

**Tender Notice for Production of Pakistan-China Friendship Song, Concert at the Great Wall of China and Drone Show**

The Embassy of Pakistan, Beijing, located at No. 1, Dongzhimenwai Dajie, Sanlitun, Chaoyang District, Beijing, invites sealed quotations from reputable Chinese event management companies, cultural production agencies, music production houses and drone show service providers for the production of a Pakistan-China Friendship Song, organization of a concert at the Great Wall of China, and an accompanying drone and light show as part of commemorative activities marking the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations between Pakistan and China.

The project comprises the following components:

1. Recording, production and post-production of a Pakistan-China Friendship Song featuring Chinese and Pakistani artists.
2. Organization and management of a concert at the Great Wall of China for the launch and promotion of the friendship song.
3. Provision and operation of a drone and light show comprising approximately 1,000 drones for a performance of 10–15 minutes.
4. Event planning, stage management, technical support, sound and lighting arrangements, audiovisual production and associated logistics.
5. Coordination with relevant Chinese authorities and venue management entities for permissions and operational arrangements.
6. Provision of all necessary manpower, equipment and organizational support required for successful execution of the project.

2. All participating firms must provide valid registration documents issued by the competent authorities of the People's Republic of China along with relevant tax registration certificates.
3. Bidders shall demonstrate proven experience in organizing large-scale cultural events, concerts, music productions and/or drone shows.
4. Financial proposals shall clearly indicate all applicable costs.
5. Bidders shall submit a comprehensive implementation plan outlining timelines, technical specifications, safety measures and contingency arrangements.
6. The proposal for the drone and light show shall specify the number of drones, duration of performance, technical capabilities, safety certifications and previous experience.
7. Bidders shall ensure compliance with all applicable Chinese laws and regulations.
8. The successful bidder shall be responsible for obtaining all necessary permits and approvals.
9. All quoted prices shall be inclusive of taxes, service charges and any other applicable fees.
10. The selected company shall ensure high-quality production standards and timely completion of all deliverables.
