



INVITATION TO e-BIDS THROUGH EPADS v2.0 FOR DISPOSAL OF PUBLIC ASSETS

National Database and Registration Authority (NADRA) (National Database and Registration Authority (NADRA)), invites electronic bids of **Disposal Through Open Auction** from interested firms / companies **Individual / Individual Consultant, Sole Proprietorship, Partnership Firm, Company (Private Limited), Company (Public Limited), State Owned Enterprise (Private Limited), State Owned Enterprise (Public Limited)** for e-Auction of **Auction of Faulty / Non-serviceable / Beyond Economic Repair Computer / IT Items / Equipment** on as is where is basis. The bidders must be registered with Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) for Income Tax and Sales Tax, and must be on Active Taxpayer List. (Requirement of PEC registration may be added in case of disposal of civil, electrical, or mechanical works).

2. e-bidding documents as per Disposal of Public Assets Regulations-2024, containing detailed terms and conditions, specifications and requirements etc. are available for the registered bidders on **EPADS v2.0** at <https://vendors.epads.gov.pk/>, and may be searched by using Disposal Activity ID No. **D10933**.

3. Manual bids shall not be accepted. The bidders shall participate on-line in e-Auction through their **EPADS v2.0** accounts. The e-Auction shall remain open till **Thursday, October 15, 2026 11:00 AM**, and will be reviewed and evaluated on-line on the same day at **Thursday, October 15, 2026 12:00 PM**. The bidders shall have the opportunity to increase their offers multiple times till the closing time that is **Thursday, October 15, 2026 11:00 AM**, after which the bidder with the highest Offeror will be automatically selected by **EPADS v2.0** as the winner...
