REMOVAL FROM SERVICE NOTICE IN RESPECT OF
MR TARIQ ABBAS, ASSISTANT (BS-16)

WHEREAS, disciplinary proceedings were initiated against Mr. Tariq Abbas, Assistant (Bs-16, Bureau of Emigration and Overseas Employment, Islamabad under civil Servant (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules 2020 vide a Show Cause Notice dated 12.09.2024 on charge of "misconduct" as defined in Rule 2(1)(k) of said Rules on following charges:-

- He has been absent from official duty w.e.f. 13.02.2019 after availing two years Extra Ordinary Leave.
- The reply of Explanation (issued on 12.04.2019) submitted by him was not satisfactory, wherein he mentioned he needed five (05) years to complete his PhD which had already elapsed.
- According to Higher Education Commission, his study programme was supposed to be completed in 2023 but he neither contacted back to his employer nor HEC and hence found absent wilfully absent.
- He had been given fair chance of personal hearing after issuance of a Final Show Cause Notice, where he had ensured to join back services, he did not act upon his assurance.
- His such non-compliant behaviour is contrary to official discipline and conduct, which tantamount to misconduct and his prejudicial to good order and service discipline.
- He remained absent from duty for a period of seven years.

- After going through the record of the case and notwithstanding given fair chances of joining back the service, the Director General, Bureau of Emigration and Overseas Employment being authority in terms of Rule 2(1)(c) of the Civil Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) Rules, 2020, read with rule 6 of the Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules 1973, has been pleased to impose a major penalty of "Removal from Service" upon Mr Tariq Abbas, Assistant (BS-16), Bureau of Emigration and Overseas Employment, Islamabad in accordance with Rule 4(3)(d) read with proviso (ii) to Rule 16(7)(b) of the Civil Servants (Efficiency & Discipline) rules, 2020.
- He will have a right to file appeal against this order to the Appellate Authority under of this Civil Servants (Appeal) Rules, 1977 within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issuance of this order.
- This issues with the approval of Director General (BE & OE).
