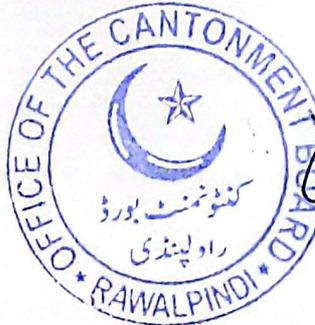

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS OF PROCUREMENT PRODUCT

The garbage carts shall meet the following minimum technical specifications:

2	Capacity	120 Liters
3	Material	High Density Poly propylene (PP) / Food Grade
4	Manufacturing Process	Injection molded construction ensuring strength and durability
5	Dimensions	Approx. Height 35.5 inches, Width 19 inches, side 21 inches
6	Weight	Lightweight but heavy-duty design suitable for daily municipal use
7	Lid	Hinged lid to prevent odor and protect waste from rain
8	Wheels	Two heavy-duty rubber wheels with corrosion resistant steel axle
9	UV Protection	UV stabilized material suitable for outdoor use
10	Handling	Ergonomic handle design for easy maneuvering
11	Load Capacity	Suitable for household and commercial solid waste collection
12	Color	Green / Grey or as approved by Rawalpindi Cantonment Board
13	Branding	RCB logo and serial number to be printed/embossed on each cart
14	Durability	Weather resistant, corrosion free and crack resistant

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

(Supply and fixing of 1400 Nos. PolyCarts – 120 Liters)

These Special Conditions of Contract shall be read in conjunction with the General Conditions of Contract, PPRA Rules 2004, and the terms contained in the bidding documents. In case of any conflict, these Special Conditions shall prevail.

1. Scope of Work

The contractor shall manufacture, supply, transport, deliver, and install a total of 1400 Nos. Poly Carts of 120-liter capacity at locations specified by Rawalpindi Cantonment Board (RCB).

The scope includes:

- Manufacturing of garbage carts as per approved technical specifications
- Transportation to designated locations within Rawalpindi Cantonment area
- Fixing / installation at designated sites if required
- Marking / embossing of RCB logo and serial numbers on each cart.

2. Technical Specifications

The garbage carts shall strictly conform to the specifications provided in the bidding documents including:



- **Material:** High Density Poly propylene (PP) / food grade quality
- **Capacity:** 120 Liters
- **Dimensions:** Approx. Height 35.5 inches, Width 19 inches, side 21 inches
- **Design:** Ergonomic design suitable for municipal waste collection
- **Wheels:** Heavy duty rubber wheels with steel axle
- **Lid:** Hinged lid to prevent rainwater and odor
- **UV Protection:** UV stabilized material suitable for outdoor conditions
- **Color:** As approved by RCB
- **Branding:** RCB logo and serial number on each cart

Any deviation from specifications shall render the supply liable for rejection.

3. Delivery Period

The contractor shall complete the supply and delivery of all carts within 15 days from the issuance of the Work Order.

RCB may allow extension of time only in genuine cases subject to written approval.

4. Inspection and Quality Assurance

RCB reserves the right to conduct:

- Factory inspection during manufacturing
- Inspection at delivery stage
- Random quality testing

Any cart found defective, substandard, or not meeting specifications shall be rejected and replaced by the contractor at his own cost.

5. Warranty

The contractor shall provide minimum one (01) year warranty against:

- Manufacturing defects
- Structural failure
- Wheel damage due to poor manufacturing
- Lid damage due to poor quality material

During the warranty period, the contractor shall repair or replace defective carts free of cost.

6. Payment Terms

Payment shall be made after successful delivery, inspection, and certification by the concerned officer of RCB.

The contractor shall submit:

- Invoice
- Delivery challan
- Inspection certificate
- Any other required documents

All applicable taxes and statutory deductions shall be deducted as per Government rules.



7. Liquidated Damages / Penalty

In case of delay in supply beyond the stipulated delivery period, liquidated damages at the rate of 0.05% of the contract value per day shall be imposed subject to a maximum of 10% of the contract value.

8. Performance Security

The successful bidder shall furnish Performance Security equal to 5% of the contract value in the form of CDR / Bank Guarantee in favor of the Cantonment Executive Officer, RCB, within 07 days of issuance of Letter of Acceptance.

Failure to submit performance security may lead to cancellation of the contract and forfeiture of earnest money.

9. Replacement of Defective Items

If any garbage cart is found damaged or defective during inspection or within the warranty period, the contractor shall replace the defective cart within 03 days at his own cost.

10. Risk & Responsibility

The contractor shall bear all risks during manufacturing, transportation, unloading, and delivery of the garbage carts until they are officially handed over to Rawalpindi Cantonment Board.

11. Taxes & Duties

The contractor shall be responsible for payment of all applicable taxes including Income Tax, Sales Tax, and other statutory levies under prevailing Government laws.

12. Termination of Contract

RCB reserves the right to terminate the contract in case of:

- Failure to supply within stipulated time
- Supply of substandard products
- Violation of contract terms
- Corrupt or fraudulent practices

In such case, performance security may be forfeited and the work may be assigned to another contractor at the risk and cost of the defaulting contractor.

13. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute arising out of the contract shall be resolved through mutual consultation. In case of unresolved matters, the decision of the Director Military lands and Cantonments Rawalpindi Region shall be final, subject to applicable laws.

14. Governing Law

This contract shall be governed by PPRA Rules 2004 and Cantonments Act 1924.
