NOTICE INVITING TENDERS ON EPAD SYSTEM
(Single Stage Two Envelopes Procedure)

The Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority (PKHA) invites electronic bids from eligible contractors/firms in accordance with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (KPPRA) Procurement Rules, 2014 under the **Single Stage – Two Envelope Procedure** through the e-PAD System for the following scheme:

Bidders registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRA), Enlisted with the C&W Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) in the relevant category and field of specialization, appearing on the **Active Taxpayers List (ATL)** of the **Federal Board of Revenue (FBR)**, and possessing adequate financial soundness, relevant experience, personnel capability, required equipment, and other qualifications as specified in the Instructions to Bidders (ITB) and Bidding Documents, are eligible to participate in the bidding process.

- The Bidding Documents, including the Priced Bill of Quantities (BOQ), Engineer's Estimate, Instructions to Bidders (ITB), Evaluation Criteria, and other relevant documents, are available on the PKHA website (www.pkha.gov.pk) and the e-PAD System (<https://kp.eprocure.gov.pk>) and may be downloaded for bidding purposes.
- Technical Bids shall be opened at 1230 hours on the same day. However, Financial Bids of the technically qualified bidders shall be opened after approval of the Technical Evaluation by the Competent Authority.
- The procurement shall be conducted through the e-PAD System. Both the Technical Bid and Financial Bid shall be submitted electronically through the e-PAD System (<https://kp.eprocure.gov.pk>).

Documents shall, however, be submitted in hard copy to the office of the Director (Procurement), Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority, Attached Departments Complex, Gate No. 5, Khyber Road, Peshawar, on or before the closing date and time mentioned above:

- a. Bid Security equivalent to **2% of the Estimated Cost**, along with **Additional Bid Security (if applicable)**, in a sealed envelope clearly marked **"Bid Security"**.
 - b. Non-refundable **Tender Entry Fee (@0.03% of the Estimate Cost)** for each tender separately, in shape of **Call Deposit Receipt (CDR)**.
 - c. An affidavit stating that **"Bid Security amounting to 2% has been placed in the Financial Bid without indicating the amount in the affidavit."**
6. The Tender Entry Fee and Affidavit shall be enclosed in a separate sealed envelope clearly marked **"Tender Entry Fee & Affidavit."**
 7. Bid Security in the form of **Call Deposit Receipt (CDR)** or **Bank Guarantee** issued by a scheduled bank in favour of the **Managing Director, Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority (PKHA)** shall be acceptable.
 8. A **pre-bid Joint Venture (JV)** comprising firms possessing the required **PEC category** (or higher) shall also be eligible to participate. A duly executed **Joint Venture Agreement** shall be submitted along with the **Technical Bid**. The **Technical Bid** of the **JV** shall be evaluated according to the share percentages specified in the **Joint Venture Agreement**. The **Joint Venture** shall comply with the minimum qualification requirements prescribed under **Rule 3.3 of the PEC Standard Procedure for Prequalification of Constructors**.
 9. The time allowed for completion of the work shall be communicated through the **Letter of Acceptance/Letter of Award** and the **Commencement Order**.

(INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDERS)

(Single Stage Two Envelope)

1. Technical proposal should accompany the following:
 - a. A letter of intent addressed to Managing Director – PKHA.
 - b. The title page of brochure shall also contain the nomenclature of the work for which the bidder intends to apply.
 - c. Proof of Registration with PEC in relevant categories with CE-01, CE-02 Codes.
 - d. Proof Registration with KPRA.
 - e. Proof of Enlistment with C&W Department, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
 - f. National Identity Card (CNIC Photocopy)
 - g. Form H of the Company / Firm.
 - h. Proof of Similar Nature Works, in hands and completed during last 10-years supported by work orders & completion / performance certificates duly attested from the Executing agencies concerned.
 - i. Details of Machinery (Tools, Plants & Equipment etc.) supported with the documents as evidence of ownership / lease / rented.
 - j. Particular of technical staff / Engineers along with updated CVs and their agreement (for the current year) on stamp paper with the firm together with their qualification. Affidavit to the effect that the said personnel or their equivalent shall be made available for the job should also be given along with their registration number of PEC and contact numbers.
 - k. Financial soundness supported by annual audit reports for the last year.
 - l. Tax Return Certificate for the last year.
 - m. Any other document to support the technical bid.
2. ***The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 10% below Engineer estimate shall submit bid security @ 2% only of Engineer Estimate.***
3. ***The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below up to 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition to 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security, then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the second lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.***
4. ***[Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer's Estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineers' Estimate along with detailed rate analysis].*** In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detailed rate analysis and / or required amount of additional security, then the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
5. In case detailed rate analysis submitted with the bids is, in view of the PKHA, not convincing, the Managing Director – PKHA may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof.
6. Technical evaluation will be carried out with pass / fail threshold and Evaluation criteria in this regard can be downloaded from the EPADS or official website of PKHA.
7. The bidders are required to quote their rates (electronically) "ABOVE / BELOW / AT PAR". Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.

9. The Successful bidder shall be subjected to all admissible taxes including stamp duty, service charges, sale tax and any other at prevailing rate.
 10. Time allowed for the completion of the work as specified in the NIT shall start from the issuance of Notice of the Engineer.
 11. Electronic Bids validity period is 120-days.
 12. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement with PKHA within Twenty-Eight (28) days after issuance of Acceptance Letter.
 13. If the evaluated electronic bid costs of two or more than two bidders are equal then the successful bid will be declared through **Open Draw**.
 14. The Procuring Entity has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning cogent reasons.
 15. Bid security of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd lowest bidders for the specific work will be retained by the Authority till the approval of bids.
 16. A Pre-bid meeting will be held in the office of the undersigned on 20/07/2026 at 11:00 am for clarification of information regarding the schemes
 17. Any clarification regarding bidding documents required, must be communicated on or before 21/07/2026 till 05:00 PM on EPAD System Only.
 18. All the information and documents provided by the bidder must be based on facts beyond any doubt. During analysis / Scrutiny or evaluation of the proposals any misrepresentation, false statement or fake document would make a ground for rejection of the bid and will also be liable for debarment / blacklisting. Any fake document or misrepresentation detected during the currency of the contract, will render the firm to be black listed and would be reported to the PEC for cancellation of their registration/license.
