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A. General	
1. Scope of Application	1.1 “Invitation for Prequalification”, Pakistan State Oil Company Limited has defined the procedure of obtaining prequalification document in invitation of Prequalification (IoP) and in invitation to Applicants. Therefore, Prequalification Data sheet (Section II), refers both head to all the potential prospective applicants for collection and submission of prequalification document. All prospective applicants who will be interested in submitting applications for Supply & Installation of Laptops at PSO Head Office Karachi shall comply with the requirement as specified in Section IV (Schedule of Requirements), otherwise considered as disqualified.
2. Fraud and Corruption	2.1 The Pakistan State Oil Company Limited requires that the Applicants observe the highest standard of ethics during the agreements period. 2.2 The Applicants/Bidders shall allow Pakistan State Oil Company Limited to inspection of all accounts, records and other documents relating to Application/Bid submission (whether declared or not) Primary Procurement process, Framework Agreement performance, Secondary Procurement process, and/or Call-off Contract performance and in the case of award of a Call-off Contract. 2.3 Any communications between the Applicant and the Pakistan State Oil Company Limited related to matters of alleged corrupt and fraudulent practices must be made in writing or in electronic forms that provide record of the content of communication. 2.4 Pakistan State Oil company limited will reject an application or bid or proposal, if it is established that the



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	Applicant or the Bidder or Prospective was engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices in competing for the contract. 2.5 Pakistan State Oil company limited will also declare the Applicant as blacklisted in accordance with Public Procurement Rule 19.
3. Eligible Applicants	3.1 Only manufacturers/suppliers/contractors/Vendors are allowed to participate in prequalification process. 3.2 Applicants shall be considered to have a conflict of interest, if they participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications or have been hired or proposed to be hired by the PSO for execution of subsequent Framework Agreement(s) or Call off Contract(s). In addition, Applicants may be considered to have a conflict of interest if they have a close business or family relationship with such professional staff of the PSO who: (a) are directly or indirectly involved in the preparation of the Prequalification Documents or Bidding Documents or specifications of the Framework Agreement or Call-off Contract and/or the Prequalification or Bid evaluation process of such Contract; or (b) Would be involved in the implementation or supervision of such Framework Agreement or Call-off Contract, unless the conflict stemming from such relationship has been resolved throughout the Procurement Process, Bidding process during the execution of the Framework Agreement and/or Call-off Contract. 3.3 An Applicant that has been declared debarred or blacklisted shall be ineligible to be prequalified to bid or enter into any Framework Agreement or Call-off Contract for such period of time and for such type of procurement for which he



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has been declared debarred or blacklisted. The list of debarred firms and individuals is available at PPRA's website.

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3.5 Vendor Performance Evaluation shall be made on all Purchase Order worth Rs. 3 Million.

- (a) Successful Bidder's performance has been monitored through Vendor Performance Evaluation System.
- (b) The evaluation will be conducted in accordance with the parameters of Vendor Performance Report as attached in SAP Ariba project.
- (c) Bidder's performance will be evaluated from issuance of purchase order to Goods receipt, not limited to this, it shall also cover the period of performance / support during the warranty period.
- (d) In case of monthly payments, vendor performance evaluation will be conducted every month and on the basis of that VPES will automatically calculate the scoring of the vendor and an average of all VPES scores will consider as the final score of that project.
- (e) Following Scoring / Ranking Grid will be used to evaluate vendor performance against the awarded project:

- (f) In view of above, vendor scores less than three in two projects of a fiscal year should considered as non-performer, and may attract temporary blacklisting for six (6) months, subject to the procedure as provided in PPRA rules and the Company Policy.



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	(g) Vendor Cumulative Score less than 3 in a Fiscal year on the basis of performance evaluation of at least 3 procurement projects, then it will be considered to be Non-Performing Vendor and can be recommended for upto 3 years temporary blacklisting subject to the procedure as provided in PPRA rules and the Company Policy. (h) Keeping in view of above, for continued participation vendors should have maintained at least satisfactory standard of performance.

