The C&W Division Upper Chitral Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa invites Electronic Bids through E-PADS from eligible firms/contractors in accordance with KPPRA Procurement Rules 2014, amended up to 10.05.2022 on **Single Stage Single Envelope** procedure for the following work(s).

1. Bid Solicitation Documents and Instructions to Bidders can be obtained from the office of the executive engineer C&W Division Upper Chitral on any working day or Downloaded from EPAD System before the submission date/time.
2. The bidders should submit their E-bids as per KPPRA Notification No. SOR(14)/ Vol:1-20/2021-22 dated 10.05.2022 and Notification No. S.R.O(15)/Vol:1-25/2022-23 Dated:22.08.2022.
3. **Bid Security in shape of CDR i.e. Bank Name, CDR Number(s) and Date(s) must be submitted electronically along with E-bid on the E-PAD System and in original to the office of Executive Engineer, C&W Division Upper Chitral before the closing date and time.**
4. All bidders are required to be registered with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority under Finance Act, 2013 Act No. XXI of 2013.
5. Venue of Bids opening is office of the Executive Engineer C&W Division Chitral Upper.

## INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. The bidders are required to quote their rates above or below on both MRS as well as on non MRS items.
2. i) The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 10% below Engineer estimate shall submit bid security to the extent of 2% of Engineer Estimate only.
3. The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below up to 20% below on Engineer's Estimate shall submit along with their bid, 8% Additional Security of Engineer Estimate cost in addition to 2% bid security. if the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security then it will be considered as non-responsive and 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the 2<sup>nd</sup> lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
4. (Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on engineer's estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and engineer's estimate along with detailed rate analysis.) in case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detailed rate analysis and/ are required amount of additional security, the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the 2<sup>nd</sup> lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
5. In case detailed rate analysis submitted with the bids is, in view of procuring entity, not convincing, the head of procuring entity may declared such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reason thereof.
6. The procuring entity may offered the contract to the next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids or may advertise procurement opportunity afresh.
7. After commencements of work by the successful bidder, the procuring entity may replace the Additional Security with a bank guarantee of the same amount from the scheduled bank: if the already deposited security is not in the form of bank guarantee.
8. The Additional Security shall be released to the contractor in four installments i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> Installment 25% to be released upon completion of 25% of the project. 2<sup>nd</sup> Installment 25% to be released upon completion of 50% of the project. 3<sup>rd</sup> Installment 25% to be released upon completion of 75% of the project, and the 4<sup>th</sup> Installment of 25% to be released after completion of the project.
9. All previous orders, instructions and regulations issued regarding Additional Security shall stand superseded.
10. All such effort to conspire to cartel making shall be considered as violation of Rule-44 and shall be attributed towards mis-procurement under Rule-54 of procurement Rules ibid.
11. Electronic Bids should be submitted electronically on or before the fixed date/time.
12. Any bidder who provides incorrect information shall stand disqualified and will be debarred.
13. Time allowed for completion of the work is as specified in the NIT which will start from the issuance of LOA.
14. Electronic Bids will valid for Ninety (90) days.
15. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement with the department within 07 Days after issuance of Work order.
16. Call Deposit of Scheduled Banks shall be acceptable.
17. If the evaluated electronic bid costs of two or more than two bidders are equal then the successful bidder will be declared through draw/Free Toss.
18. The Electronic Bids will be displayed by Online E-PAD System after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders/their representatives who choose to be present.
19. The employer has the authority to reject any E-bid or all the E-bids assigning valid reason.
20. Bid Security of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> lowest bidders will be retained by the employer till approval of bid.
21. All the Bidders must submit Bids in scanned form through E-PADs and submit original CDR to the office of the Executive Engineer, C&W Division Upper Chitral.
