NOTICE INVITING E-TENDER (EPADS)

ADP Scheme "240245-Solarization of Tubewells in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (2025-26)

Sealed tenders based on MRS-(2025 1st Bi Annual) for the below mentioned works are hereby invited on the basis of **Single stage single envelope procedure** through **EPADS** from the government contractors registered with PEC, enlisted with C&W Department & Local Government Department (LCB) as per Centralized Enlistment Policy of the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for the current financial year.



Terms and Conditions:

1. Bid Documents along with Tender form can be downloaded from the official EPADS website i.e. (www.eprocure.gov.pk) and KP-PPRA website (www.kppra.gov.pk) after publishing NIT. The tender form will be filled neatly and a clear scan copy of the same will be uploaded at the time of apply (bid submission) through EPADS.
2. While the original tender form along with original bid securities, CNIC copy and detail rate analysis (if applicable) complete in all respect must be delivered through courier to the Office of Office Of The **TMA Paharpur** located at Main Bazaar Paharpur city before closing time of bid.
3. Cutting and overwriting in the bid documents (including the Tender Form and BOQ) shall not be acceptable. Any discrepancy between the scanned copies submitted through **EPADS** and the hard copies will result in disqualification, and the bid will be considered non-responsive.
4. No bidder shall be allowed to withdraw their bid till the award of the contract or the bid is valid, whichever is earlier.
5. The rates may be offered as %age above or %age below or at-par on engineer estimate and also the Firms/Contractors shall enter their rates in figures and words and there shall be a number of two figures after the index. The signature of the Firms/Contractors shall be mandatory on the tender form. Failure to do so shall render the Form/BOQ defective.
6. The last time and date for online clarification is up-to **05:00 PM on 30.04.2026**.
7. The securities shall be in shape of call deposit in favor of the **Tehsil Municipal Officer TMA Paharpur**.
8. The eligible bidders must possess the relevant specialization codes for the respective schemes, as prescribed by the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC).
9. The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 10% below Engineer Estimate shall submit bid security 2% only of Engineer Estimate.
10. The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below up to 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition to 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security, then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the second lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
11. Similarly, a contractor, quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer's estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineers' Estimate along with

detailed rate analysis. In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detailed rate analysis and / or required amount of additional security, then said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.

12. In case detailed rate analysis submitted with the bids is, in view of the Procuring Entity, not convincing, the Head of the Procuring Entity may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof.
13. The procuring entity may offer the contract to next lowest bidder after due diligence in the context of financial difference between such two bids or may advertise procurement opportunity afresh.
14. The call deposits i.e. bid security for the work / contract must be prepared after publishing of NIT and before the closing time of the bid.
15. Work order will be issued subject to availability of funds. The time for completion of scheme shall be as per work order. The contractor or his representative can be present at time of opening of electronic bids opening.
16. In case of tie / draw amongst the responsive bidders, the bid may be decided through free toss which shall be considered as final.
17. Any electronic bidder who provides false, or materially inaccurate or incomplete or do not send information in hard form will be disqualified as per KPPRA Act Section 29 (1) read with KPPRA Rule (43). Furthermore, the Procuring Entity/Executing Agency will recommend and sent cases for debarring/Blacklisting and will initiate / take action in light of approved procedure / mechanism as per KPPRA Act section 29 (2) read with KPPRA Rule (44).
18. Bids will remain valid for 120 days from the closing date of bids.
19. The firms/contractors who want to participate in tendering process may register themselves with the EPADS for gaining their unique username and password.
20. All bidders are required to be registered with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPR) under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act 2013.
21. The PEC and KPR registrations must be valid for the current financial year and must be attached to the bid documents. The bidder must also be an active taxpayer.
22. All types of material tests of the work done will be mandatory, the results of which will have to be borne by the contractor/farmer as per the orders of the Engineer-in-Charge.
23. The successful tenderer will be liable to pay all taxes as per the prevailing laws of the Government of Pakistan.
24. TMA Paharpur will not be allowed to supply any kind of machinery.
25. The successful contractor will have to sign an agreement with this department within 15 days, which will include all the amendments made so far.
26. In case the government declares a holiday on the appointed date, the tender will be opened on the next day.
27. Tender fee of 0.03% on the cost of bid in the form of CDR will be deposited separately.
28. All contractors and firms must be included in the active taxpayer list.
29. Any addition made in the terms & conditions in NIT advertised shall be implemented as per KPPRA Act & Rules.
30. The procuring entity reserves the right to reject any or all e-bids while assigning valid reasons for such rejection.
