NOTICE INVITING TENDER (EPADS)

Divisional Forest Officer Wildlife, National Parks Wildlife Division D.I. Khan invites Bids from reputed and well experienced firms, duly registered for Income Tax and Sales Tax for procurement / supply of various machinery and equipment etc. in accordance with KPPRA Procurement Rules-2014 on **Single Stage Single Envelope Procedure** through EPADS for the following lots under the project titled: *"Implementation of Management Plan of Sheikh Buddin National Park"*.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. The Bidding documents can be downloaded for lot wise items from the official EPADS website i.e. (<https://kp.eprocure.gov.pk/>) after publishing of NIT. The Bid Soliciting Documents shall be filled neatly and a clear readable scan copy of the same shall be uploaded at the time of bid submission through EPADS.
2. The firms / suppliers who wish to participate in the bidding process shall register themselves at the EPADS portal.
3. The bidders are required to fill online bids and upload the scan copies of the bid documents along with original tender form, original bid securities i.e. 2% bid security.
4. The bids security shall be in the shape of CDR in favor of Divisional Forest Officer, National parks Wildlife Division D.I. Khan from the any scheduled bank of Pakistan.
5. Cutting and overwriting in the bidding documents (including tender form, etc.) shall not be acceptable.
6. The original Bid Security (CDR) and the original No-Litigation/Non-Blacklisting Certificate, duly executed on E-Stamp Paper, shall be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly marked "Financial Proposal", along with the tender name and sender's details, to the **Office of the Divisional Forest Officer, D.I. Khan Wildlife Division, North Circular Road Dera Ismail Khan**, through registered courier before the closing date and time for submission of bids.

7. The bid security Call Deposit Receipts (CDRs) shall be prepared for each lot separately after publication of the NIT and before the closing date and time for submission of electronic bids.
8. Interested firms/contractors must provide the following information with their application/Bidding documents:
- Photocopy of National Identity Card
 - Active registration status with the relevant tax authorities.
 - Affidavit of Non-involvement in any court case with the department.
 - Any other documents, which the firms may consider necessary.
 - Application must be signed by authorized person of the firm with official stamp
9. The suppliers/representative of suppliers are invited to be present at the time of opening of electronic bids at the **Office of the Divisional Forest Officer, D.I. Khan Wildlife Division, North Circular Road Dera Ismail Khan.**
10. Tender shall be processed according to aggregate amount quoted for each lot.
11. Any Electronic Bidder who provides false, materially inaccurate, or incomplete information — will be disqualified under KPPRA Act Section 29(1) and Rule 43. Additionally, the Procuring Entity/Executing Agency will recommend the case for debarring/blacklisting and initiate action as per KPPRA Act Section 29(2) and Rule 44.
12. Bids securities of 1st, 2nd and 3rd lowest bidders for the respective lots will be retained by the client till approval of tenders.
13. Bidders are at liberty to seek any clarification or further information from the office of the undersigned or through EPADS portal during office hours until one day before the closing date for submission on electronic bids.
14. Work/Supply Order will be issued subject to the availability of funds and payments thereafter.
15. All applicable taxes will be deducted and shall be recoverable as per the directives of the government and in accordance with the rules and regulations in practice.
16. The bids validity shall be for 120 days from the closing date of bids.
17. After the award of contract, the successful bidder shall seek approval of Sample & Specifications Verification Committee by provision of samples and specifications of the requisite items before supply.
18. The Procuring Entity may reject all bids at any time prior to its approval as per KPPRA Rules 2014.
19. Any addition made in the terms and conditions in NIT advertised shall be implemented in accordance with KPPRA Rules 2014.


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
