Subject:- **BIDDING DOCUMENTS / INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDERS IN RESPECT OF PROCUREMENT OF AMBULANCES UNDER THE PROJECT TITLED “STRENGTHENING POINTS OF ENTRY AND BORDER HEALTH SERVICES PAKISTAN”**

1. Border Health Services – Pakistan (BHSP) intends to invite sealed bids from eligible firms/manufacturers/authorized dealers for procurement of ambulances under PSDP Project titled “Strengthening Points of Entry and Border Health Services Pakistan” in pursuance of Rule 36(b) of PPRA Rules, 2004 i.e. Single Stage – Two Envelope Procedure.
 - 1.1 Procurement shall be made from PSDP allocation of Border Health Services – Pakistan (BHSP) for Financial Year 2026-27.
 - 1.2 Detail showing estimated requirement and deployment locations of ambulances is as under:

2. In addition to the bidding criteria as laid down in these bidding documents, standard terms and conditions, inter alia, shall be as under:
- 2.1 The bidders must be registered with FBR for the purpose of Income Tax and General Sales Tax. Copies of NTN, GST Registration and Active Taxpayer List (ATL) status shall be attached.
 - 2.2 The bidders must be manufacturers or authorized dealers/distributors of ambulances/vehicles.
 - 2.3 The bidders must not have been blacklisted by any Government/Semi-Government/Autonomous organization. Certificate to this effect shall be provided on judicial stamp paper.
 - 2.4 The bidders shall have relevant experience in supply of ambulances/vehicles to Government/Semi-Government/Autonomous organizations.
 - 2.5 The bidders shall provide documentary evidence regarding availability of after-sales services, maintenance support and warranty facilities in Pakistan.
3. Bidders shall produce following information regarding their business along with bids on their organization letter head duly signed and stamped:
- 3.1 Firm's Name and Official Address along with year of establishment.
 - 3.2 Complete Mailing Address, Telephone Numbers, Email Address, Bank Account Details and Owner/Authorized Representative particulars.
 - 3.3 Status of Company i.e. Manufacturer / Authorized Dealer / Distributor.
 - 3.4 Manufacturer Authorization Certificate, where applicable.
 - 3.5 Complete technical literature/brochures of offered vehicles and ambulance equipment.

4. The form, language and other requisites of bids shall be as follows:
- 4.1 The bid(s) shall be in the form of sealed envelope(s) addressed to:
- Project Director**
Strengthening of Points of Entry & Border Health Services – Pakistan
Block No. 47, Pakistan Secretariat, Saddar, Karachi.
- 4.2 Bid related documents/correspondence shall be in English language.
- 4.3 The bid(s) shall be on printed letterhead of the firm.
- 4.4 All pages of bids and supporting documents shall be properly signed and stamped by the authorized person of the firm.
- 4.5 Technical Proposal and Financial Proposal shall be sealed separately and clearly marked as:
- TECHNICAL PROPOSAL
 - FINANCIAL PROPOSAL
- 4.6 Bidders may participate in one or both Lots.
- 4.7 Incomplete, conditional or unsigned bids shall be rejected.
5. Open Competitive Bidding shall be conducted under Rule 36(b) of PPRA Rules, 2004 i.e. Single Stage – Two Envelope Procedure.
- 5.1 Financial Proposals of technically non-responsive bidders shall be returned unopened.
6. The bids shall be in sealed package(s) in such manner that contents are fully secured and cannot be known till opening of bids.
- 6.1 No bid shall be allowed to be modified, altered or withdrawn after opening of bids except as provided under PPRA Rules, 2004.
- 6.2 Correction in bid of any type including cutting/overwriting/typographical mistakes shall not be entertained unless authenticated by authorized signatory.
- 6.3 Border Health Services – Pakistan may seek clarification(s), if required, during evaluation process in accordance with PPRA Rules.
7. The Purchase/Procurement Committee shall evaluate all bids in the light of criteria laid down in these bidding documents.
- 7.1 Evaluation shall be carried out Lot-wise.
- 7.2 The bids shall be evaluated on the basis of:

