RETENDER INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB 2026-27).

In term of KPPRA S.O.R (23) Vol.1-34/2024-25 Dated 24/03/2025, The Medical Superintendent Miangul Abdul Haq Jahanzeb Kidney Hospital Swat invites E-bids through E-Pak Acquisition and Disposal System (E-PAD) from eligible bidders being on active tax payer list of FBR under National Competitive Bidding from firms/Distributors/Sole agents and manufacturers for supply of the items(for Provisional Allocation, Zakat, Baitul Mall and Sehat Sahulat Program) as per detail given below to meet the requirement of Miangul Abdul Haq Jahanzeb Kidney Hospital Swat, through single stage-single envelop bidding procedure for all the items under the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Procurement of goods and services rules 2014, during the financial year, 2026-27 under the following head of Accounts:

General & Special Terms & conditions

- The E-bid rates/Percentage (inclusive of all taxes), will be valid up to 30/06/2027.
- Standard Bidding Document, (SBD), detailed description of items can be download from EPAD system.
- Bids must be Uploaded before **10:00 hours on 06/10/2026 (Thursday) & Opening time 10:30AM.**
- The tender shall be processed through EPADS. Therefore, bidders are requested to upload their quotations along with all required documents and the CDR through the EPADS portal. The original CDR must be submitted before the tender opening date and time. Failure to submit the original CDR within the stipulated time shall render the bid non-responsive, and late submissions shall not be entertained.
- Only those items that were coded in the Standard Bidding Document (SBD) shall be included in the quotation. Any additional or non-coded items will not be entertained.
- Each Bidder shall write the name of the quoted brand along with complete specifications.
- Quote item according to assigned code, instead of code the quotation will not be considered.
- If any of the bidders requires any clarification regarding specification, Size, quality, or any other query, he may visit to the Procurement Cell/Account section of this Hospital, during working hours till deadline for submission of the bids.
- All the bidders are required to Upload annexure wise complete requisite documents with page marking.
- The firm must be registering Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) for Sale tax, Income Tax, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRA) for service tax, Excise & Taxation for Professional Tax, all required document must be uploaded on EPAD, no hard copies will be entertained, otherwise the quotation will be rejected.
- Any offer received not as per terms & condition of the tender KPPRA Rules will not be entertained.
- Quotation & the offer rate all pages must be signed & sealed (every page) by the authorized person of the bidder.
- Bids must be accompanied with bids security/earnest money with 2% (as mentioned above for each category) in the form of call deposit in favor of Medical Superintendent Miangul Abdul Haq Jahanzeb Kidney Hospital Swat (FTN No.9050375), no pay order & cheque shall be accepted and bids shall be rejected.
- The bids should be on the letter pad of the bidder duly typed /computerized. No cutting/overwriting will be accepted.
- Income tax as per government rules, stamp duty, DPR, Professional Tax, Service tax and sale tax etc. will be deducted at the time of payment subject to the non-availability of Taxes Exemption certificate.
- All prices quoted must be in Pak Rupees (PKR) and should include all applicable taxes. If not specifically mentioned in the Price, it will be presumed that the prices include all the taxes.
- The competent authority has the right to reject any or all bids by assigning reason under clause 47 of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa public procurement rules 2014.
- The contractor shall supply oxygen on a daily basis, as required by the Hospital.
- The Penalty on late supply of goods shall be charged as under @ 2% on daily basis for late supply after fifteen and 30 days of receipt of demand/Purchase order from Hospital.
- In case the contractor failed to supply the items in the stipulated period according to Rules, the Hospital Shall purchase the same items from the market on the risk & cost of the contractor or from the second firms or Local purchase, as an emergency purchase, to meet urgent requirement.
- In case of repeated failure or non-supply the required coded items, the concerned firms must provide a written statement explaining the reason. If no written response is received within 03 days, the firm will be disqualified and the matter will be reported to higher authorities to proceed for debarment / blacklisting.
- Each Items supplied shall strictly conform to the Schedule of Requirements of supply order and to the Specifications prescribed by the Hospital against each item.
- All the items will be supplied at to Hospital without any loading, transportation & unloading charges.
- The contractor shall certify on the bills/claims that rate of the items is according to the quotation.
- The firms shall be bound to accept all the terms & condition of the government/KPPRA and any further condition introduced by the government during the contract period in addition to the terms & conditions mentioned in the SBD.
- Bidders are essentially required to provide correct and latest postal/email/web addresses, phone/mobile/fax numbers for actively and timely communication.
- No bid may be withdrawn after closing of bid time & date and no CDR will be released of the non-responsive bidders after bid validity period (i.e. 90 Days) or award of contract to responsive bidders.
- No offer shall be considered if (i) the firms/owner is not active tax payer(ii)offer received after due date and time(iii)the tender is ambiguous(iv)the tender is unsigned(v)offer received without requisite earnest money(vi)offer received from black listed or suspended firms. (vii) The offer is conditional.
- If the successful firm fails / delays in performance of any of the obligations, under the Contract, violates any of the provisions of the Contract / Letter of Award, commits breach of any of the terms and conditions of the Contract or found

