INVITATION TO BID

1. BUITEMS, a public sector University situated at Quetta, invites sealed bids from reputable, experienced transport service providers registered with the income and sales tax departments and who are on the active taxpayers' list (ATL) of FBR in the relevant field
2. The procedure of open competitive bidding is Single Stage-One Envelope.
3. Bidding documents, which contain detailed terms and conditions, method of procurement, the procedure for submission of bids, bid security, bid validity, the opening of bid, evaluation criteria, clarification/rejection of bids, performance guarantee (where applicable), etc. are available for the interested bidders at “Directorate of Procurement, BUITEMS.” The non-refundable fee for the bidding document is Rs. 1,000 (One Thousand Rupees Only), payable by a pay order/demand draft in favour of the Director of Procurement, BUITEMS.
4. The bidders are required to furnish a bank deposit / CDR / pay order of Rs 20,000 (refundable) as Bid Security in favour of “Director Procurement, BUITEMS.” The BUITEMS shall reject any bid not accompanied by bid security as non-responsive and without any right of appeal.
5. The bids, prepared in accordance with the instructions in the bidding documents, must reach the Directorate of Procurement, BUITEMS, Airport Road on or before **12:00 pm** on **26th March 2026**. Bids will be opened at **12:30 pm** on the same day, in the presence of the bidder’s representatives who choose to attend at the same address. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Eligible Bidders.** - Bidding is open to all firms and persons meeting the following requirements:
 - a) Registered with the Income and Sales Tax Departments, Government of Pakistan
 - b) and who are on the Active Taxpayers List (ATL) of the Federal Board of Revenue(FBR), Government of Pakistan.
2. **Tender Document Fee (Non-Refundable).** - Bidding documents along with Pay Order / Demand Draft amounting to **Rs. 1,000/-** as a tender document fee (Non-Refundable) shall be submitted in favour of “Director Procurement, BUIITEMS”. No bid will be accepted without the tender documents fee.
3. **Bid Security (Refundable).** - The bidder is required to furnish a Deposit at Call (CDR) or a Bank Guarantee issued by a Scheduled Bank in Pakistan, Rs 20,000 as a Bid Security in favour of “Director Procurement.” The university shall reject any bid not accompanied by acceptable bid security as non-responsive and without any right of appeal.
 - a. The bid securities of unsuccessful bidders will be returned upon award of contract/Issuance of Purchase Order to the successful bidder or expiry of the validity of Bid Security, whichever is earlier.
 - b. The Bid Security may be forfeited:
 - i. If a bidder withdraws his bid during the period of bid validity
 - ii. If a bidder does not accept the correction of his bid price
 - iii. In case of a successful bidder, if he fails to sign the contract agreement or execute the work specified in the bill of quantities/ list of goods.
 - iv. In case of nonperformance of the contract, delayed supply/installations, or substandard supply/installation, short in quantity, the security deposited will be forfeited, and the firm will be blacklisted.
4. **Bid validity.** - All prices should be valid for at least **60 days.** Withdrawal or any modification of the original offer within the validity period shall entitle BUIITEMS, Quetta, to forfeit the bid security or ban such vendor participation in BUIITEMS tenders/works.
5. The Purchase/Work Order will be awarded on the **least-cost selection basis.**
6. All prices should be quoted on F.O.R. (Pak Rupees).

7. **Delivery time or Completion Schedule.** – The completion/delivery time from the purchase/work order date will be **30 days**. The handing over / completion time for this contract is of critical importance.
8. The bid proposal should include freight, all other taxes, and delivery of items at the BUITEMS, Takatu Campus, Quetta premises.
9. All pages (BoQs & Terms & Conditions) must be signed/stamped, failing which the bid may be rejected.
10. Any addition, deletion, or modification of any clause of the procurement terms and conditions of BUITEMS by any vendor will not be accepted. It may lead to rejection of the bid.
11. **Site Visits/Concerned Office.** - Before quoting, the bidder can visit the **Directorate of Procurement, BUITEMS, to see the requirements of each item/location** and to know the full implications of the assignment. Failure to do so will not absolve the vendor of his responsibility to carry out the work as specified in the tender documents. The vendor shall bear the cost of visiting the site and shall be responsible and at risk.
12. The bid form must be duly filled in, stamped, and signed by the bidder's authorized representative.
13. **Method of Procurement.** – The Procedure for this procurement opportunity is Open Competitive Bidding.
14. **Submission and opening of bids.** - The bid should be submitted in a sealed envelope so that the contents are fully enclosed and cannot be known until duly opened. The sealed bids must reach up to **26th March 2026** on or before **12:00 PM** and will be opened on the same date **at 12:30 PM** in the presence of available bidders. All bids submitted after the time prescribed shall be rejected and returned without being opened.
15. If the Government declares the opening date as a public holiday, the next working day shall be deemed the date for submission and opening of the tender at the same time and venue.
16. After the opening of bids, BUITEMS will examine the bids for completeness as per the tender document.

18. Clarification of bids. - After the opening of bids, bidders are not allowed to alter or modify their bids. However, the procuring agency may seek and accept clarifications to the bid that do not change the substance of the bid.