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- Eligibility requirements,
 - Compliance with technical specifications,
 - Submission of mandatory documents,
 - Relevant experience,
 - Warranty and after-sales services,
 - Delivery capability,
 - and Lowest Evaluated Responsive Bidder basis.
8. The Evaluation Report shall be announced in accordance with Rule 35 of PPRA Rules, 2004 before approval of final recommendations by the Competent Authority.
9. The price of each item/vehicle shall be clearly written/typed inclusive of all applicable taxes, duties, registration charges, freight, transportation, delivery and allied charges in firm and final manner leaving no ambiguity in Financial Bid.
- 9.1 Prices quoted shall remain valid for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of opening of Financial Bids.
- 9.2 Any conditional, ambiguous or incomplete offer in any respect shall be rejected.
- 9.3 All pages of bidding documents must be properly signed and stamped.
10. The Bid Security shall be furnished as follows:
- 10.1 The bidder shall furnish Bid Security equivalent to 2% of total quoted bid price in the form of Call Deposit Receipt (CDR), Pay Order or Bank Guarantee issued by a Scheduled Bank of Pakistan in favour of Director, Border Health Services – Pakistan, Karachi.
- 10.2 Any bid not accompanied with required Bid Security shall be rejected.
- 10.3 Bid Security shall be returned to unsuccessful bidders after completion of procurement process.
- 10.4 Bid Security shall be forfeited if:
- the bidder withdraws bid during validity period,
 - fails to sign contract agreement,
 - or fails to furnish required Performance Security.
11. The successful bidder shall furnish Performance Security equivalent to 10% of the Contract Price in accordance with Rule 39 of the PPRA Rules, 2004 and the Contract Conditions.


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TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

LOT – I

STANDARD AMBULANCES (1100–1300 CC)

The ambulances shall be brand new, latest model, and fully compliant with the technical requirements specified in **Annexure-A (Technical Compliance Sheet)**, which shall form an integral part of these Bidding Documents. Bidders shall provide complete compliance against each specification contained therein, along with supporting original manufacturer's technical literature/brochures. Equivalent or higher specifications/features shall be acceptable, subject to operational suitability and approval of the Procuring Agency.

LOT – II

SPECIALIZED BORDER / REMOTE AREA AMBULANCES (2200–3500 CC)

The ambulances shall be brand new, latest model, and fully compliant with the technical requirements specified in **Annexure-B (Technical Compliance Sheet)**, which shall form an integral part of these Bidding Documents. Bidders shall provide complete compliance against each specification contained therein, along with supporting original manufacturer's technical literature/brochures. Equivalent or higher specifications/features shall be acceptable, subject to operational suitability and approval of the Procuring Agency.

12. Delivery of ambulances shall be completed within ninety (90) days from issuance of Supply Order/Purchase Order.

- 12.1** All vehicles shall be delivered at consignee locations specified by Border Health Services – Pakistan.
- 12.2** Inspection shall be carried out by the authorized Inspection Committee of Border Health Services – Pakistan.
- 12.3** Any vehicle not conforming to specifications may be rejected.
- 12.4** Payment shall be made after satisfactory inspection and acceptance.
- 12.5** Border Health Services – Pakistan reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantities of ambulances as per operational requirements, availability of funds and applicable PPRA Rules. The Procuring Agency may require delivery, inspection and handing over of the ambulances at any designated location within Pakistan


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13. In case of delay in delivery or commissioning (where applicable) beyond the stipulated period, liquidated damages @ **0.1%** of the value of the delayed or undelivered portion of the contract per day shall be imposed, subject to a maximum of **10%** of the total contract value, unless such delay is caused by force majeure.
14. Border Health Services – Pakistan may, at any time before the deadline for submission of bids, modify / amend bidding documents by issuing corrigendum/addendum in accordance with PPRA Rules, 2004.
15. Interested bidders requiring any clarification regarding bidding documents may submit written request to Director, Border Health Services – Pakistan during office hours before closing date of bids.
16. Bidder shall bear all costs associated with preparation and submission of bids.
17. Supplied vehicles shall carry minimum one-year warranty along with after-sales support and availability of spare parts.
18. As provided under Rule 33(1) of PPRA Rules, 2004, Border Health Services – Pakistan reserves the right to reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to acceptance of bid/proposal.
19. Under Rule 48 of PPRA Rules, 2004, all grievances/issues shall be redressed through Grievance Redressal Committee constituted by the Competent Authority.
20. Procurement shall be subject to availability / release of PSDP funds for FY 2026-27.
