

INVITATION FOR BIDS THROUGH E-PADS

DHQ Teaching Hospital KDA Kohat intends to invite e-bids through E-Pak Acquisition and Disposal System (E-PADS), from firms/vendors/suppliers registered with Income Tax and Sales Tax Department, having valid Drug Sale License under Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Drug Sales Rules 1982 (as amended in 2017) for Provision of medicines/surgical disposables/other items, Laboratory and other diagnostic services (CT and MRI) to Sehat Sahulat Program patients during the fiscal year 2026-2027. The procurement shall be carried out through SINGLE STAGE TWO ENVELOPES (TECHNICAL/FINANCIAL) in accordance with Rule 6(2)(b) under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (KPPRA) Procurement Rules, 2014.

Terms and Conditions:

1. E-Bids, prepared in accordance to the instructions contained in the bidding documents alongwith bid security instrument, and required documents; must be submitted by using E-PADS on or before July 29, 2026 till 11:00 am. Manual bids shall not be accepted. Electronic Bids will be opened on the same day at 11:30 am.
2. Pre-bidding meeting will be held on 14-7-2026 at 11:00 am in the conference room of DHQ Teaching Hospital KDA Kohat.
3. Scanned copies of all documents shall be uploaded through E-PADS while submitting e-bid. However, bid security instrument in form of Call Deposit Receipt (in original) shall also be submitted in the office of the Medical Superintendent DHQ Teaching Hospital KDA Kohat, before closing time for submission of e-bid along with attested copies of other documents uploaded on E-PADS.
4. The approved rates will remain valid until June 30, 2027, under KPPRA Rule 31(A) pertaining to framework contracts/agreements.
5. Bidders must be registered with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPR) for works/services.
6. The bidders are requested to give their single highest possible discount for all the mentioned services (on Maximum Retail Price (MRP) for Medicines/other items and on standard market rate (SMR) for Diagnostics Services of Laboratory Tests, CT Scan and MRI etc. because no negotiations on quoted rates/price are allowed under the KPPRA rules, 2014.
7. Offers received as per tender enquiry/bidding document, framed under KPPRA Act and Rules will be considered for the technical evaluation, otherwise it will be rejected and will not be entertained.
8. In case the contractor fails to execute the contract strictly in accordance with the terms & conditions laid down in the contract and/or Bidding Documents, the Call Deposit Receipt may be forfeited and/or the firm may be blacklisted or both as the case may be.
9. The competent authority reserves the right to reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance as provided under Rule 47 of the KPPRA Procurement Rules, 2014.