4. Sections of Prequalification Documents	4.1 Prequalification Documents consists sections indicated below, and which should be read in conjunction with any Addendum issued in accordance with ITA 6. 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	4.2 PSO accepts no responsibility for the completeness of the Prequalification documents, responses to requests for clarification, the minutes of the pre-Application meeting (if any), or Addenda to the Prequalification documents in accordance with ITA 6. In case of any discrepancies, documents issued directly by the PSO shall prevail. 4.3 The Applicant is expected to examine all instructions, forms, and terms in the Prequalification Documents and to furnish with its Application all information or documentation as is required by the Prequalification Documents.
5. Clarification of Prequalification Documents and Pre-Application Meeting	5.1 Applicant's may require clarification of the Prequalification Documents via SAP Ariba event message board. PSO will provide clarification no later than three (03) days prior to the deadline for submission of the Applications. PSO will share the same response to all prospective Applicants who have obtained the Prequalification Documents via SAP Ariba event message board. PSO shall also promptly update its response on SAP Ariba RFP. 5.2 Applicants can attend a pre-Application meeting via zoom link date and time will provided. Applicants may obtain clarification of the schedule of requirement, the qualification criteria or any other aspects of the Prequalification Documents in the meeting. 5.3 PSO may called Pre-Application meeting, if necessary. Any modification to the Prequalification Documents that may become necessary as a result of the pre-Application meeting shall be made by PSO exclusively through the use of an Addendum pursuant to ITA 6. Non-attendance at the pre-Application meeting will not be a cause for disqualification of an Applicant.



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6. Amendment of Prequalification Documents	6.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of Applications, PSO may amend the Prequalification Documents by issuing an Addendum. 6.2 Any Addendum issued shall be part of the Prequalification Document and shall be communicated via SAP Ariba message board to all Applicants who have obtained the Prequalification Documents from PSO. The Procuring Agency shall promptly publish the Addendum at the PSO SAP Ariba message board: Provided that an Applicant who had either already submitted their Applications electronically via SAP Ariba shall have the right to alter his already filed Application and submit the revised Application prior to the Application submission deadline. 6.3 In case of Addendum, PSO may at its discretion extend the deadline for the submission of Applications if it deemed necessary.

7. Deadline for Submission of Applications	7.1 Applicants should submit their Applications electronically, as mentioned in Prequalification Invitation. 7.2 If required in accordance with the provisions of ITA 6.3, PSO will extend the deadline for the submission of Applications, in which case all rights and obligations of PSO and the Applicants subject to the previous deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended. 7.3 The deadline will be extended in the same manner as that of original Invitation for Prequalification (or the advertisement).
8. Late Applications	8.1 No late application(s) will entertain. Once time stop no applicant will able to submit their application electronically in SAP Ariba.
9. Opening of Applications	9.1 Applications Open electronically through SAP ARIBA on 03-09-2026 at 03:00 P.M
E. Procedures for Evaluation of Applications	
10. Confidentiality	10.1 Information relating to the Applications, their evaluation and results of the Prequalification shall not be disclosed to Applicants or any other persons not officially concerned with the Prequalification process until the notification of Prequalification results is made to all Applicants in accordance with ITA 28. 10.2 From the deadline for submission of Applications to the time of notification of the results of the Prequalification in



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	accordance with ITA 28, any Applicant that wishes to contact PSO on any matter related to the Prequalification process may do so only in writing through SAP Ariba event message board.
11. Clarification of Applications	11.1 To assist in the evaluation of Applications, PSO may, ask an Applicant for a clarification (including missing documents) of its Application, to be submitted within a stated reasonable period of time. Any request for clarification from the PSO and all clarifications from the Applicant shall be in writing through SAP Ariba message board. 11.2 If an Applicant does not provide clarifications and/or documents requested by the date and time set in the PSO request for clarification, its Application shall be evaluated based on the information and documents available at the time of evaluation of the Application.
12. Responsiveness of Applications	12.1 PSO may reject any Application which is not responsive to the requirements of the Prequalification Documents. In case the information furnished by the Applicant is incomplete or otherwise requires clarification as per ITA 11.2, and the Applicant fails to provide satisfactory clarification and/or missing information within prescribed time, it may result in disqualification of the Applicant.



