Detailed Technical Specification – Tyres for Electric Urban Transit Buses:

1. The tyres shall be a new, tubeless, all-steel radial tyres specifically designed and marketed by the manufacturer for Urban Transit/City Bus service, including electric buses operating under frequent stop-start conditions and regenerative braking. Highway/Coach/Regional or Mixed-Service tyres shall not be accepted.
2. The tyres shall comply with UNECE Regulation No. 54 (ECE R54) or an equivalent internationally recognised standard.
3. The tyres shall have reinforced sidewalls suitable for repeated kerb impacts, high-load urban operation, and high-torque electric drive systems.
4. The tread compound shall be designed for:
 - Frequent acceleration and braking.
 - Regenerative braking
 - High mileage in urban service.
 - Low rolling resistance to maximise EV range.
5. The offered tyres shall have a Load Index and Speed Rating not less than those specified by the bus OEM.
6. The bidder shall submit the manufacturer's technical data sheet and catalogue clearly identifying the offered tyres as Urban Transit/City Bus (or equivalent terminology such as Municipal Bus, City Bus, or Urban Service). Tyres designated by the manufacturer for Highway Coach, Long-Haul, Regional, or Mixed Service shall be considered non-responsive.
7. Tyres shall not be more than 12 months old on the date of supply and shall carry a minimum 5-year manufacturer's warranty against manufacturing defects.
