OUTSOURCING (PROVISION) OF CT SCAN & MRI DIAGNOSTIC SERVICES AT SELECTED HOSPITALS IN
KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA THROUGH PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP (PPP)

1. Health Foundation in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is mandated to promote and enable the development of innovative healthcare delivery models in the province. It aims to achieve policy objectives of Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa to improve quality and coverage through various means of Public Private Partnership (PPP) for healthcare service delivery and matters connected therewith and ancillary thereto;
2. The Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, under its health sector reform agenda, intends to improve access to advanced diagnostic imaging services by engaging the private sector through PPP arrangements. This initiative aims to ensure availability of CT scan and MRI services within public sector hospitals, reduce patient referrals, improve clinical decision-making, and minimize out-of-pocket expenditures. Accordingly, the Health Department intends to outsource (provision of) diagnostic imaging services at the following hospitals:

3. Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Health Foundation now invites **E-Bids through EPADS (E-Pak Acquisition & Disposal System)** from eligible bidders to indicate their interest in providing the services mentioned in the Terms of Reference (ToRs) for the above hospitals under a **Public-Private Partnership (PPP)**
4. The selected Private Partner shall be responsible for the complete lifecycle delivery of CT scan and MRI services including design, financing, installation, establishment, operation, management, and maintenance of the facilities.
5. **CT scan and MRI services are independent components of the project. Bidders may apply for one or both modalities; however, each hospital and each modality (CT scan and MRI) shall be treated as a separate project. Separate applications/bids shall be submitted for each hospital and each modality, and evaluation and award shall be carried out independently.**
6. **Joint ventures (JV)/consortiums may apply as per conditions laid down in the EOI documents.**
7. For each hospital and modality in which a bidder is interested, either individually or as a member of a joint venture, the rule of **one bidder, one bid** shall apply. A bidder participating in a joint venture shall not be permitted to submit a separate individual bid for the same hospital and modality.
8. All bidders are required to be registered with the **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRA)**.
9. EOIs must be submitted by uploading scanned copies of all required documents through the **bidder's own EPADS account** at:

10. A **pre-bid meeting** will be held on **29th April 2026 at 3:00 pm** at Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Health Foundation.
11. The **deadline for submission** is **15th May 2026, at or before 2:30 pm PST**.
12. EOIs will be opened electronically on the same day at **3:00 pm (PST)** through EPADS. No bids will be entertained without E-Bids. (In case of circumstances beyond control, the EOIs will be opened online on the next day, at the same time and venue.)
13. EOI documents/formats can be downloaded from EPADS after publication of advertisement and until the last date for submission.
14. EOIs submitted by hand, courier, email, or fax will **NOT** be accepted.
15. The procurement process will be conducted under **Single Stage, Two Envelope Procedure** in accordance with the **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (KPPRA) Act 2012 and Rules 2014**, wherein the technical proposals will be evaluated first, and only the financial proposals of technically qualified bidders will be opened.
16. The term outsourcing used in this EOI refers to service delivery under PPP framework and does not constitute disposal of public assets.
17. The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Health Foundation reserves the right to reject any or all bids, in accordance with Rule 47 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority Rules, 2014. Reasons for such rejection shall be recorded in writing and communicated to the bidders upon request.