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F. Evaluation of Applications and Prequalification of Applicants	
13. Evaluation of Applications	13.1 The PSO shall evaluate all proposal as per criteria defined in Section II, Qualification Criteria and Requirements, to evaluate the qualifications of the Applicants, and no other methods, criteria, or requirements shall be used. PSO Shall reserves the right to waive minor deviations from the qualification criteria if they do not materially affect the technical capability and financial resources of an Applicant to perform the contract, however subject to the provisions of ITA 18. 13.2 Only the qualifications of the Applicant shall be considered. The qualifications of other related entities such as the Applicant's subsidiaries, parent entities, affiliates, subcontractors or any other firm(s) different from the Applicant shall not be taken into consideration in determining the qualifications of the Applicant.
14. PSO's Right to Accept or Reject Applications	14.1 PSO reserves the right to accept or reject all the Applications, and to annul the Prequalification process at any time, without thereby incurring any liability to the Applicants.
15. Prequalification of Applicants	15.1 All Applicants whose Applications substantially meet the specified qualification requirements will be prequalified by PSO.
16. Notification of Prequalification	16.1 PSO shall notify all Applicants in writing of the names of those Applicants who have been prequalified. In addition, those Applicants who have been disqualified will also be informed. 16.2 PSO shall upon request communicate to any supplier or contractor who submitted a proposal, the grounds for its rejection, but is not required to justify those grounds.

18. Mechanism of Blacklisting	Following procedure for blacklisting of a bidder shall be adopted: 18.1 The process of blacklisting will start from the issuance of a Show Cause Notice ("SCN") to the bidder/contractor wherein the reasons for issuance of said notice shall be mentioned in sufficient details together with the background of the case. 18.2 The SCN shall be issued by the Chief Supply Chain Officer ("CSCO"), on joint recommendation of GM indenting department and GM-P&S. Such recommendations shall include basis for initiation of blacklisting proceedings in reasonable detail. 18.3 P&S department will act as a facilitator for the purpose of blacklisting in fair and transparent manner. P&S Department shall be responsible to maintain the record of all blacklisting proceedings together with copies of SCNs, replies thereto, material submitted by the parties during the blacklisting proceedings and final decisions. 18.4 The bidder/supplier/contractor shall be required to reply to the show cause notice within a minimum seven days period from the date of the receipt of the SCN. 18.5 The hearing opportunity to the bidder shall be afforded by the CSCO. The venue, time and date of the hearing shall be intimated through the same SCN. 18.6 In case the CSCO has conflict of interest, P&S department shall apprise the MD who may authorize Chief



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	Financial Officer (“CFO”) or any other officer to proceed with the matter. If CFO or any other officer is appointed to take any action under this Mechanism, he shall exercise and perform all powers and functions of CSCO under this Mechanism. 18.7 The bidder/supplier/contractor may respond to the SCN and/or appear on the given date for personal hearing. The bidder/supplier/contractor may either appear in person or through a duly authorized representative. 18.8 In case the bidder/supplier/contractor neither respond to the SCN nor appear for personal hearing, the CSCO may decide: 18.8.1 either to provide another opportunity to the bidder/supplier/contractor to respond to the SCN and/or appear for personal hearing on some other date; or 18.8.2 Subject to clause (xi) and (xii) of this Mechanism, proceed further in ex-parte manner on the basis of available information and record. 18.9 In case the bidder/supplier/contractor fails to respond the SCN and do not appear for personal hearing in response to the SCN issued under clause 4 (i) and (ii), the CSCO may proceed further in the matter in ex-parte manner. 18.10 In case the bidder or his duly authorized representative respond to the SCN and/or appear for person hearing, he shall be provided a full opportunity of personal hearing in accordance with the principles of natural justice and fair play. 18.11 In case the concerned Chief is satisfied that the allegations levelled against the bidder/contractor/supplier are not established, he may pass a decision to this effect by mentioning the reasons/grounds and close the proceedings.
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	18.12 In case the concerned Chief is satisfied that the allegations levelled against the bidder/contractor/supplier are established, he may pass a decision, together with all reasons and grounds, to blacklist and cross debar in any public procurement or disposal proceedings the bidder/contractor/supplier: 18.12.1 Up to the period of ten (10) years, if the corrupt and fraudulent practice is established against the bidder/contractor/supplier; 18.12.2 Subject to clause 3 above, up to the period of three (03) years, if the bidder fails to perform his contractual obligations during the execution of contract or breaches the contract due to his capacity and capability to perform or otherwise; 18.12.3 Up to the period of six (06) months, if the bidder/contractor/supplier fails to abide by a bid securing declaration without being indulged in any corrupt and fraudulent practice. 18.13 The decision of blacklisting, under the signature of CSCO, shall be communicated to the Authority and respective bidder/contractor/supplier within a period not exceeding seven (7) days. The decision shall clearly specify the period of blacklisting/ cross-debarring in accordance with rule 19 of the Rules. 18.14 Post decision circumstances will be handled by P&S Department in accordance with Rule 19, sub-rule (2) to (5) of the said rule.

