Communication & Works Highway Division-II Peshawar invites Electronic Bids from the eligible Firms / Bidders Enlisted with C&W Department and Pakistan Engineering Council for the CFY 2025-26, in accordance with KPPRA Procurement Rules -2014 on Single Stage Single Envelope procedure, amended up-to vide Notification No. SOR (14) Vol: 1-24/2021-22 Dated: 10-05-2022, through EPADS for the following works:

- Bid documents and instruction to Bidders can be downloaded up to one day prior to the opening date from C&W web site www.cwd.gkp.pk. KPPRA Website.
- Nonrefundable bidding entry fee @ 0.03% of tender cost notified vide Section Officer (Confidential) Chief Minister's Secretariat Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar No. SO(C)/CMS/KPK/2021/2828-31 dated 05-04-2021.
- All those contractors who failed to submit the required tender fee earlier are hereby declared non-responsive and ineligible.
- The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 10% below Engineer Estimate shall submit bid security @2% only of Engineer Estimate.
- The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below up to 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favour of Government and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
- Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer's estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineers' Estimate along with detail rate analysis. In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detail rate analysis and /or required amount of additional security, then the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favour of Govt. and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
- In case detail rate analysis submitted with the bids is in view of the procuring Entity, non-convincing, the Head of the Procuring Entity may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof.
- The procuring entity may offer the contract to next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids or may advertise procurement opportunity a fresh.
- After commencement of work by the successful bidder, the procuring entity may replace the Additional Security with a bank guarantee of the same amount from the scheduled bank; if the already deposited security is not in the form of bank guarantee.
- The Additional Security shall be released to the contractor in four installments i.e. 1st installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 25% of the project, 2nd Installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 50% of the project, 3rd Installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 75% of the project and the 4th installment to be released after 100% completion of the project.
- All previous orders, instructions and regulations issued regarding additional security shall stand superseded.

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS (ITB)

1. The bidder shall submit through courier 2% bid security sealed envelope of the Engineer Estimated cost in the shape of Call Deposit at (original) along with photo copies before closing date and time.
2. The bidders should submit their E-bids as per KPPRA Notification No. S.R.O. (14)/Vol: 1-24/2021-22: Dated 10/05/2022.
3. Copies of valid registration with PEC, FBR and KPRA – Active Tax Payer
4. Copy of valid Enlistment Certificate of C&WD for the Current Year
5. National Identity Card (CNIC photocopy)
6. Form H in case of Company / Firm.
7. Financial soundness supported by annual audit reports for the current year.
8. Tax Return Certificate for the current year.
9. The bidders are required to quote their rates (electronically) "ABOVE/BELOW/AT PAR" for both priced BOQ/Engineer Estimate based on MRS-25 and NSI as well. Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.
10. The successful bidder shall be subjected to all admissible taxes including Stamp duty, service charges, sales tax and any other at prevailing rate.
11. Financial Bid shall be filled online. Complete bid must reach this office on or before the fix date and time.
12. Time allowed for the completion of the work as specified in the NIT shall start from the issuance of work order.
13. Electronic Bid validity period is 90-days.
14. Successful Bidders should sign the Agreement with C&WD within (28) days after issuance of letter acceptance.
15. Call deposit and Bank guarantee of scheduled banks shall be acceptable.
16. If the evaluated electronic bid cost of two or more than two bidders are equal than the successful bid will be declared through open draw.
17. Financial Bids will be opened in office of the Executive Engineer Highway Division-II Peshawar after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders/their representative who choose to be present.
18. The procuring entity has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning cogent reason.
19. Bid security of the first, second and third lowest bidders for the specific work will be retained by the Authority till the approval of bids.
20. All the information in documents provided by the bidders must be based on facts beyond any doubt. Any misrepresentation, false statement or fake document found in the proposal at any stage, would lead to debarment/blacklisting of the firm. The matter may also be reported to the PEC for cancellation of registration/license of the respective firm.
21. All bidders are required to be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, established under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act, 2013 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XXI of 2013), for works, consulting and non-consulting services as listed in Schedule-II of the Act *ibid*.
