



Tender Notice

The Cereal Crops Research Institute, Pirsabak Nowshera is mandated to develop high yielding varieties of wheat and produce early generation seed (Pre-Basic Seed) of these approved varieties under the supervision of FSC&RD. The Institute has cultivated Pre-Basic Seed of Wheat Varieties on 159 acres at its research farm. The crop will be harvested in the first week fortnight of May, 2026, through combine harvester.

Sealed quotations are invited for hiring the services of registered government contractors for harvesting the wheat seed crop through combine harvester. The interested bidders are requested to quote per acre charges for the wheat crop harvesting through combine harvester. The quoted per acre charges shall be inclusive of applicable taxes. Following terms and conditions shall be applicable;

1. The bidder shall be registered government contractor having active tax payer status at the FBR online services and shall be registered with the KP-Provincial Revenue Authority for provincial GST on services. All applicable taxes (Federal & Provincial) will be deducted at source.
2. The Combine Harvester shall be in excellent working condition and meet the following output parameters;
 - a. The broken grains ratio shall not at any case exceed 0.5%.
 - b. Zero grain blows in boosa.
 - c. Boosa size shall be 1 to 2 cm, soft and best for animal feed.
3. The required harvesting shall be completed within 12 days. In case of delays, 2% will be deducted from the net payment for the first 5 days delay while 5% will be deducted per day for subsequent delays.
4. Notwithstanding the condition in para 3 above, in case of rain and unfavorable weather, the competent authority shall realign the target date.
5. The sealed bids shall invariably contain 2% bid security in the shape of call deposit drawn in the name of the **Director, CCRI, Pirsabak Nowshera**.
6. Successful bidder shall be required to submit 10% **Performance Guarantee** drawn in the name of the Director, CCRI, Pirsabak Nowshera in the shape of call deposit or bank guarantee.
7. An performance agreement on judicial stamp paper, shall be inked with the successful bidder before the work order is issued.
8. The prospective bidders may visit the site on any working day during working hours and may request for further clarification from The Farm Manager, CCRI, Pirsabak Nowshera (Dr. Ibne Amin Khalil, SRO 0333 940 2060).
9. The last date to submit the bids is 04.05.2026, till 12:00 pm. The bids shall be opened on the same day at 02:00 pm in the presence of the Procurement Committee and representatives of bidding firms.
