

Terms and Conditions:

- Bidding documents can be downloaded from the official EPADS website (eprocure.gov.pk) after publication of this NIT in a daily newspaper and on the KPPRA website. The Bid Submission Documents (BSD) shall be completed properly and uploaded in scanned form through EPADS at the time of bid submission
- Tender Fee Rs 2000 (Non-refundable shall be submitted in the shape of call deposit in favor of TMO, Tehsil Municipal Administration, Chamkani, Peshawar. If not submitted then the firm will consider as non-responsive.
- The eligible contractors/fabricators/manufacturers are required to submit their technical and financial Bids through e-PADS, also send their bids in sealed envelopes i.e. one envelope containing "Tender Fee" and the second envelope containing both technical and financial proposals/ bids and sent to the Office of TMO, Tehsil Municipal Administration, Chamkani, Peshawar Budhai road, Peshawar through registered courier service before bid submission due time.
- The securities shall be in shape of call deposit in favor of the TMO, Tehsil Municipal Administration, Chamkani, Peshawar.
- The last date and time of submission of electronic tender form is **29 June, 2026 at 12:30 PM**. The date and time of Opening of Financial Bid shall be announced after evaluation of technical bids.
- Technical proposals must be numbered and a table of contents inserted at beginning of the proposal showing the contents of the proposal according to the numbered pages.
- Any disfiguring / overwriting, manipulation in the tenders shall be liable to rejection.
- Eligible contractors/fabricators/manufacturers shall be registered with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) in relevant category renewed for 2025-26 or 2026-27 whichever comes later. Also, eligible one shall have specialized code ME-05 and ME-06.
- The "Technical Proposals / Bids" of the contractors/fabricators/manufacturers will be evaluated based on criteria mention in the bidding Documents.
- The scope of the work can be increase or decrease as per requirements, non-BOQ items if any, will be paid as per MRS 2025 (1st BI Annual) / MRS based analysis if non - scheduled.
- The "Financial Bids / Proposals" of only technically responsive qualified bidders will be opened after evaluation of Technical Bids in the presence of bidders/ their representative (who may like to attend) whereas the "Financial Bids" of technically non responsive bidders shall be returned unopened to the respective contractors/fabricators/manufacturers.
- The bidders shall submit their 2% bid security (if any) as per KPPRA rules and Notification No.S.R.O.(14)/Vol: 1-24/2021-22 / 6058-71dated 10th May, 2022.
- The call deposits i.e. bid security for the work / contract must be prepared after publishing of NIT and before the closing time of the bid.
- Eligible bidder shall possess
 - Affidavit of non-blacklisting
 - Active NTN
 - Active Sales Tax Registration i.e. ATI

- ◆ Certificate of spare parts availability up to 10 years
- 15. Bidder who does not comply the mandatory requirements will not be considered for technical evaluation and will be declared as non-responsive.
- 16. In case of tie / draw amongst the responsive bidders, the bid may be decided through free toss.
- 17. The successful bidder shall furnish Performance Security @ 10% of the Contract Price in accordance with KPPRA Rules and contract conditions.
- 18. The Procuring Entity reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel the bidding process at any stage prior to acceptance of a bid as per KPPRA Act, 2012 and KPPRA Rules, 2014.
- 19. The chassis shall be provided by the Procuring Entity. The contractor shall be responsible for complete fabrication, installation, testing, commissioning, painting, and delivery of the hydraulic dumper bodies in fully operational condition, including a minimum one-year defect liability/warranty period from the date of successful commissioning.
- 20. The bidder may preferably possess a valid ISO 14001, ISO 45001 and ISO 9001 Quality Management System Certification (which will be evaluated as per criteria) for manufacturing/fabrication activities and shall provide documentary evidence with the bid.
 - All structural steel, plates, pipes, hydraulic components, fasteners, bearings, axles, wheels, cylinders, and other materials shall be new, unused, and free from defects. Material test certificates shall be provided where required.
 - Fabrication shall be carried out in a properly equipped workshop by qualified personnel using approved fabrication methods. Welding shall be continuous, neat, and free from cracks, porosity, undercuts, and other defects.
 - The Employer or its authorized representative shall have the right to inspect the works, materials, and fabrication process at any stage during manufacturing. Any component found defective or not conforming to specifications shall be replaced by the contractor at no additional cost.
 - The contractor shall conduct functional, operational, and load testing of the fabricated machinery before delivery and shall provide inspection and test reports for approval.
 - All fabricated components shall be properly cleaned, surface prepared, primed, and painted with anti-corrosive coating suitable for outdoor municipal and sanitation operations.
 - The contractor shall provide complete as-built drawings, operation manuals, maintenance instructions, and warranty certificates at the time of handover.
 - A minimum warranty period of twelve (12) months from the date of successful commissioning shall be provided against defects in materials, workmanship, fabrication, and performance.
 - The Employer reserves the right to reject any machinery, component, or workmanship that does not comply with the approved specifications, quality standards, or performance requirements, and the contractor shall rectify or replace the same at his own expense.
- 21. Successful bidder shall provide complete operational training to the staff of procuring entity.
- 22. Work order will be subject to fund availability.
- 23. The Procuring Entity has allocated a fixed budget for this procurement. Only those bids whose evaluated bid price is within the approved allocated budget/funds provision for the subject work shall be considered for further evaluation and award. Bids exceeding the approved allocated amount may be rejected in accordance with the applicable provisions of KPPRA Rules and the approved procurement plan.
