C&W Division **Battagram**, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa invites Electronic Bids from eligible Firms/Contractors in accordance with KPPRA Procurement Rules 2014 on **Single Stage Two Envelops Procedure** for the following works. The Firms/Contractors should be registered with Pakistan Engineering Council in **Category C-3 & above** having specialized codes **CE01, CE10** in Pakistan Engineering Council for the work noted below and as mentioned in Notice Inviting E-Pads, N.I. E-Pads is attached as Annexure-A). Also enlisted with C&W, KPRA and should have adequate Financial Soundness. Similar Works Experience, Personnel Capabilities and Equipments etc; as per the Evaluation Criteria (attached) of work. No application will be considered after due date and time.

1. Bid Solicitation Documents and Instructions to Bidders can be downloaded from the official EPADS website and C&W website ([www.cwd.gkp.pk](http://www.cwd.gkp.pk)) as well as KPPRA website ([www.kppra.gov.pk](http://www.kppra.gov.pk)) before the submission of date/time. Bids without requisite documents or incomplete will not be processed further for Technical Evaluation.
2. Bidders shall be required to submit as affidavit on stamp paper and place the same affidavit in the Technical Proposal, affirming that the CDR enclosed in the sealed financial bid is authentic and original. In case of non-availability of the affidavit, the firm/bidder shall be considered as non-responsive.
3. A copy of Technical Proposal as well as financial securities in the required format is mandatory and to be uploaded on EPAD System.
4. All term & conditions including KPPRA amended Rules can be seen on official website of the C&W Department or from the office of the undersigned on any working day during duty hours.
5. All Federal/Provincial duties / Stamp duties/Taxes will be recovered as per direction of the Government issued from time to time.
6. Electronic bidding will be done on "Above/Below" system on BOQ/Engineer's Estimate, based on MRS applicable.
7. All bidders are required to be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act, 2013 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XXI of 2013).
8. The bidder should submit their E-bids as per KPPRA Notification No. S.R.O(14)/Vol:1-24 /2021-22 dated: 10-05-2022.
9. Original Copies of Call Deposit for Bid Security and Tender Fee @0.03% on the tender cost should be enclosed in the Technical Proposal and shall reach the Office before closing date/time.
10. Venue of bids is opening at the office of the Executive Engineer C&W Division Battagram.
11. A complete set of criteria/bid documents must be obtained by an interested eligible bidder on submission of written application from the office of the undersigned on any working days before closing date on **10/03/2026** i-e payment of Rs.3000/-(non-refundable) otherwise his bid will not be entertained.
12. Pre-bid meeting will be held on **03/03/2026** in the office of Executive Engineer C&W Division Battagram.
13. The applications for Single Stage Two Envelops Procedure / Technical Bid must be submitted online on E-Pads as per KPPRA Notification No. S.R.O(34) Vol: (1-45)/2025-26 dated Peshawar the 27<sup>th</sup> of August 2025" and No.S.R.O.(29)/Vol-I-40/2025-26/699-711 dated 29-10-2025.
14. The Original documents required in technical proposal must be submitted to E-Pads in original format.

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

**INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS.**  
**NOTICE INVITING BIDS THROUGH E-PADS**  
**(SINGLE STAGE TWO ENVELOP E-PADS)**

1. As per Govt:of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority Notification No. S.R.O.(14)/Vol:1-24/2021-22/6058-71 dated 10-5-2022 which is available in the KPPRA web site.
- i.e. In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 35-A of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority Act, 2012 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XI of 2012) the Authority has been pleased to issue the following regulation, namely: -
- 1. Short title and commencement.-** (i) This regulation may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulation No. XIV 2022.
- (ii) This shall come into force at once.
- 2. Matters pertaining to Additional Security in case of abnormally low bids.-** This regulation relates to the matters pertaining to Additional Security submitted by the bidders in procurement of works.
- i. The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 10% below Engineer estimate shall submit bid security @ 2% only of Engineer Estimate.
- ii. The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below upto 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition to 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favour of Government and the second lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
- iii. **[Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer's Estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineers' Estimate along with detailed rate analysis]<sup>1</sup>.** In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detailed rate analysis and / or required amount of additional security, then the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favour of Government and the 2<sup>nd</sup> lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
- iv. In case detailed rate analysis submitted with the bids is, in view of the Procuring Entity, not convincing, the Head of the Procuring Entity may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof.

<sup>1</sup> Differential amount; if a contractor quote, e.g. 25% below engineer estimate bid then he has to deposit along with his bid 2% bid security and 25% additional security of engineer estimate.

