NOTICE INVITING E-BIDDING THROUGH EPADS

Sealed tenders based on MRS-2025 (1st Bi Annual) / Non MRS-items as per approved PC-I for the below mentioned works out of "Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa" "REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF TRANSFORMER" 2025-26, are hereby invited on the basis of Single Stage Single Envelope Procedure through **EPADS** from the Government contractors registered with PEC, enlisted with C&W Department as per Centralized Enlistment Policy of the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for the current financial year:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Bid Documents can be downloaded from the official EPADS website i.e. (www.portalkp.eprocure.gov.pk) after publishing NIT. Bid documents will be filled neatly and a clear scan copy of the same will be uploaded at the time of apply (bid submission) through EPADS.
2. While the original Biding documents along with original bid securities and detail rate analysis (if applicable) complete in all respect must be delivered through courier to the Office of Assistant Director Senior LG&RDD HQ Lower District Orakzai located District Head Quarter Babar Mela Hangu, before closing time of bid.
3. **Cutting and overwriting** in the bid documents (including the Tender Form and BOQ) shall not be acceptable. **Any discrepancy between the scanned copies submitted through EPADS and the hard copies will result in disqualification, and the bid will be considered non-responsive.**
4. The rates may be offered as %age above or %age below or at-par on engineer estimate.
5. those contractor/firms are eligible to participate in the tender who are registered with Inspectorate of Electricity, Energy & Power Deptt; Khyber Pakhtunkhwa of electricity act 1937 Under Rule 48 & hold Class-E license as well as Provide One-year warranty of the particulars as per PESCO SOP, the contractor/firm workshop must be registered with PESCO. Furthermore, the Bidders must have the relevant codes for the above mentioned works as per PEC i.e EE04 & EE05.
6. The **Bid Security** must be in the form of a **Call Deposit Receipt (CDR)**, prepared in favor of the Assistant Director Senior LG&RDD HQ District Orakzai.
7. in case of failure to submit the original bid security and additional security instrument before the date and time, the procuring entity shall debar the bidder for a period of one (01) years.
8. In the case of violation for second time, blacklist him for a minimum period of three (03) years in accordance with section 29 of the KPPRA Act read with Rule 44 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Service Rules, 2014.
9. it is further added that unregistered/unprequalified workshops could not repair the PESCO Damaged Transformer as in case the PESCO SOP violated & discourage the unregistered/non-prequalified workshops for repair of PESCO Damaged Transformer under MNA/MPA/Minister Funds & issued directions to field formation not to shift the PESCO Damaged Transformers directly to unregistered/non-prequalified workshops.
10. All bidders must be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRIA).
11. The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 10% below Engineer Estimate shall submit bid security @ 2% only of Engineer Estimate.

12. The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below up to 20% below on Engineer's Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition to 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security, then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the second lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.

13. Similarly, a contractor, quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer's estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineers' Estimate along with detailed rate analysis. In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detailed rate analysis and / or required amount of additional security, then said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.

14. In case detailed rate analysis submitted with the bids is, in view of the Procuring Entity, not convincing, the Head of the Procuring Entity may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof.

15. The procuring entity may offer the contract to next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids or may advertise procurement opportunity afresh.

16. The call deposits i.e. bid security for the work / contract must be prepared after publishing of NIT and before the closing time of the bid.

17. Work order will be issued subject to availability of funds. The time for completion of scheme shall be as per work order. The contractor or his representative can be present at time of opening of electronic bids opening.

18. In case of tie / draw amongst the responsive bidders, the bid may be decided through free toss which shall be considered as final.

19. Any electronic bidder who provides false, or materially inaccurate or incomplete or do not send information in hard form will be disqualified as per KPPRA Act Section 29 (1) read with KPPRA Rule (43). Furthermore, the Procuring Entity/Executing Agency will recommend and sent cases for debaring/Blacklisting and will initiate / take action in light of approved procedure / mechanism as per KPPRA Act section 29 (2) read with KPPRA Rule (44).

20. Bids will remain valid for **120 days** from the closing date of bids.

21. The firms/contractors who wants to participate in tendering process may registered themselves with the EPADS for gaining their unique username and password.

22. The **PEC and KPRA registration** must be valid for the current Financial Year and must be attached to the bid documents. The bidder must also be an active taxpayer.

23. No bidder shall be allowed to withdraw their bid till the award of the contract or the bid is valid, whichever is earlier.

24. Any addition made in the terms & conditions in NIT advertised shall be implemented as per KPPRA Act & Rules.