19. Arithmetic Errors. The tender shall be checked for any arithmetic errors and rectified. As determined after arithmetic corrections, the Tender Price shall be termed the Corrected Total Tender Price, binding upon the Tenderer.

20. Evaluation of bids. - Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation criteria and other terms and conditions outlined in the bidding documents.

21. Evaluation Criteria: Financial bids will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- The Tender will be evaluated on the **least-cost selection basis**
- Valid Fitness Certificate of Bus issued by MVE (mandatory)
- Company Profile and copies of CNIC, National Tax Number (NTN), and General Sales Tax (GST) certificates should be attached. (mandatory)
- Experience of the firm in the relevant field/services to any Federal or Provincial Universities, Education Boards, or the private sector etc., anywhere in Pakistan. Please attach Purchase Orders/Work Orders. (mandatory)
- The bidder who has not been blacklisted by any Federal or Provincial Government Department, Agency, Organisation, autonomous body, University, or Private Sector Organisation anywhere in Pakistan. The vendor will provide this undertaking on non-judicial stamp paper. (mandatory)
- Only buses with a model year of 2005 or above shall be considered

22. One Bid per Bidder. - Conditional or alternative bids are not allowed. Bidders are required to quote one bid.

23. BUIITEMS reserves the right to reject the bid if;

- i. Received without Bid Security.
- ii. Received later than the date and time fixed for tender submission.
- iii. The tender is unsigned/ unstamped.
- iv. The offer is ambiguous.
- v. The offer is conditional.
- vi. The offer is from a firm which is blacklisted by any Govt Office.
- vii. The offer is received by telephone/telex/fax/telegram.
- viii. Any unsigned/ambiguous erasing, cutting/overwriting, etc., are made.

24. BUIITEMS will inspect the supplied and provided items to verify their conformity to the Specifications given in BoQ. The inspection will be conducted after completion of the Purchase/Work Order.

25. The agent/supplier/manufacturer's sole responsibility is to comply with Pakistan's

applicable laws.

- 26.** Purchase order (s) will be awarded to the technically evaluated and recommended lowest bidder (s) based on the least cost/package-wise, according to the nature of BoQ.
- 27. Rejection of bids.** – BUIITEMS reserves the right to reject all bids or proposals at any time before accepting a bid or proposal. BUIITEMS will communicate the grounds for rejecting bids upon request of any supplier or contractor but is not liable to justify those grounds.
- 28. Extensions of Time.** - If at any time after issuance of the Purchase Order, the Supplier should encounter conditions impeding timely delivery of the Items under tender documents clause 07, the Supplier shall promptly notify the Purchaser in writing of the delay, its likely duration, and its cause. As soon as practicable after receipt of the Supplier’s notice, the Purchaser shall evaluate the situation and may, at its discretion, extend the Supplier’s time for delivery, in which case the extension shall be ratified by the parties by amendment of the Contract.
- 29. Liquidated Damages.** If the vendor fails to deliver the goods/services to BUIITEMS in time, then the penalty will be charged as follows:
 - a. 0.01% per day of the Purchase Order for the first 10 working days.
 - b. 0.15% per day of the Purchase Order, after that, up to a maximum of 10% of the sum stated in the Purchase/Work Order. Once the maximum is reached, the Purchaser may terminate the contract pursuant to tender clause 33; bid security and payment may be forfeited.
- 30.** If the delivered goods/services are not according to the required quality standards/specifications, they shall be liable to be rejected after inspection. The vendor would be required to supply as per the requirements mentioned in our BoQs; otherwise, the purchase/ work order will be canceled after the due date with confiscation of bid security.
- 31. On account payments.** - Part / Advance payments are not allowed. Payment will be made on submission of an Invoice in the name of “Director Procurement, BUIITEMS”, with a copy of delivery challan (s) after the complete order has been supplied, inspected, and accepted, which includes delivery/installation, and BUIITEMS acceptance/inspection thereof.
- 32. Blacklisting of Suppliers and Contractors.** - A procuring agency can permanently or temporarily bar the suppliers and contractors who either consistently failed to provide satisfactory performances or were found to be engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices from participation in its respective procurement proceedings.
- 33. Termination.**
 - 33.1 Termination for Default**
 - (a) The Purchaser, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of Contract, by Notice of default sent to the Supplier, may terminate the Contract in whole or in part:
 - (i) if the Supplier fails to deliver any or all of the Goods within the period specified in the Contract or within any extension thereof granted by the Purchaser.
 - (ii) if the Supplier fails to perform any other obligation under the Contract.

