2. Introduction

Pakistan Mineral Development Corporation (PMDC) is an autonomous body established in 1974, under the administrative control of Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division), Government of Pakistan and is engaged in exploration, evaluation, development, mining, value addition and marketing of mineral resources of Pakistan.

PMDC invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from internationally recognized and experienced consulting firms having expertise in Gemstone for undertaking Gemstone Exploration, Gemstone Resource Estimation (GRE) and Model Mine Design and Development of Ruby Project located in Aliabad area, District Hunza, Gilgit Baltistan (GB), Pakistan in accordance with internationally standards and best practices. *Firms pre-qualified/shortlisted through this EOI, will be entitled to receive request for proposal (RFP) at next stage on case-to-case basis.*

3. Project Background

The Gilgit–Baltistan (GB) region of northern Pakistan is one of the most prospective gemstone provinces globally due to its unique tectonic setting at the convergence of the Indian, Eurasian, and Kohistan–Ladakh plates. The region encompasses parts of the Karakoram Range, Himalaya, and Hindu Kush, forming a complex assemblage of metamorphic, igneous, and sedimentary terranes shaped by Himalayan orogeny. High-grade metamorphism, granitic intrusions, and pegmatitic activity have created favorable conditions for gemstone mineralization.

GB is globally known for ruby (Hunza), aquamarine (Shigar Valley), as well as topaz, tourmaline, garnet, spinel, peridot, and spodumene. Gemstones are typically associated with granitic pegmatites, metamorphic schists and gneisses, marbles, and skarn zones.


Despite longstanding artisanal mining, no systematic exploration and resource estimation project has yet been undertaken in any area. The reliable resource/reserve data is largely unavailable, and no model gemstone mine has yet been developed. In view of the significant geological potential, PMDC intends to execute Pilot GRE & Model Mine design project in Aliabad, Hunza District, Gilgit Baltistan, Pakistan. In accordance with the directives of Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division), PMDC intends to:

- Conduct systematic geoscientific exploration and modern data acquisition
- Establish internationally compliant gemstone resources
- Prepare a technically and economically viable model mine design



- Promote formalization, mechanization, and sustainable mining practices
- Attract strategic investors through transparent and internationally recognized standards

4. Objectives of the EOI

The objective of this EOI is to invite experienced international consulting firms to express interest in providing services for the Pilot Gemstone Resource Estimation (GRE) and Model Mine Design for ruby Project in Aliabad, Hunza District, Gilgit–Baltistan, Pakistan.

The selected consultant will undertake systematic ruby exploration, prepare internationally compliant resource estimates (NI 43-101 / JORC-equivalent), and develop a technically and economically viable model mine design to support sustainable and transparent sector development.

5. Scope of Work of the Project

The scope is intended to establish a benchmark, internationally compliant ruby resource and a technically sound model mine to support sustainable gemstone development in Gilgit Baltistan. The selected Consultant shall undertake, but not be limited to, the following scope of work for the Pilot Gemstone Resource Estimation (GRE) and Model Mine Design Project for ruby gemstone in Aliabad, Hunza District, Gilgit–Baltistan, Pakistan:

5.1 Data Review and Gap Analysis

- Review all available geological, exploration, mining, and production data.
- Conduct data validation, verification, and gap analysis.
- Prepare a detailed exploration strategy based on identified gaps.

5.2 Geological Mapping and Exploration

- Conduct detailed geological and structural mapping.
- Design and supervise trenching, channel sampling, and, where required, core drilling programs.
- Implement systematic sampling, logging, QA/QC protocols, and database management in accordance with international best practices.

5.3 Laboratory Testing and Gemological Evaluation

- Supervise sample preparation, testing, and gemstone quality assessment.
- Establish grade/quality classification criteria for ruby resources.

5.4 Resource Estimation

- Develop a geological and structural model of the deposit.
- Prepare a 3D resource model using appropriate software.
- Estimate gemstone resources in accordance with internationally recognized reporting standards (e.g., NI 43-101 / JORC-equivalent).
- Prepare a compliant Technical Report signed by a Qualified/Competent Person.

