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**NOTICE INVITING TENDER**  
**SINGLE STAGE – TWO ENVELOPE PROCEDURE**

The Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Communication and Works (C&W) Department, Mega Projects III, Hazara Division, Abbottabad, invites electronic bids from eligible firms/contractors in accordance with the KPPRA Procurement Rules, 2014 (amended), under the Single Stage – Two Envelope bidding procedure for the following works on E-Pak Acquisition and Disposal System (EPADS).

1. Bid solicitation documents and Instructions to Bidders, duly stamped and signed, can be downloaded from the KPPRA's website and E-PADS system. However, the same can be obtained from the office of the undersigned on payment of a non-refundable fee of Rs. 10,000.
2. The bidders shall be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRA) and the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) in the relevant category (as provided above) and field of specializations (as specified in the bidding documents). Firms enlisted with the C&W Department, possessing adequate relevant experience, personnel capabilities, equipment capabilities, financial soundness, and fulfilling other requirements as provided in the Bidding Documents, are eligible to participate in the tender.
3. Contractors quoting bids up to 10% below the Engineer's Estimate shall submit bid security @ 2% of the Engineer's Estimate only.
4. Contractors quoting bids more than 10% below and up to 20% below the Engineer's Estimate shall, along with their bids, submit an additional security equal to 8% of the Engineer's Estimate in addition to the 2% bid security. In case the bid is not accompanied by the required amount of additional security, the bid shall be considered non-responsive, and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favour of the Government. The second lowest bidder, and so on, shall then be considered accordingly.
5. Similarly, a contractor quoting a bid more than 20% below the Engineer's Estimate shall submit, along with the bid, additional security equal to the differential amount between the submitted bid and the Engineer's Estimate, along with a detailed rate analysis. If such bids are not accompanied by the required detailed rate analysis

and/or the required amount of additional security, the bid shall be considered non-responsive. All securities submitted with such non-responsive bids shall be forfeited in favour of the Government, and the second lowest bidder, and so on, shall be considered accordingly.

6. In case the detailed rate analysis submitted with the bid is, in the view of the Procuring Entity, not convincing, the Head of the Procuring Entity may declare such bid as non-responsive without forfeiture of bid security, while recording reasons thereof.
7. The entire bidding process shall be conducted through the E-PADS system. However, contractors shall submit hard copies of detailed profiles/brochures of their firms for record purposes. Evaluation/marketing shall be based on the brochures/documents uploaded in soft form on the E-PADS system.
8. Technical evaluation shall be carried out through the E-PADS system on the basis of qualification criteria provided in the bidding documents.
9. Bidders are required to quote their rates electronically as ABOVE/BELOW/AT PAR for both the priced BOQ and the Engineer's Estimate on the E-PADS system.
10. The successful bidder shall pay all applicable taxes, including stamp duty, service charges, sales tax, and any other taxes at the prevailing rates.
11. Call deposit receipts (CDRs) of scheduled banks or bank guarantees shall be acceptable only if issued in favour of the Executive Engineer, C&W Department, Mega Projects III, Hazara Division, Abbottabad.
12. No pay order or bank draft shall be acceptable except a call deposit receipt (CDR) of a scheduled bank; otherwise, the bid shall be declared non-responsive.
13. Complete details of the bid security in the shape of a CDR, including bank name, CDR number(s), and date(s), must be submitted electronically through the E-PADS system.
14. The original bid security in the shape of a call deposit receipt shall be kept sealed in the financial proposal and submitted to the Office of the undersigned at House No. 787, Street No. 05, Iqbal Road Supply, Abbottabad. In addition, the bidder shall place an affidavit in the technical proposal stating that bid security has been placed in the financial proposal, without mentioning the amount/figure; otherwise, the technical proposal shall be considered non-responsive and shall be returned unopened after examination by the Procurement Committee.
15. Bid securities of the bidders for the specific work shall be retained by the Authority until approval of the bids.
16. If the evaluated bid cost of two or more bidders is found equal, toss shall be conducted to determine the successful bidder.
17. Technical bids shall be opened in the office of the Executive Engineer, C&W Department, Mega Projects III, Hazara Division, Abbottabad, on the specified date and time.
18. Financial Bids shall be opened electronically in the office of the Executive Engineer, C&W Department, Mega Projects III, Hazara Division, Abbottabad, on a later date and

19. The Procuring Entity reserves the right to reject any or all bids by assigning cogent reasons.
20. All information and documents provided by the bidders must be factual and free from any ambiguity. During analysis, scrutiny, or evaluation of the proposals, any misrepresentation, false statement, or fake document shall render the bid liable to rejection and may also lead to debarment/blacklisting. Any fake document or misrepresentation detected during the currency of the contract shall render the firm liable to blacklisting and shall also be reported to the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) for cancellation of registration/license.
21. Pre-bid meeting will be held on Tuesday, June 02, 2026, at the office of the undersigned.