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- v. The procuring entity may offer the contract to next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids or may advertise procurement opportunity afresh.
  - vi. After commencements of work by the successful bidder, the procuring entity may replace the Additional Security with a bank guarantee of the same amount from the scheduled bank; if the already deposited security is not in the form of bank guarantee.
  - vii. The Additional Security shall be released to the contractor in four installments i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 25% of the project, 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 50% of the project, 3<sup>rd</sup> installment of 25% to be released upon completion of 75% of the project and the 4<sup>th</sup> installment of 25% to be released after 100% completion of the project.
  - viii. All previous orders, instructions and regulations issued regarding additional security shall stand superseded.
3. A copy of the technical proposals in the required format is mandatory to be uploaded as a part of E-bidding before submitting Financial Bids. Scanned copy of bid security shall be submitted electronically along with technical bid on E-bidding system.(E-PADS).
  4. Technical proposals should be in sealed envelope clearly marked "Technical Proposal" and additional security (in case of quoted rates more than 10% below) should be in sealed envelope with signed BOQ clearly marked "Financial Bid". Technical proposals and financial bids shall reach the Bids opening venue before closing time.
  5. Financial bid shall be filled online. Complete bids must reach the concerned offices on or before the fixed date/ time.
  6. The bidders are required to quote their rates above or below on both MRS as well as non MRS items.
  7. Any Electronic bidder who submits fake or forged documents or information shall stand de- barred.
  8. Electronic E-PADS Bids validity period is 90 days.
  9. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement with the department within Twenty Eight (28) days after issuance of LOA.
  10. Call Deposit of Scheduled Banks shall be accepted.
  11. If the evaluated electronic bid costs of two or more than two bidders is equal then the Successful bidder will be declared through draw
  12. Technical Bids will be opened after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders/ their representatives who choose to be present.
  13. The employer has the authority to reject any E-PADS bid or all the E-PADS bids assigning cogent reasons.

UNDER THE CHAIRMAN SHIP OF SECRETARY C&W DEPARTMENT ON 3-8-2018 VIDE DIRECOR P&M C&W DEPARTMENT No. D(P&M)/C&WD/1043/2018 DATED 17-8-2018 RECEIVED IN THIS OFFICE VIDE SUPERINTENDING ENGINEER(HQ)OFFICE OF THE CHIEF ENGINEER (EAST) C&W DEPARTMENT ABBOTTABAD NO.1840/2-M DATED 17-9-2018,THE FOLLOWING CONDITION WILL BE ADDED IN THE STANDARD NIT;-
- i. (a) "Bidders who submit their financial bids without a valid C.D. will be debarred from Participating in bidding process for one year.
  - (b) The bidder should be enlisted with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, as per KPPRA rules.
15. **E-PADS Process will be held as per Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority Notification No.S.R.O.(29)/Vol:1-40/2025-26/699-711 dated 29-10-2025 which is available in the KPPRA web site i.e.** In exercise of the powers conferred under section 35-A read with section 29 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority Act, 2012 (KPPRA Act), the Authority, with the approval of the Board of Directors, is pleased to make the following regulations for mitigating collusive practices and ring information in public procurement:
- Short Title and Commencement (1):** These regulations may be called the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement (Bid Security instrument Submission and Enforcement) Regulations, 2025.
- (2) They shall come into force at once and shall apply to all public procurements carried out under the KPPRA Act and rules made thereunder.
- (3) All bidders shall enter the details of the bid security and, where applicable, the additional security instrument in the E-PAK Acquisition and Disposal System (EPADS) at the time of bid submission. The original bid security and additional security instruments, details of which have already been entered in EPADS, shall be submitted to the procuring entity well before the closing date and time of bid submission. The procuring entity shall retain the original bid security and additional security instruments of all bidders until signing of the contract with the best evaluated bidder or till the bid validity period whichever is earlier.**
- i. In case of failure to submit the original bid security and additional security instrument before the date and time, the procuring entity shall debar the bidder for a period of one (1) year.
  - ii. In the case of violation for second time, blacklist him for a minimum period of three (3) years in accordance with section 29 of KPPRA Act read with Rule 44 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of Goods, Works and Services Rule, 2014.
16. As per C&W Secretariat Notification No.SO(B)I-102/CMD/PBC/2020-21/C&WD dated 12-04-2021 the bidding entry fee @0.03% of the tender cost should be enclosed in the Technical Proposal and shall reach the Office before closing date/time. which will be non-refundable at the time of bid submission.
