**INVITATION TO BID.**

Collectorate of Customs (Enforcement), Peshawar invites EPADs/sealed bids from authorized firms, contractors and general order suppliers registered with Sales Tax /Income Tax Departments along with KPRA and are on active tax payer list (ATL) of FBR. The tender is for transportation and destruction/disposal of seized/confiscated goods from all State Warehouses and Anti-Smuggling Units of Collectorate of Customs (Enforcement), Peshawar to concerned points of destruction (Peshawar, DIK-Rata Kulachi), during the current financial year 2025-26. Transportation of seized/confiscated goods will be made with the help of heavy goods vehicles (HGVs), articulated lorries, or large trailers and will be destructed in the supervision of deputed staff.

02. Bidding documents containing terms and conditions are available in HQ: General Branch of Collectorate of Customs (Enforcement) Custom House, Peshawar on payment of Rs. 5,000/- as per rule 23(5) of PPRA Rule 2004 (Non-Refundable).

3. Only those participants who already have worked with Pakistan Customs for Transportation of Goods/Vehicles in the past (03) three years are eligible for the bidding process.

4. The bids, prepared in accordance with the instructions in the bidding documents much reach the office of Assistant Collector (HQ), Collectorate of Customs (Enforcement), Custom House, Peshawar on or before 20<sup>th</sup> June 2026 up to 10:00am and will be opened on the same day at 11:00am in the presence of the bidders.

## **Instruction to Bidders**

1. The Collectorate of Customs Enforcement Peshawar invites Quotation from renowned firms/companies registered with SECP, PEC, Income Tax/Sales Tax Departments and are on Active Taxpayer List of FBR (I.T & GST).
2. Quotation procedure will be based upon "**Single Stage-Single Envelope**" bidding method.
3. Bids complete in all respect should reach the office of the undersigned up to 20<sup>th</sup> **June 2026 till 10:00am hours** and Bid will be opened at 11:00am hours on same day in the conference hall of Customs House Peshawar.
4. The Collectorate of Customs Enforcement reserves the right to accept or reject at any time prior to the acceptance of any or all the tenders / bids.
5. Bidders shall submit bids for each individual site.
6. The work should be completed **within \_\_\_\_ Months from signing** of Contract Agreement.
7. Joint Venture (JV) and Subcontracting of any sort is not allowed.
8. Abnormally low bids will be rejected. Also, the bidders are to submit market analysis report along with the financial bid.
9. The Bid Security shall be in the form of Call Deposit bearing Name of Firm in favor of Assistant Collector, (HQ), Collector of Custom (Enforcement), Peshawar from local scheduled Bank of Pakistan in the technical envelop. Without call deposit the firms shall be rejected in the technical evaluation stage. Cash /cheque will not be accepted.
10. The contractor will submit the documentary evidence as per instructions in the bidding documents, without which tender will be liable for rejection.
11. A Challan (non-refundable) amounting to PKR 5,000/- (Rupees five Thousand Only), issued in favor of Assistant Collector (HQ), Collector of Customs (Enforcement), Peshawar, from any scheduled bank operating in Pakistan.
12. Pre-bid meeting will be held on 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2026 at Custom House, Peshawar. The details regarding quantity of confiscated goods, specific points of destruction will be communicated. Only the bidders who attend the pre-bid meeting will be eligible for the submission of the bids.

### **Bids Evaluation Criteria:**

- Bids will be evaluated in a fair, transparent and non-discriminatory manner.
  - The work will be awarded to the most advantageous bid after evaluation based on Least Cost Criteria under Single Stage-Single Envelope.
  - **General Terms & Conditions**
1. The Terms & Conditions are as under:  
No Quotation will be considered if: -
    - a) Received without required documentation or found incomplete.
    - b) Received later than the date and time fixed for Quotation submission.
    - c) The Quotation is unsigned/ unstamped.
    - d) The Quotation is signed/stamped by the unauthorized agent of the Firm/company.
    - e) The Quotation is from a firm which is blacklisted or in litigation of some sort with any Public- Sector Organization.
    - f) In contradiction with the specification given by The Collectorate of Customs Enforcement Peshawar.

1. Suppliers, who are on Active Taxpayers List (ATL) of FBR, both GST and Income Tax are eligible to apply.
2. Bidders will have to produce proof of being a Tax Filer with FBR.
3. Income tax as applicable and announced by the Govt. of Pakistan will be deducted at source.
4. The payment will be made after successful completion of all items and job, for the items accepted by The Collectorate of Customs Enforcement Peshawar
5. The rates must be quoted **as per pattern** and in PKR.
6. Prices should be valid for \_\_\_ **days**.
7. Any attempt by a bidder to influence the evaluation, comparison, and post qualification of the Bids or Contract award decisions may result in the rejection of its bid.
8. The Collectorate of Customs Enforcement Peshawar reserves the right to accept or reject the bid at any time prior to the acceptance of any or all the tenders / bids.
9. In case of a delay in delivery, a penalty will be imposed as per the contract agreement.
10. In cases lowest bidder refuses or fails to supply the item(s) within the deadline(s), the Work Order may be offered to the next lowest bidder and same principle for 3rd and so on at risk and expense of the firm/company.
11. Applicable Income tax and GST will be deducted at source/as per rules. In case of exemption, please mention and attach the proper documentation duly verified from the concerned tax authorities/FBR; however, if The Collectorate of Customs Enforcement Peshawar will be final authority to accept or reject the exemption certificate and the vendor may claim refund from Tax Authorities/FBR.
12. In case any holiday is announced by the Govt. OR any other unforeseeable circumstances that prevent the Quotation from being opened on the date announced (Force Majure), the tenders will be opened on the VERY NEXT WORKING DAY. Time and venue of the Quotation will remain as mentioned in the Quotation notice.
13. The documents prepared by the Bidder as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the Bid shall be in English only.
14. The currency of the quotation would be in Pakistan Rupees only.
15. In case of calculation error, the unit price will be considered as valid.
16. Any proposal/Quotation received by The Collectorate of Customs Enforcement Peshawar after the deadline will be returned unopened to the bidder concerned. Delays in the mail or courier, delays of person in transit, or delivery of a proposal to the wrong office shall not be accepted as an excuse for failure to deliver a proposal at the proper place and time. It shall be the bidder's responsibility to determine the manner in which timely delivery of his proposal will be accomplished either in person / mail to the concerned office.
17. In case a firm/company submits two bids/options against our tender; the bid with the highest value/amount will be considered.
18. Payment will be made as per actual quantity provided/supplied & accepted.
19. The Collectorate of Customs Enforcement Peshawar is authorized to vary quantities at the time of establishing the contract or as decided latterly according to its requirement and budget.
20. Do not submit any other document other than demanded.
21. No request for correction will be entertained after opening of the bid.
