The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Textbook Board, Peshawar (KPTBB) intends to invite Expressions of Interest (EOIs) from reputed and experienced national publishing firms/individuals/authors/group of authors, for the development of textbooks (Grade 9 & 11) based on Curriculum 2024-25, notified by the DCTE KP, strictly in accordance with the provisions of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Textbooks and Learning Materials Policy (KPTLM), 2017. Interested developers having proven experience and requisite technical capacity are invited to submit their profiles and relevant credentials for evaluation and shortlisting.

General Conditions:

1. Applications are invited from registered national publishing firms/individuals/authors/group of authors, having valid registration with the Income Tax authorities.
2. Interested developers must possess adequate experience and demonstrable technical capacity in the development and production of textbooks, as has been explained in the prequalification documents.
3. The prequalification documents (free of cost) may be collected from the office of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Textbook Board, Peshawar, during office hours (09:00 AM to 05:00 PM) within working days. The same can also be downloaded from the official website of the Board <https://tbb.kp.gov.pk>.
4. Complete EOIs shall be submitted to the office of the Secretary, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Textbook Board, Peshawar, on or before **20 July 2026**. EOIs received after the deadline shall not be entertained.
5. The Board reserves the right to accept or reject any or all EOIs, at any stage of the process without assigning any reason, in accordance with the applicable rules and policies/regulations.
6. The Board will evaluate the credentials, experience, and technical capability of the applicants and will shortlist suitable developers, for participation in the subsequent stages of textbooks development under the KPTLM Policy 2017.
7. The qualified publishers/developers shall bear all expenses related to manuscript development, submission, and reviews, in accordance with the approved rates.
8. Applicants are advised to carefully read the EOI/prequalification documents before submission of their interest and ensure that all required information and supporting documents are provided.
9. Incomplete applications or applications not accompanied by the prescribed documents, shall be rejected without any further correspondence/reason.
10. Any false statement, concealment of material facts, or submission of forged or misleading documents shall result in immediate disqualification and may attract further penalties under the applicable laws, rules, and regulations.
