

PAKISTAN CRICKET BOARD
AUCTION OF VEHICLE SCRAP MATERIAL AT NATIONAL
BANK STADIUM KARACHI
(TERMS AND CONDITIONS)

The financial bid form with all the required documents (below mentioned) should uploaded on **EPADS 2** (<https://epads.gov.pk>) (Reference no. D10975) before **11:00 A.M.** PST on **8th October 2026**. The applications shall be opened for evaluation on **EPADS** (<https://epads.gov.pk>) at **11:30 A.M.** PST on the same day.

1. The Auction will be based on, “**AS IT IS AND WHERE IT IS**”.
2. Bidder must submit bid security in the form of CDR amounting to Rs. 50,000- in favor of Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB) which shall be refunded/ adjusted after completion of the disposal process.
3. Taxes will be levied as per prevailing law at the time of receipt/ payment.
4. Non-blacklisting affidavit at Non-Judicial stamp paper of 100 Pak Rupees.
5. The interested party may visit and inspect the auction-able material from Monday to Friday during 9 am to 5 pm.
6. Rates must be quoted as per UoM mentioned against each item in items list.
7. The successful bidder will be responsible for lifting the scrap from PCB-designated places within a week after receipt of award letter.
8. The successful bidder will provide the signed document upon lifting of scrap as and when collected from PCB.
9. The successful bidder will be required to depute a focal person, who will be responsible for supervising the collection process of scrap.
10. The successful bidder will bear the transportation, supervision, weighing, labor and all other costs incurred during lifting of scrap from National Bank Stadium Karachi.
11. If the successful bidder withdraws the offer, the security deposit will be forfeited in favor of the PCB.
12. The winning bidder will submit all amounts in advance.
13. Auction will be based on the highest total value for all items
