

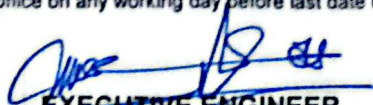

C&W Executive Engineer Maintenance-II Division, Peshawar, Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa invites Electronic Bids from eligible Firms/ bidders in accordance with KPPRA procurement rules 2014 on Single Stage Two Envelop procedure for the work:

Terms and Conditions

- Bid documents including instruction to Bidders will uploaded on E-PADS and C&W website for bidder convenience but the same set of criteria/ bid documents in hard form should also be obtained by an interested eligible bidder on submission of written application from the office of the undersigned on any working day before closing date on 24-08-2026 i.e payment of Rs. 4000 (Nonrefundable).
- Bid Security @ 2% of the Estimated Cost in the shape of Call Deposit Receipt (CDR) from any Scheduled Bank shall be kept sealed in the Financial Proposal. The original Call Deposit (in original) and E-Stamp Paper of the current month shall be attached in the Technical Proposal. It is further added that the following documents duly attested by the Oath Commissioner shall also be enclosed in the Technical Proposal i.e List of Staff List of Machinery Non Black-Listing Certificate Litigation Certificate Undertaking Certificate.
- The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below up to 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favour of Government and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly no further evaluation will be carried out.
- Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit his bid with an additional security on Engineer's estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineers' Estimate along with detail rate analysis. In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detail rate analysis and /or required amount of additional security, then the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive, the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly. In case detail rate analysis submitted with the bids is in view of the procuring Entity, non-convincing, the Head of the Procuring Entity will declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof.
- If a bidder fails to submit the original Bid Security (CDR) and Additional Security (CDR) as per instructions before the specified date and time, the procuring entity shall debar the bidder for a period of one (01) year. If the bidder commits the same violation a second time, the bidder shall be blacklisted for a minimum period of three (03) years.
- A copy of Technical Proposal in the required format is mandatory and to be uploaded as a part of E-PADS.
- All taxes should be deducted as per government rules and policy.
- Scanned copy of bid security shall be submitted electronically along with Technical bid on E-PADS system. Bids must be accompanied by a non-refundable Tender Fee @ 0.03% of the Engineer's Estimate; in the shape of CDR otherwise bidder will be considered disqualified.
- All the bidders are required to be registered with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, Established under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act, 2013 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XXI of 2013), for works consulting and non-consulting service as listed in schedule-II of Act ibid..
- The bidders should submit their Technical/Financial Bid on E-PADS as per KPPRA Notification No. S.R.O. (14)/Vol: 1-24/2021-22: Dated 10/05/2022.
- Technical bids (sealed) in separate envelopes may be addressed to Executive Engineer Maintenance-II Division should be submitted till closing date in addition to upload on E-PADS. (optional)
- If the evaluated electronic bid costs of two or more bidders are equal, then the successful bidder will be declared through draw.
- Bids submitted by bidders who have pending tender fee dues in past tenders their bid will be rejected straight away.
- Opening of Technical Bid, Office of Executive Engineer Maintenance-II Division, at Bacha Khan Chowk Peshawar.
- Details evaluation criteria should be obtained from the undersigned office on any working day before last date of submission.

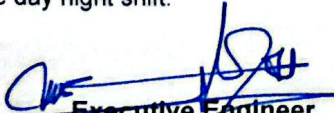

INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS (ITB)

Technical Proposal should be accompanied with the following:

1. Bidder shall submit an affidavit that Sealed Envelopes submitted along-with Technical proposal contains 2% Earnest Money.
2. The bidders should submit updated Technical Bid on E-PADs as per KPPRA Notification No. S.R.O. (35)/Vol: 1-46/2025-26 August-27-2025
3. Copies of valid registration with PEC, FBR and KPRA – Active Tax Payer
4. Copy of valid Enlistment Certificate of C&WD for the Current Year
5. National Identity Card (CNIC photocopy)
6. Form H in case of Company / Firm.
7. Detail of similar nature and other general works, in hands and completed during last five years supported by work orders and completion certificates duly attested from Executing Agencies concerned.
8. Machinery (Tools, Plants & Equipment etc.) supported with the purchase documents as evidence of ownership.
9. Particular of technical Staff/engineers along with updated CVs and their agreement (for the current year) on stamp paper with the firm together with their qualification. Affidavit to the effect that the said personnel or their equivalent shall be made available for the job should also be given along with their registration number of PEC and contact numbers.
10. Financial soundness supported by annual audit reports for the last 3 year.
11. Tax Return Certificate for the current year.
12. Any other document to support the technical bid.
13. Evaluation of Technical Proposal will be carried out with pass/ fail threshold in passing all the field including PEC registration in relevant code, Enlistment with C&W in relevant code, Tax payer proof, relevant experience in past five years, performance, technical personnel, required equipment, financial status, auditors reports, managerial capabilities, litigation status etc. Evaluation criteria in this regard can be obtained from office of the undersigned on any working day in office hours one day before closing date.
14. All the bidding will be submitted through E-PADs system. Technical Bid should in sealed envelope clearly marked: "Technical bid" addressed to the Executive Engineer Maintenance-II Division and shall be submitted through Pakistan Post/UMS/Courier before closing time.
15. The bidders are required to quote their rates (electronically) "ABOVE/BELOW/AT PAR" for both priced BOQ/Engineer Estimate based on MRS and NSI as well. Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.
16. The successful bidder shall be subjected to all admissible taxes including Stamp duty, service charges, sales tax and any other at prevailing rate.
17. Financial Bid shall be filled online. Complete bid must reach this office on or before the fix date and time.
18. Time allowed for the completion of the work as specified in the NIT shall start from the issuance of work order.
19. Electronic Bid validity period is 90-days.
20. Successful Bidders should sign the Agreement with C&WD within (28) days after issuance of letter acceptance.
21. Call deposit and Bank guarantee of scheduled banks acceptable.
22. If the evaluated electronic bid cost of two or more than two bidders are equal than the successful bid will be declared through open draw.
23. Technical Bids will be opened in office of the Executive Engineer Maintenance-II Division Peshawar after 30 minutes of closing time in the presence of bidders/their representative who choose to be present.
24. Financial bids (Electronic bids) will be opened in office of the Executive Engineer Maintenance-II Division Peshawar on later date which will be communicated to technically qualified bidders only.
25. The procuring entity has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning cogent reason.
26. Bid security of the first, second and third lowest bidders for the specific work will be retained by the Authority till the approval of bids.
27. All the information in documents provided by the bidders must be based on facts beyond any doubt. Any misrepresentation, false statement or fake document found in the proposal at any stage, would lead to debarment/blacklisting of the firm. The matter may also be reported to the PEC for cancellation of registration/license of the respective firm.
28. Financial electronic bids will be opened after opened of Technical Evaluation.
29. All bidders are required to be registered with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority, established under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Finance Act, 2013 (Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Act No. XXI of 2013), for works, consulting and non-consulting services as listed in Schedule-II of the Act ibid.
30. Preference will be given to those bidders/contractors who provide day night shift.