5.5 Model Mine Design

- Prepare conceptual to pre-feasibility level mine design.
- Recommend suitable mining methods (underground/open pit, as applicable).
- Develop preliminary mine layout, production schedule, and equipment selection.
- Estimate capital and operating costs.
- Conduct preliminary economic analysis.



5.6 Environmental and Sustainability Considerations

- Identify key environmental and social considerations.
- Propose sustainable mining, safety, and formalization measures suitable for the region.

5.7 Reporting

- Submit interim and final technical reports.
- Provide complete digital database, models, drawings, and supporting documentation.

6. Evaluation Criteria



8. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE APPLICANT(S)

8.1 LANGUAGE

The EOI Application and all related correspondence and documents must be written in English. Supporting documents and printed literature furnished by Applicant with the EOI may be in any other language if they are accompanied by appropriate translations of the submitted documents



in English and being duly certified. Supporting materials, which are not translated into English, will not be considered for short listing purpose.

8.2 KNOWLEDGE OF LOCAL CONDITIONS

The Applicant shall be obligated to fully inform itself of all local conditions and factors and all federal, provincial and local laws, regulations and guidelines which may have an effect on its ability to execute the Scope of Work. The Applicants shall have sole responsibility to determine and investigate all matters pertaining to the execution of the Scope of Work for the Project/Project that may affect the cost, duration and execution of the Scope of Work for the Project.

8.3 COST OF PREPARING EOI

Each Applicant shall bear and be solely responsible for all of the costs and expenses associated with or relating to the preparation and submission of this EOI.

8.4 CONSORTIUM

If Applicant is a Consortium, there must be a Consortium Leader appointed through a Power of Attorney executed by all Consortium Members individually, authorizing the Consortium Leader to act on their behalf and to enter into legally binding obligations.

In the event the Applicant is a Consortium, all communications and correspondence shall be routed through the Consortium Leader. The PMDC shall only correspond with the Consortium Leader and as such delivery of any notice, information or other correspondence to the Consortium Leader shall be deemed delivered to all the Members of Consortium.

The Members of Consortium shall not be entitled to submit another bid individually or as part of another consortium.

8.5 ELIGIBILITY

Undertaking on stamp paper/letterhead that the Applicant, or in case of a Consortium any of its members, is not involved in litigation or arbitration with any of provincial or Federal Government Department of Pakistan, any Agency of United nations, World Bank and Asian Development Bank. In case the firm was involved in any litigation or arbitration process, proof of dispute resolution along with history for the last five years.

An Applicant, or in case of Consortium any of its Members, declared Insolvent/blacklisted / debarred by any public sector organization or department in Pakistan shall be ineligible for short-listing. In this regard, the Applicant shall provide an Affidavit on stamp paper declaring that "Neither the Applicant nor its Directors, Stakeholders, as a whole or as a part of the firm have ever been declared as insolvent, blacklisted/ defaulted by any government agency/ department/organization". In case the Applicant is a Consortium, the Affidavit shall be provided by each Member of the Consortium



The Applicants, or in case of the Consortium its members, should belong to eligible countries as per current policies of the Federal Government of Pakistan.

The Applicants, or in case of Consortium, should not have any conflict of interest with PMDC.

For this EOI, the Consortium Leader shall be a firm that has successfully completed a minimum of two similar projects outside the country of its head office registration.

8.6 CLARIFICATION

The Applicants may request any clarification on any aspect of the EOI up to the date indicated in the timeline. Any request for clarification must be sent in writing by courier or email to DGM Procurement PMDC.

8.7 AMENDMENTS IN EOI DOCUMENTS

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of EOI, PMDC may amend the EOI document by issuing an addendum. Any addendum issued shall be part of the EOI document.

To give Applicants reasonable time to take an addendum into account in preparing their applications, PMDC may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of applications.

