- Submission of false or misleading information shall lead to disqualification.
- PEC reserves the right to verify submitted documents/information from original sources.
- The framework agreement will be valid for one year, extendable for further two years as per PPRA Rules subject to satisfactory performance.
- Being pre-qualified shall not confer any right to claim award of work; assignments shall be issued on need basis.

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
