suitable for substation service conditions.

10. K-ELECTRIC REVISED DESIGN AND STANDARDS

- The revised K-Electric approved substation design/drawings shall form an integral part of the Bidding/Contract Documents when issued.
- All civil dimensions and arrangements shall comply with the latest approved K-Electric design and applicable standards.
- The Contractor shall provide openings, trenches, foundations, clearances and access arrangements necessary for the approved electrical equipment.
- K-Electric inspection comments relating to civil construction shall be attended to by the Contractor where they fall within the approved scope.
- No deviation from the approved K-Electric design shall be made without prior written approval of the Engineer/competent authority and, where required, K-Electric.

11. MATERIALS AND WORKMANSHIP

- All cement, steel, aggregates, bricks/blocks, sand, water, waterproofing materials and other construction materials shall be of approved quality.
- Reinforcement steel shall be clean and free from loose rust, oil, paint or other contaminants.
- Concrete shall be mixed, placed, compacted and cured in accordance with approved construction practice and project specifications.
- Formwork shall be rigid, properly aligned and sufficiently tight to prevent leakage of cement grout.
- Brick/block masonry shall be plumb, level, properly bonded and adequately cured.
- Plaster and finishing works shall be even and free from cracks, hollows and defective workmanship.
- The Engineer may require material samples, test certificates or laboratory tests where considered necessary.

12. DEMOLITION, DISMANTLING AND DISPOSAL

- Dismantling shall be carried out carefully to avoid damage to retained structures and existing electrical installations.
- Before demolition, the Contractor shall confirm isolation/clearance of affected electrical services with KMC/K-Electric.
- Reusable materials, if any, shall be separated and handed over as directed by the Engineer.
- Debris shall be removed from the site regularly and disposed of at an approved location.
- Rates for demolition shall include labour, tools, handling, loading, transportation and disposal were included in the BOQ.

13. EXCAVATION, EARTHWORK AND FOUNDATIONS

- Excavation shall be carried out to the lines, levels and dimensions shown on approved drawings.
- Excavated material suitable for reuse may be used for backfilling where approved.
- Unsuitable surplus material shall be removed from site.
- Foundation beds shall be properly compacted and prepared before placement of PCC.
- Backfilling shall be carried out in approved layers and adequately compacted.
- Foundation dimensions and reinforcement shall not be changed without approved revised drawings/instructions.

14. RCC, PCC AND REINFORCEMENT

- PCC shall be provided where specified in the approved drawings/BOQ.
- RCC work shall use the concrete grade specified in the approved structural/civil design.
- Reinforcement shall be of the specified diameter, spacing, laps and anchorage shown on approved drawings.
- Concrete shall be properly vibrated/compacted and cured.
- Construction joints shall be formed only at approved locations.
- Concrete surfaces shall be protected from damage until adequate strength is achieved.

15. MASONRY, PLASTER, FLOORING AND FINISHING

- Masonry thickness and material shall be as specified in the approved drawings/BOQ.
- Plaster shall be applied to prepared surfaces and finished true to line and level.
- Flooring shall be laid to required levels and slopes, particularly where equipment plinths and cable trenches are involved.
- All exposed civil surfaces shall receive the specified protective/finish coating.
- Colour, type and number of coats of paint shall follow the approved specification/BOQ.

16. DOORS, GATES, VENTILATION AND OPENINGS

- Doors/gates shall be fabricated and installed according to approved drawings and BOQ.
- Ventilation openings/louvers shall be provided wherever shown in the approved design.
- Frames shall be securely anchored and finished against corrosion.
- All openings shall be sealed/finished as required while maintaining the approved ventilation and access arrangement.

17. CABLE TRENCHES AND ALLIED CIVIL WORKS

- Cable trenches shall be constructed to the dimensions, levels and routes shown in approved drawings.
- Trench walls and bases shall be suitably constructed and finished for the intended cable installation.
- Removable trench covers shall be provided where specified.
- Cable sleeves, ducts and wall/foundation penetrations shall be positioned accurately before concrete/masonry works are completed.
- Water ingress into cable trenches shall be prevented by suitable slope, drainage and sealing arrangements as shown in the approved design.

18. EARTHING PITS AND ELECTRICAL-CIVIL INTERFACE

- Civil construction of earthing pits/chambers shall comply with approved K-Electric drawings and applicable requirements.
- Earth electrode locations and connections shall not be altered without approval.
- Inspection chambers/covers shall be constructed to permit safe inspection and maintenance.
- All interfaces between civil works and electrical installations shall be coordinated before finalizing concrete, masonry or finishing works.

19. DRAINAGE AND WATERPROOFING

- The substation shall be protected against rainwater ingress and water accumulation.
- Floor levels and external ground levels shall be maintained to direct water away from the substation.
- Roof waterproofing and drainage shall be repaired/provided where included in the approved scope.
- Any observed water leakage affecting the proposed equipment area shall be brought to the Engineer's notice before completion.

20. TESTING, INSPECTION, COMPLETION AND HANDOVER

- The Engineer shall inspect completed civil works before installation/energization of electrical equipment.
- Any defective or non-conforming work shall be rectified by the Contractor at its cost where attributable to the Contractor.
- Concrete/material test reports shall be submitted where required.
- The Contractor shall clean the substation and remove debris before handover.
- Handover shall include completion of all civil works, making-good, access, drainage, finishing and other approved allied works.
- K-Electric inspection comments within the approved scope shall be attended to before final completion.

21. SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

- All demolition and construction activities shall be performed under safe working procedures.
- Workers shall use appropriate PPE including helmets, safety shoes, gloves, eye protection and other required equipment.
- Electrical areas shall be treated as hazardous unless formally isolated/cleared.
- Barricading and warning signage shall be provided around excavation and demolition areas.
- Construction activities shall be planned to minimize disturbance to Safari Park visitors, staff, animals and ongoing operations.
- Construction debris, cement waste and other materials shall not be allowed to obstruct public paths or affect animal enclosures/operations.
- The Contractor shall comply with applicable safety and environmental requirements.

22. MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

- Measurement shall be made in accordance with the units and descriptions contained in the approved BOQ.
- Payment shall be based on actual quantities executed and accepted, where the BOQ/Contract provides for item-wise measurement.
- Rates shall include labour, materials, tools, plant, transport, loading/unloading, wastage, overheads, profit, applicable taxes and incidental expenses necessary for completion unless expressly excluded.
- No payment shall be made for unauthorized work or work executed contrary to approved drawings/instructions.
- Variations, if required, shall be dealt with only through the prescribed approval process.

23. COMPLETION PERIOD

The completion period shall be specified in the Work Order/Contract based on the approved execution programme. Considering the emergency nature of the work, the Contractor shall mobilize promptly after issuance of the Work Order and shall coordinate its programme with KMC and K-Electric requirements.

25. GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- The Contractor shall execute the work according to the approved drawings, BOQ, specifications and Engineer's instructions.
- The Contractor shall provide competent supervisory staff and adequate labour, tools and equipment.
- The Contractor shall protect existing KMC and K-Electric property and shall make good damage caused by its negligence.
- No substantial variation or alteration shall be undertaken without the required approval.
- The Contractor shall maintain the work area in a clean and safe condition.
- The Contractor shall comply with applicable procurement rules, laws, safety requirements and KMC instructions.
- Disputes shall be dealt with in accordance with the Contract and applicable laws/rules.

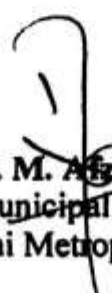