- (b) In the event the Purchaser terminates the Contract in whole or in part, the Purchaser may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, Goods or Related Services similar to those undelivered or not performed, and the Supplier shall be liable to the Purchaser for any additional costs for such similar Goods. However, the Supplier shall continue the performance of the Contract to the extent not terminated.
 - (c) if the Supplier, in the judgment of the Purchaser, has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the Contract.
- 34.** In case of any grievances, the matter will be redressed as per PPRA Rules.
- 35.** Deduction of Income Tax and any other tax will be made at source according to the Government's prevailing rules.
- 36.** The quantities given in the Bill of Quantities are estimated and provisional and are given to provide a common basis for bidding. The basis of payment will be the actual quantities of work executed and measured by the Bidder and verified by the Department/Concerned Office and valued at the rates and prices entered in the priced Bill of Quantities, where applicable, and otherwise at such rates and prices as the Purchaser may fix as per the Contract.
- 37.** Within ten(10) days of receiving notification of award from the Procuring Agency, the successful bidder shall furnish the performance security.
- 38.** The amount of Performance security shall be Rs. 250,000, which the Procuring Agency will retain for the period of the Contract agreement. The performance guarantee shall be denominated in the currency of the Contract acceptable to the Procuring Agency and shall be in one of the following forms:
- (a) a bank guarantee or
 - (b) a cashier's or certified cheque or CDR.
- 39.** BUIITEMS reserves the right to modify the quantities of goods/services at any time before the purchase/work order award.
- 40.** The bidder should furnish a certificate as worded below in token of acceptance of all the terms and conditions of the tender. Otherwise, the tender will not be considered under any circumstances.

Scope of Work

The *Service Provider* shall be responsible for providing a safe, reliable, and punctual transport service for BUIITEMS students on the route BUIITEMS Takatu Campus, Quetta to Kuchlak, Pishin and back, as per the details below:

1. Route and Distance

- Route: BUIITEMS Takatu Campus, Quetta ↔ Pishin
- Approximate Distance (one way): 55 kilometres
- Expected Round Trip Distance (daily): 110 kilometres (subject to actual route verification by BUIITEMS Transport Section)

2. Number and Type of Vehicle

- The service provider shall provide one (01) dedicated, well-maintained bus with a minimum seating capacity of 63
- The vehicle should be model year 2010 or newer, in excellent running and physical condition.
- The bus shall have the following mandatory features:
 - Comfortable cushioned seats with adequate leg space
 - First aid box
 - Fire extinguisher and emergency exit
 - Functional speedometer, odometer, and seat belts
 - Proper internal lighting, indicators, and horn
 - Vehicle fitness certificate issued by the Motor Vehicle Examiner

3. Operational Schedule

- The bus shall operate six (05) days a week (Monday to Friday), excluding official university holidays.
- Morning Schedule: The bus shall reach BUIITEMS Takatu Campus by 8:45 a.m. daily
- Return from BUIITEMS: After class hours, normally between 4:00 – 4:30 p.m., or as per the official schedule issued by the BUIITEMS Transport Section.
- Timing adjustments may be made by BUIITEMS during exams, semester breaks, or special events.

4. Parking and Fuel Arrangements

- In Quetta, the bus will be parked at BUIITEMS Takatu Campus.
- In Pishin, the service provider shall arrange secure night parking for the vehicle at its own expense and responsibility.
- Fuel will be provided by BUIITEMS based on a fixed consumption rate of 4 kilometres per liter of diesel.
- The service provider shall maintain a daily fuel logbook signed by the Transport Officer BUIITEMS, reflecting kilometres travelled, liters issued, and balance carried forward.

5. Driver and Crew

- The service provider shall employ a qualified, licensed, and experienced driver familiar with the Quetta–Pishin route.
- The driver must:
 - Possess a valid PSV license
 - Be physically fit and medically examined annually
 - Maintain good conduct, discipline, and cleanliness with a recent Police Clearance Certificate
- The service provider shall also provide a conductor/helper to assist with boarding, discipline, and maintenance of cleanliness inside the bus.
- The service provider will be fully responsible for the salary, benefits, and conduct of its staff.

6. Safety and Maintenance

- The service provider shall ensure the vehicle is mechanically fit and roadworthy at all times.
- Routine preventive maintenance and servicing must be carried out at least once a month.
- In case of vehicle breakdown, a replacement vehicle must be arranged within two (2) hours to avoid disruption of student transport.
- The vehicle must carry all necessary documents: route permit, registration, insurance, fitness certificate, and pollution certificate.
- The driver must strictly follow all traffic rules and safety regulations.
- Any accident, delay, or incident must be immediately reported to the BUIITEMS Transport Officer.

7. Cleanliness and Hygiene

- The bus must be cleaned daily, both interior and exterior.
- Seats, windows, and floor mats shall be kept dust-free and hygienic.
- The university reserves the right to inspect the bus regularly for hygiene and maintenance standards.

8. Attendance and Punctuality

- Daily attendance of the bus (arrival/departure time) will be recorded by BUIITEMS Transport Section.
- Repeated delays exceeding 15 minutes without valid reason will attract financial penalties.
- Absence or non-availability of bus on a working day without prior notice may result in deduction of daily service charges or termination of contract in case of repeated offenses.
- Insurance and Liability
- The service provider shall maintain comprehensive insurance covering the vehicle, passengers, third-party liabilities, and driver.
- BUIITEMS shall not be responsible for any accident, loss, or damage to the vehicle or personnel employed by the service provider.

9. Reporting and Coordination

- The service provider shall coordinate directly with the Transport Officer, BUIITEMS, for route planning, timing adjustments, and verification of services.