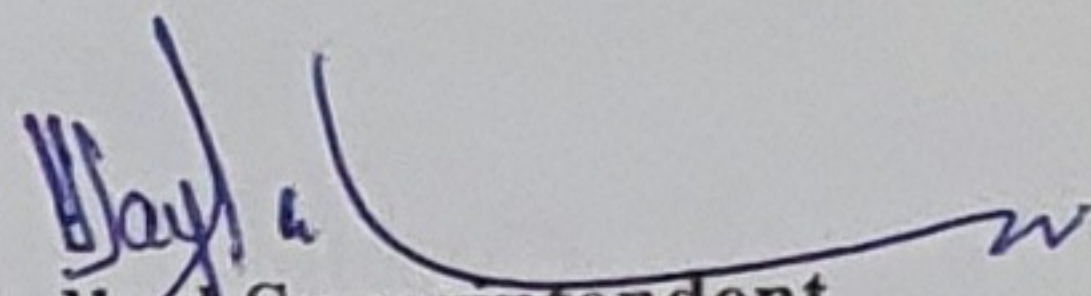

- to have engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the award of contract or during the execution of the contract, the institution may without prejudice to any other right of action / remedy it may have, blacklist the bidder, either indefinitely or for a stated period, for future tenders in public sector, as per provision of KPPRA Rules, 2014.
31. Any direct or indirect effort by a firm, to influence this Hospital during the process of selection of a bidder or award of contract may besides rejection of its bid result into disqualified the firm.
 32. Before payment, the concerned Department/End User of this Hospital shall inspect the Oxygen for meeting the quality and quantity against the prescribed specification. Any payment shall be processed after satisfactory assessment/inspection and acceptance by the Concerned Department/Inspection Committee of this Hospital, subject to the availability of budget from Govt.
 33. All defects in material/defective items will be corrected/replaced without any cost to the Hospital within the same days.
 34. The Bid Security as a performance Security may be forfeited if the Supplier/Vendor fails to deliver or supply goods/Services in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Contract Agreement.
 35. The responsive bidder shall have 07 days to accept the agreement. If no response is received within this period, the bidder shall be considered non-responsive, and the contract may be offered to the second lowest responsive bidder.
 36. Any shortcomings, deficiencies, or missing documents in the bid uploaded on EPADS shall be the sole responsibility of the bidder. Bids containing such deficiencies shall not be considered for evaluation and may be rejected.
 37. All general and special terms and conditions, along with all clauses, rules, regulations, and provisions included in the Standard Bidding Documents (SBD), shall be applicable to all firms, suppliers, sole distributors, and manufacturers participating in the supply process.