All national bidder who fulfil the participation requirements are eligible to participate in this Prequalification.

Section VI – Scope of Supply

The Vendor shall supply and deliver the Laptops at the PSO designated location as specified by the Purchaser. Upon delivery, the supplied Laptops shall undergo a detailed physical verification by PSO's authorized representatives against the specifications, quantities, and configurations mentioned in the Purchase Order. The verification shall include, but not be limited to, validation of Laptop quantity, model, hardware components, and accessories, including hard disks, memory modules, processors, power supplies, network interface cards (NICs), and other relevant components.

In case of any missing, defective, damaged, or non-compliant component identified during physical inspection, the Vendor shall be responsible for the immediate replacement or rectification of the affected parts at no additional cost to PSO.

Following successful physical verification, the Vendor shall deploy its qualified technical resources to perform the installation and commissioning of the Laptops at the PSO Data Center. The Vendor shall install the required Operating System and complete all necessary configuration activities as per PSO requirements.

The delivery of Laptops shall be considered complete and accepted only after successful installation of the Operating System and verification of all hardware specifications through OS-level validation and command-line utilities. PSO shall verify critical parameters, including but not limited to processor details, memory capacity, storage configuration, RAID setup (where applicable), network interfaces, firmware versions, and other technical specifications to ensure compliance with the Purchase Order.

The Vendor shall remain responsible for resolving any hardware or component failures identified during delivery, installation, commissioning, or acceptance testing and shall replace faulty components within the agreed timelines without any additional cost to PSO.

Note: Vendor staff must adhere to PSO HSE guidelines/policies while delivery Laptops at PSO designated location at all times.



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Section VII – Supply Requirements

Laptops will be procured on as and when required basis based on the business requirement. Delivery will be made PSO head office / LMT Korangi or PSO designated location as per the requirement in Call of contract from the date of issuance of Purchase Order.

Delivery:

1. Purchase order will be issued on as and when required basis through Call of contract for required quantity.
2. The supplier shall also ensure that the supplies are exactly as per specifications laid down in our RFQ document / purchase order.
3. The job includes labour, transportation and all material charges.
4. All service, tools (nonferrous if required), first aid box, ladder, materials and transportation required for execution of work to be arranged and provided by contractor.

Terms & Conditions:

1. The above items shall be subjected to be checked/approved by PSO Information Communication Technology (ICT) Dept. before delivery of each consignment,
2. The Supplier will be liable to replace the defective items free of cost within a two-week time from the date of intimation. Sending and receiving courier charges of such items are also to be paid by the vendor. PSO ICT's decision in classifying the item as defective shall be final and binding upon the Supplier and not be challengeable,
3. The vendor will be responsible for delivery of items in the designated premises of the Pakistan State Oil, PSO House, Khayaban-e-Iqbal, Clifton Karachi,
4. The vendor has to provide the evidence (at PSO House) that all the items provided are brand new and not recycled.
5. Bids may be evaluated on item wise basis or as a whole. Part payment against part delivery is allowed.
