## REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

**PROCUREMENT OF TRANSACTION ADVISORY SERVICES (TAS) FOR OPTIMIZING EOI AND RFPs FOR DEVELOPMENT OF CARBON REMOVAL AND EMISSION REDUCTION PROJECTS THROUGH IMPROVED FOREST MANAGEMENT (IFM) AND AFFORESTATION, REFORESTATION AND RE-VEGETATION (ARR) ACTIVITIES UNDER PPP MODE IN KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA**

The Forest Department, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, invites sealed Proposals from eligible and qualified National consultancy firms/ Consortia for the management and optimization of complete Procurement Cycle as per detailed RFP uploaded on KPPR website and EPADS. The Procurement selection shall be carried out on the basis of Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method, under the Single Stage – Two Envelopes procedure, through the E-Pak Acquisition and Disposal System (EPADS) of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, in strict compliance with KPPRA Rules, 2014 (as amended from time to time).

1. The interested consultancy firms shall comply with the specifications mentioned in the Eligibility Criteria as per detailed RFP uploaded on EPADS.
2. Consultancy service providers must meet all eligibility, qualification, and experience requirements specified below to participate in this assignment.
3. Consultants must have valid registration with KPPRA, and FBR, and must be active taxpayers on the FBR Active Taxpayer List.
4. They must also be registered on the E-Pak Acquisition and Disposal System (EPADS) of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Additionally, consultants must meet all other requirements as specified in the RFP document.
5. The consulting firms shall submit/ upload the technical and financial proposals through EPADS before the specified date and time for submission of bids (the uploaded contents shall be readable) by 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 up to 1100 hours to the office of the *Project Director, Carbon Stock Assessment for REDD+ and Carbon Credits Marketing Forestry Planning & Monitoring Circle, Palosi road Amanabad, Opposite Pakistan Forest Institute, Peshawar.*
6. The Technical proposal will be opened on the same day 30<sup>th</sup> March at 1130 hours in the presence of the Procurement Committee duly notified by the competent authority and representatives of participating firms, present at the time at the office, mentioned above.
7. The Financial Proposal of the technically qualified firms will be opened at a later stage and the date, time and venue will be communicated after evaluation and approval of technical bids/ proposals. Financial Proposals submitted by bidders declared non-responsive or technically unqualified during the Technical Evaluation stage shall be returned unopened, without being considered for financial evaluation.
8. The proposals received after due date and time shall not be entertained.
9. All applicable Government taxes shall be deducted/paid as per prevailing rules.

10. The procuring entity may reject any or all bids at any time prior to acceptance in accordance with KPPRA Rules. However, the grounds for rejection will be provided to the bidders as per KPPRA Rules.
11. The consulting firms are advised to strictly adhere to the requirements of the assignment/ RFP document and submit reports as per Scope of Work in RFP.
