NOTICE INVITING TENDERING

The PHE Division Dir Lower, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, invites electronic bids from eligible firms/contractors for the following works, in accordance with the "**Single Stage, Single Envelope**" procedure outlined in Rule 6 (2) (a) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (KPPRA) Rules 2014 through the **EPAD System** for the following works:

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The firm/contractor must have a valid registration with the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) under the relevant codes and category.
 2. The firm/contractor must have a valid registration and renewal with the Provincial Enlistment Committee for 2025-26.
 3. The firm/contractor must be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRA) and have an active taxpayer status.
 4. Additional security shall be submitted as per the KPPRA notification No. SRO (14)/Vol:1-24/2021 22 Dated: 10-05-2022.
 5. Bidding documents can be downloaded from the EPAD System (kp.eprocure.gov.pk) and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa PPR (kppra.gov.pk).
 6. Eligible bidders who meet the above requirements are required to submit the required documents and bids online through the **EPAD System** and send physically, only the original earnest money/stamp duty/additional Security/tender fee specified for each work in the form of a call deposit, made out in the name of the undersigned through courier service addressed to the Executive Engineer, PHE Division, Dir Lower, and must be received well before **01:00 P.M. on 11-06-2026**. The tender will be opened on the same date at **1:30 P.M.** in the presence of participating contractors/bidders or their authorized representatives.
 7. Electrical/Mechanical contractor must possess a workshop registered in the firm's name, located in the district of Dir Lower, having a valid electrical inspector's inspection certificate for the year 2025-26. The electrical/mechanical contractor must obtain a workshop verification certificate from the relevant authority before the bid opening date and attach the original certificate with their bid. Failure to submit this certificate will result in the bid being considered non-responsive.
 8. Due to the emergency nature of the works, which require prompt repairs to water supply schemes in the event of breakdowns. The contractor must provide an affidavit on stamp paper, attested by the concerned oath commissioner, committing to prioritize the public's interests and undertake prompt repairs without delay or financial constraints, non-compliance of which may result in disqualification at any stage.
 9. The contractor shall be responsible for providing a three-month warranty for all repairs, ensuring that any defects or issues are addressed during this period.
 10. As per KPPRA Notification No. SOR (29)/Vol.1-40/2025-26/699-711 dated 29/10/2025. All bidders shall enter the details of the bid security and, where applicable, the additional security instrument in the E-PAK Acquisition and Disposal System (EPADS) at the time of bid submission. The original bid security and additional be submitted to the procuring entity well before the closing date and time of bid submission. The procuring entity shall retain the original bid security and additional security instruments of all bidders until signing of the contract with the best evaluated bidder or till the bid validity period, whichever is earlier.
 - a) In case of failure to submit the original bid security and additional security instrument before the date and time, the procuring entity shall debar the bidder for a period of one (01) year.
 - b) In the case of a violation for 2nd time, blacklist him for a minimum period of three (03) years, and according to Section 29 of the KPPRA Act, read with rule 44 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of goods, works, and services rule 2014
1. Incomplete/non-readable bids with unattested cutting/overwriting/disfiguring shall be considered as "non-responsive".
2. All taxes of Provincial / Federal Government will be deducted as per the rules.
3. In case of noncompliance with any term and condition, the bid will be rejected.
4. The competent authority reserved the right to reject any or all bids by assigning cogent reasons.


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