8.8 LATE APPLICATION

Any application received by PMDC after the deadline/Due Date for submission of applications will not be entertained

8.9 DOCUMENTS ESTABLISHING THE QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANT

To establish its qualifications, the Applicant shall provide the information requested in the corresponding sheets, Evaluation Criteria etc. in the form of verifiable documentary evidence.

8.10 SUBMISSION OF EOI APPLICATION

Each Applicant shall prepare and submit **one (1) printed original, two (2) printed copies of its EOI Application, clearly marking each one as "Original", "Copy No. 1", "Copy No. 2", etc.,** as appropriate. In the event of any discrepancy between the copies and the original, the original shall govern.

- I. The original and all printed copies of the EOI application shall be typed or written in indelible ink. The person or person who is duly authorized shall sign the EOI application by:
 - i. Signing the original EOI Application; and
 - ii. Initialing all the pages of the EOI document.



- II. The relevant EOI application shall contain no alterations, omissions or additions, unless such corrections are signed by the person or persons duly authorized.

b) Sealing and Marking of EOI Applications

- III. The Applicant shall seal the Original EOI Application along copies in envelope, with mark **"EOI Application for Pre – qualification against Gemstones Exploration Project of PMDC"**
- IV. The outer and inner envelope shall each indicate the name and address of the Applicant (in case of a Consortium, the name and address of the Consortium Leader) to enable the relevant EOI Application to be returned unopened if it is declared "late".

8.11 Application Submission Date and Time

EOI applications should be submitted via post, online or in person on or before **[3 PM, local time] on [April 16, 2026] to the office of Deputy General Manager Procurement PMDC, Plot No.13, Sector-H/9, Islamabad (Dgm-Pro@PMDC.Gov.PK)** in the manner and form as detailed in this EOI document, which shall be opened on the same day by the Procurement committee in the presence of representatives of the firms who chose to attend at **[3:30 PM, Local time]**. PMDC reserves the right to reject any or all the proposals any time before the award of contract as per provisions contained in PPRA Rules.

8.12 CONFIDENTIALITY

Information relating to the evaluation of Applications, and recommendation for short-listing, shall not be disclosed to the Applicants or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until the notification of short-listing is made to all Applicants.

8.13 CLARIFICATIONS OF APPLICATIONS

To assist in the evaluation of applications, PMDC may, at its discretion, ask any Applicant for a clarification of its application which shall be submitted within a stated reasonable period of time. Any request for clarification and all clarifications shall be in writing.

If an Applicant does not provide clarifications of the information requested by the deadline, the application shall be evaluated based on the information and documents available at the time of evaluation of the application. Failing to provide requisite information may lead to rejection / disqualification of application.

8.14 RESPONSIVENESS OF APPLICATIONS

All applications not responsive to the requirements of the EOI Documents shall be rejected. PMDC will carry out a preliminary examination of each application to determine whether it is complete, whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether it is generally in order.



Any application found to be non-responsive may be rejected by the Client and not included for further consideration.

8.15 NOTIFICATION OF SHORT-LISTING

PMDC shall promptly notify each Applicant as to whether or not it has been shortlisted after completing the process and short-listing procedure.

8.16 INTERPRETATION & FINAL DETERMINATION

The interpretation and final determination of any matter relating to the EOI Document, all enclosed documents, sections, compliance documents etc. as well as any additional or supplementary information required by PMDC will be at PMDC's sole discretion which shall be final and binding on the Applicants.

8.17 USE OF INFORMATION

Permission for disclosure of information submitted by an Applicant as part of the EOI is not required for the release of information to PMDC, its governing bodies/departments, its consultants, advisors and personnel for the purpose of evaluation of application and short-listing.

8.18 CONFLICT OF INTEREST

PMDC may confirm the status of the Applicant for the sake of conflict of interest before completion of the short-listing process. For this purpose, the Applicant shall be required to provide this information in specific terms, and any misrepresentation shall be made ground for rejection. Applicants shall note that in case of their selection, any such links, if detected during the course of their contract, would be reported by PMDC to PPRA for cancellation of its registration/license leading to their blacklisting.
