
**NOTICE INVITING E-PADs

Terms and Conditions

- Bid documents including instruction to Bidders may be uploaded on E-PADs on C&W website for bidder convenience but the same set of criteria/ bid documents in hard form should be obtained by an interested eligible bidder on submission of written application from the office of the undersigned on any working days before closing date on 18-05-2026 i.e payment of Rs. 4000 (Nonrefundable).
- Bid Security 2% of the Estimated Cost in the Shape of Call Deposit (in Original) any Schedule Bank shall be kept sealed in the financial Proposal shall in addition place an affidavit in the Technical Proposal. It is further added that original E-Stamp Paper of current month duly attested by the Oath Commissioner i.e. List of Staff, List of Machinery, Non Black-Listing / Litigation & Undertaking Certificate are enclosed in Technical Brochures.
- The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below up to 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favour of Government and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
- [Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer's estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineers' Estimate along with detail rate analysis].
- In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detail rate analysis and /or required amount of additional security, then the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favour of Govt and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
- In case detail rate analysis submitted with the bids is in view of the procuring Entity, non-convincing, the Head of the Procuring Entity may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof.
- A copy of Technical Proposal in the required format is mandatory and to be uploaded as a part of E-PADs before different with rate Analysis submitting financial bids.
- All taxes should be deducted as per government rules and policy.
- Scanned copy of bid security shall be submitted electronically along with Technical bid on E-PADs system.
- Bids must be accompanied by a non-refundable Tender Fee @ 0.03% of the Engineer's Estimate; in the shape of CDR otherwise bidder will be considered disqualified.
- All the bidders are required to be registered with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, Established under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act, 2013 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XXI of 2013), for works consulting and non-consulting service as listed in schedule-II of Act ibid..
- The bidders should submit their E-PADs as per KPPRA Notification No. S.R.O. (14)/Vol: 1-24/2021-22: Dated 10/05/2022.
- Technical bids (sealed) in separate envelopes addressed to Executive Engineer Maintenance-II Division should be submitted till closing date.
- Opening of Technical Bid, Office of Executive Engineer Maintenance-II Division, at Bacha Khan Chowk Peshawar.





INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS (ITB)

Technical Proposal should be accompanied with the following:

1. Bidder shall submit an affidavit that Sealed Envelopes submitted along-with Technical proposal contains 2% Earnest Money.
2. The bidders should submit bid copy on E-PADs as per KPPRA Notification No. S.R.O. (35)/Vol: 1-46/2025-26 August-27-2025
3. Copies of valid registration with PEC, FBR and KPRA – Active Tax Payer
4. Copy of valid Enlistment Certificate of C&WD for the Current Year
5. National Identity Card (CNIC photocopy)
6. Form H in case of Company / Firm.
7. Detail of similar nature and other general works, in hands and completed during last five years supported by work orders and completion certificates duly attested from Executing Agencies concerned.
8. Machinery (Tools, Plants & Equipment etc.) supported with the purchase documents as evidence of ownership.
9. Particular of technical Staff/engineers along with updated CVs and their agreement (for the current year) on stamp paper with the firm together with their qualification. Affidavit to the effect that the said personnel or their equivalent shall be made available for the job should also be given along with their registration number of PEC and contact numbers.
10. Financial soundness supported by annual audit reports for the last 3 year.
11. Tax Return Certificate for the current year.
12. Any other document to support the technical bid.
13. Evaluation of Technical Proposal will be carried out with pass/ fail threshold in passing all the field including PEC registration in relevant code, Enlistment with C&W in relevant code, Tax payer proof, relevant experience in past five years, performance, technical personnel, required equipment, financial status, auditors reports, managerial capabilities, litigation status etc. Evaluation criteria in this regard can be obtained from office of the undersigned on any working day in office hours one day before closing date.
14. All the bidding will be submitted through E-PADs system. Technical Bid should in sealed envelope clearly marked: "Technical bid" addressed to the Executive Engineer Maintenance-II Division and shall be submitted through Pakistan Post/UMS/Courier before closing time.
15. The bidders are required to quote their rates (electronically) "ABOVE/BELOW/AT PAR" for both priced BOQ/Engineer Estimate based on MRS and NSI as well. Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.
16. The successful bidder shall be subjected to all admissible taxes including Stamp duty, service charges, sales tax and any other at prevailing rate.
17. Financial Bid shall be filled online. Complete bid must reach this office on or before the fix date and time.
18. Time allowed for the completion of the work as specified in the NIT shall start from the issuance of work order.
19. Electronic Bid validity period is 90-days.
20. Successful Bidders should sign the Agreement with C&WD within (28) days after issuance of letter acceptance.
21. Call deposit and Bank guarantee of scheduled banks acceptable.
22. If the evaluated electronic bid cost of two or more than two bidders are equal than the successful bid will be declared through open draw.
23. Technical Bids will be opened in office of the Executive Engineer Maintenance-II Division Peshawar after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders/their representative who choose to be present.
24. Financial bids (Electronic bids) will be opened in office of the Executive Engineer Maintenance-II Division Peshawar on later date which will be communicated to technically qualified bidders only.
25. The procuring entity has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning cogent reason.
26. Bid security of the first, second and third lowest bidders for the specific work will be retained by the Authority till the approval of bids.
27. All the information in documents provided by the bidders must be based on facts beyond any doubt. Any misrepresentation, false statement or fake document found in the proposal at any stage, would lead to debarment/blacklisting of the firm. The matter may also be reported to the PEC for cancellation of registration/license of the respective firm.
28. Financial electronic bids will be opened after opened of Technical Evaluation.
29. All bidders are required to be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, established under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act, 2013 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XXI of 2013), for works, consulting and non-consulting services as listed in Schedule-II of the Act ibid.
