Public Health Engineering Division Dir Lower, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa invites Electronic Bids from the eligible Firms/bidders in accordance with KPPRA procurement rules 2014 on **single stage single envelope** at serial No 1, 2, 3, 6 and **single stage two envelope** at serial No 4 & 5.

The Firms / Contractors must be registered with i. Pakistan Engineering Council in relevant category and code, ii. Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPPRA) and iii. Provincial Enlistment Committee.

Terms & Conditions

1. BOQ to bidders can be seen / obtained from the office of undersigned or downloaded from EPAD.
2. Last date & time of submission of bid is 25/12/2025, at 11:00 Noon, which will be opened on the same date at 02:00 PM in the presence of government contractor or their authorized representatives.
3. Bid Solicitation Documents / instruction to Bidders can be obtained from the office on any working day before the submission date & time.
4. As per KPPRA notification No. SRO (14)/Vol:1-24/2021-22 dated 10-05-2022 the Additional Security shall be submitted by the bidders as under:
 - a) The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 10% below Engineer estimate shall submit bid security @2% only of Engineer Estimate.
 - b) The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below upto 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer' Estimated cost in addition to 2% bid security. If the bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security, then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the second lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
 - c) Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer's Estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineer's Estimate along with detailed rate analysis. In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detailed rate analysis and / or required amount of additional security, then the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be consider accordingly.
 - d) In case detailed rate analysis submitted with the bids is, in view of the Procuring Entity, not convincing, the Head of the Procuring Entity may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof.
 - e) The procuring entity may offer the contract to next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids or may advertise procurement opportunity afresh.
 - f) After commencements of work by the successful bidder, the procuring entity may replace the Additional Security with a bank guarantee of the same amount from the scheduled bank; if the already deposited security is not in the form of bank guarantee.

- g) The Additional Security shall be released to the contractor in four installments i.e. 1st installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 25% of the project, 2nd installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 50% of the project, 3rd installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 75% of the project and the 4th installment of 25% to be released after 100% completion of the project.
- h) All previous orders, instructions and regulations issued regarding additional security shall stand superseded.
5. Bid shall accompany with 0.03% of E/Cost as Tender Form Fee in shape of separate CDR which is non-refundable, if not accompanied then it will be considered as non-responsive.
6. All others terms and conditions will remain intact as per guidelines and rules framed by Provincial Government.
7. The procuring entity can reject any or all the works before approval as per rules.
8. As per KPPRA Notification No.SOR(29)/Vol.1-40/2025-26/699-711 dated 29/10/2025. All bidders shall enter the detail of the bid security and where applicable, the additional security instrument in the E-PAK Acquisition and Disposal System (EPADS) at the time of bid submission. The original bid security and additional be submitted to the procuring entity well before the closing date and time of bid submission. The procuring entity shall retain the original bid security and additional security instruments of all bidders until signing of the contract with the best evaluated bidder or till the bid validity period whichever is earlier.
- a) In case of failure to submit the original bid security and additional security instrument before the date and time, the procuring entity shall debar the bidder for a period of one (01) year.
- b) In the case of violation for 2nd time, blacklist him for a minimum period of three (03) years an according with the section 29 of the KPPRA act read with rule 44 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of goods, works and service rule 2014.
9. All taxes of Provincial / Federal Government will be deducted as per rules. The bidder/firm should provide bifurcation schedule of all taxes in the bidding process.
10. Only Pre qualified / approved firm can apply for Pumping machineries.
11. Only Pre qualified / approved firm can apply for solarization Schemes, which will be on single stage two envelope.
